Selain mengagih zakat, LZS turut menjalankan usaha dakwah

MENYEBUT institusi zakat, pastinya umum membayangkan sebuah pertubuhan yang bertanggungjawab bagi mengutip dan mengumpulkan wang zakat untuk diagihkan kepada lapan golongan asnaf dinyatakan dalam al-Quran.

Namun, bukan sekadar itu, ramai tidak menyedari peranan institusi yang menawarkan bantuan dan peluang kedua kepada umat Islam menjalani kehidupan lebih baik itu turut diperluaskan dengan aktiviti menyebarkan dakwah Islam.

Ya sebagaimana dilakukan oleh Lembaga Zakat Selangor (Zakat Selangor) yang mengambil kesempatan memperkenalkan agama Islam kepada masyarakat sekeliling ketika mengunjungi dan mengadakan jelajah ke sesuatu lokasi.

Mengikuti program Jelajah Kasih Bersama Asnaf (Zikra 2.0/2016), ke Pulau Ketam, Pelabuhan Klang, Selangor baru-baru, peserta program itu berpeluang melihat pengislaman dua remaja Orang Asli di pulau majoriti berpenghuni bukan Islam tersebut.

Ahli Jawatankuasa Agihan, Zakat Selangor, **Datuk Ibrahim Md. Yusof** berkata, program Zikra bertujuan menunjukkan kepada pembayar zakat sama ada daripada institusi, syarikat dan perseorangan

hasil agihan yang disumbangkan kepada penerima secara terus.

"Ramai pembayar bertanya ke mana perginya duit zakat yang mereka sumbangkan. Menerusi program ini, kita membawa pembayar terpilih untuk melawat dan melihat sendiri hasil kutipan zakat yang diagihkan kepada penerima.

"Alhamdulillah, dalam program ini juga, kita dapat saksikan dua Orang Asli di Sungai Dua, Pulau Ketam ini memeluk Islam yang disempurnakan syahadah oleh Penolong Pegawai Tadbir Agama Islam Daerah Klang, Mohd. Nazim Suratman.

"Ini juga merupakan usaha Zakat Selangor dalam menyebarkan dakwah secara tidak langsung. Sumbangan pada hari ini juga menyasarkan kepada golongan muafak dan fakir miskin," katanya.

Turut hadir wakil daripada Bank Muamalat Berhad, TWO FS Resoucers Sdn. Bhd., KPJ Healthcare Berhad, Perbadanan Menteri Besar Selangor dan Naza Group.

Pada program itu, Ibrahim turut menyerahkan bantuan e-petrol berupa bantuan makanan bulanan kepada asnaf dan melancarkan kedai terpilih untuk dijadikan ejen e-kasih yang merupakan kedai agen asnaf mengambil bantuan keperluan makanan bulanan.

Dalam pada itu, Ibrahim berkata, pihaknya menyasarkan kutipan sebanyak RM645 juta pada tahun ini berbanding sebanyak RM627.2 juta jumlah kutipan keseluruhan pada tahun 2015.

"Oleh itu, kita sentiasa meningkatkan



usaha bagi menambah jumlah kutipan, gerak kerja kita lebih memfokuskan untuk memudahkan orang ramai membayar zakat. Kini pembayar tidak perlu lagi

bersusah ke kaunter kerana bayaran juga boleh dilakukan semudah dalam talian dan juga menerusi khidmat pesanan ringkas," jelasnya.

Dash bakal beri keselesaan kepada lebih setengah juta penduduk sekitar

SHAH ALAM 6 Jun - Pembinaan Lebuh Raya Damansara-Shah Alam (Dash) diyakini akan menyelesaikan kesesakan teruk di Persiaran Mokhtar Dahari dan Kota Damansara sekaligus memberi keselesaan kepada kira-kira 500,000 penduduk di kawasan tersebut.

Timbalan Pengerusi Gerakan Yes 2Dash (Y2D), Adlan Abdul Razak berkata, sehubungan itu adalah wajar kerajaan PKR Selangor menyegerakan pembinaan lebuh raya itu dan menamatkan penderitaan penduduk sekitar yang telah lama berlarutan.

Menurutnya, berdasarkan kenyataan Menteri Besar, Datuk

Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali sebelum ini, projek itu mendapat sokongan pelbagai pihak dan hanya ditentang kira-kira dua peratus daripada penduduk terlibat.

“Kami percaya Menteri Besar amat prihatin dengan masalah majoriti penduduk di kawasan terbabit kerana pembinaan Dash ini sejajar dengan saranan beliau yang mahukan rakyat mempunyai kehidupan berkualiti.

“Kami juga maklum projek ini ada pihak yang menentangnya, tetapi tentangan itu perlu dinilai pada meritnya bukan berdasar-

kan sentimen,” katanya dalam sidang akhbar di sini baru-baru ini.

Mengulas lanjut, Adlan berkata, pihaknya juga percaya Dash adalah pembangunan berkualiti dan inisiatif peduli yang dapat meningkatkan kualiti hidup rakyat dan menjana ekonomi penduduk sekitar.

“Dash juga dapat menyokong pembangunan di sekitar Persiaran Mokhtar Dahari, Kampung Melayu Subang, Subang Bestari, Kwasa Land dan Kota Damansara.

“Tiada lagi alasan melainkan menyegerakan pembinaan lebu-uh raya ini kerana kelewatannya akan mengakibatkan kos yang semakin tinggi dan akhirnya akan ditanggung oleh rakyat,” ujarnya.

PAN perlekeh Sungai Panjang, 'agungkan' Sekinchan?

Dalam sidang akhbar di Ibu pejabat DAP di sini hari ini, Azhar menyifatkan Sekinchan lebih maju berbanding Sungai Panjang, sebuah penempatan nelayan yang agak terbelakang.

Malah, beliau menganggap kefahaman politik pengundi Sekin-

chan lebih ke hadapan dan bandar itu boleh dijadikan 'bandar universiti politik' untuk melatih rakyat memahami keadaan politik semasa.

"Mungkin undi Sekinchan undi penentu (membantu kemenangan PAN dalam pilihan raya kecil Sungai Besar 18 Jun ini) tetapi kalau tiada sokongan daripada pengundi Melayu dan India, ia tidak seperti yang kita (PAN) harapkan," katanya.

Daripada 42,655 pengundi

berdaftar kawasan parlimen Sungai Besar, 30.70 peratus atau 13,094 adalah pengundi Cina dengan majoritinya iaitu 9,119 orang berada di Sekinchan.

Azhar, 51 yang berdepan calon BN, Budiman Mohd. Zofdi, 44, dan Dr. Abdul Rani Osman, 58 (Pas) turut meminta para penyokong pakatan pembangkang agar tidak lagi terkeliru bahawa Pas kini bukan lagi anggota pakatan itu.

"Pas hanyalah bekas (anggota) pakatan pembangkang, dan juga sokongan tidak kira siapa salkan melalui pakatan harapan (pakatan pembangkang diaanggotai DAP, PAN dan PKR," katanya.

DAP masih meneruskan agenda *Malaysian Malaysia*

KUALA LUMPUR 6 Jun - Barisan kepimpinan DAP dilihat masih mahu meneruskan agenda melaksanakan konsep *Malaysian Malaysia* dengan menyokong PAN dalam Pilihan Raya Kecil (PRK) Sungai Besar dan Kuala Kangsar.

Ketua Kluster Politik, Keselamatan dan Hal Ehwal Antarabangsa Majlis Profesor Negara (MPN), **Prof. Datuk Dr. Mohamed Mustafa Ishak** berkata, konsep itu merupakan agenda DAP sejak dahulu dan ia tidak pernah berubah.

Beliau yang juga Naib Canselor Universiti Utara Malaysia (UUM) memberitahu, konsep *Malaysian Malaysia* jauh berbeza dengan *Malaysia* dan tidak boleh dilaksanakan kerana majoriti isi kandungan konsep

tersebut melanggar Perlembagaan.

“Atas sebab itu, DAP bersungguh-sungguh menyokong PAN dalam pilihan raya ini kerana majoriti barisan kepimpinan dan ahli dalam parti baharu itu terdiri daripada mereka yang kalah dalam pemilihan Muktamar Pas Ke-61 di Kuala Selangor, tahun lalu berikutan tidak menyokong pelaksanaan Rang Undang-undang Mahkamah Syariah yang baharu di Kelantan.

“Sehubungan itu, pengundi di kedua-dua kawasan tersebut perlu bijak dalam menilai calon yang bakal diundi dan berhati-hati dengan agenda tersembunyi

DAP ini,” katanya ketika dihubungi *Utusan Malaysia* di sini hari ini.

Beliau mengilas mengenai dakwaan Presiden Pas, Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang yang menyatakan DAP menyokong PAN dalam PRK Sungai Besar dan Kuala Kangsar kerana

mempunyai agenda tersendiri iaitu menghalang perjuangan Islam.

Sementara itu, pengalisis politik tempatan, **Prof. Madya Dr. Ismail Sualman** berkata, barisan kepimpinan DAP sepatutnya hanya menjadi pemerhati dengan membenarkan PAN bertanding dalam PRK Sungai Besar dan Kuala Kangsar menerusi konsep berdiri di atas kaki sendiri.

'Mana ada, Sungai Panjang membangunlah' – Budiman

SABAK BERNAM 6 Jun - Tidak wajar melabelkan Sungai Panjang sebagai ketinggalan kerana sektor pelancongan kawasan itu semakin membangun selain mempunyai kemudahan infrastruktur kesihatan dan pendidikan yang baik.

Calon Barisan Nasional (BN) Parlimen Sungai Besar, Budiman Mohd. Zohdi berkata, antara kemudahan pendidikan di situ ialah Maktab Rendah Sains Mara (MRSM) di Sungai Besar serta klinik kesihatan.

Kit Siang akui peluang PAN amat tipis

PENASIHAT DAP, Lim Kit Siang mengakui calon PAN, Azhar Abdul Shukur mempunyai peluang yang amat tipis untuk memenangi Pilihan Raya Kecil (PRK) Parlimen Sungai Besar.

Beliau berkata, Azhar memerlukan 'keajaiban politik' memandangkan kawasan tersebut merupakan kubu kuat Barisan Nasional (BN).

Menurut Kit Siang, BN tidak pernah kalah dalam setiap pilihan raya yang diadakan di Parlimen

Sungai Besar sejak merdeka.

"Walaupun pakatan pembangkang berada di puncak kekuatannya pada Pilihan Raya Umum Ke-13 (PRU-13), BN masih memenangi kerusi Parlimen Sungai Besar dengan majoriti tipis 399 undi," katanya dalam teks ucapan yang dipaparkan melalui laman blog beliau (<http://blog.limkitsiang.com>) hari ini.

Ucapan tersebut disampaikan Kit Siang dalam ceramah kempen PRK Parlimen Sungai Besar di Sekinchan, Selangor malam tadi.

PRK Parlimen Sungai Besar pada 18 Jun ini bakal menyaksikan pertembungan tiga penjurua antara calon BN, Budiman Mohd. Zohdi; calon Pas, Dr. Abdul Rani

Osman dan Azhar.

Kit Siang turut meragui kemampuan pakatan pembangkang yang baharu dan PAN untuk mengatasi pencapaian Pas di kerusi Parlimen Sungai Besar pada PRU-13.

"Pakatan pembangkang yang baharu dan PAN merupakan entiti-entiti politik Malaysia yang belum pernah diuji.

"Mampukah keduanya menyaingi prestasi Pas dan pakatan pembangkang sebelum ini dalam PRU-13?" katanya.

Beliau juga meramalkan Pas akan kehilangan sekurang-kurangnya 10,000 undi dalam PRK Parlimen Sungai Besar berbanding 18,296 undi yang diterima parti itu pada PRU-13.

Ketika hari penamaan calon di Dewan Seri Bernam, kemesraan pemimpin Pas dan BN duduk semeja di khemah BN menjadi tumpuan media sosial.

Bagaimanapun, Tuan Ibrahim menegaskan, dalam keadaan media baharu yang terbuka ini, kadang-kala sekeping gambar boleh mengundang pelbagai fitnah.

“Saya nak jelaskan kunjungan ke khemah parti berlainan politik adalah perkara biasa. Tapi saya nak sebut, kita akan lawan calon BN...lawan tetap lawan,” katanya.

Ditanya adakah Pas bimbang jika gambar yang tersebar itu menjejaskan sokongan pengundi terhadap parti itu, Tuan Ibrahim menjelaskan, mereka perlu memberi penjelasan tentang perkara itu kepada pengundi terutama ke-

pada penyokong atas pagar.

Sementara itu Pesuruhjaya Pas Selangor, Datuk Iskandar

Abdul Samad menyifatkan gambar yang diviralkan dalam media sosial itu satu politik murahan dan tidak matang.

“Politik yang dibawa Pas ialah politik berdasarkan realiti dan bukan politik persepsi. Politik persepsi seperti inilah yang kita tentang sebab tak selari dengan budaya politik matang dan sejahtera yang dibawa Pas,” katanya.

Jaga keharmonian masjid: Mais

SHAHALAM – Majlis Agama Islam Selangor (Mais) melalui Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (Jais) menegaskan supaya pihak masjid dan surau tidak memanggil penceramah, pendakwah serta khatib yang tidak mempunyai tauliah Mais.

Pengerusi Mais, Datuk Mohamad Adzib Mohd Isa berkata, langkah ini penting bagi mengelak berlakunya penularan dan penyebaran fahaman serta doktrin salah yang mudah diterima masyarakat Islam setempat.

“Selaku pemegang amanah tunggal bagi semua masjid dan surau seluruh Selangor, Mais bertanggungjawab memastikan agar fungsi dan peranan masjid sentiasa berjalan baik bagi manfaat masyarakat Islam setempat.

“Ini termasuklah menjaga keharmonian masjid dengan memasti-

kan masjid dan kawasan zonnya bebas daripada medan berpolitik,” katanya melalui satu kenyataan kepada *Sinar Harian*.

Beliau berkata, kewujudannya juga bagi menyediakan parkir yang selamat bagi warga SS15 dan menyelesaikan masalah kesesakan aliran trafik di kawasan tersebut.

"Saya lega ia dibina juga akhirnya selepas beberapa tahun perkara ini dibincangkan," katanya.

Sementara itu, Ahli Jawatankuasa Penduduk (JKP) Zon 3, Singam M berkata, dia jarang ke kawasan komersil SS15 disebabkan sukar meletakkan kenderaan di kawasan komersil itu.

Katanya, majoriti tapak parkir disediakan untuk peniaga dan pelanggan dipenuhi kereta milik pelajar kolej berdekatan.

"Saya jarang datang ke sini sebab susah nak letak kereta, bila ada kemudahan tempat letak kereta baru ni, mungkin bolehlah berkunjung ke sini, kelak," katanya.

Timbalan Pengerusi Y2D, Adlan Abdul Razak berkata, majoriti 50 persatuan yang mewakili lebih 500,000 penduduk di kawasan perumahan di sekitar Persiaran Mokhtar Dahari, Puncak Alam dan Kota Damansara menyokong pembinaan lebuhraya itu.

"Menurut Kementerian Kerja Raya, kerja pembinaan dijangka bermula Ogos ini dan kami mahu kerajaan negeri dapat memulakannya mengikut tarikh yang diberi.

"Jika lewat, kos akan jadi makin tinggi dan akhirnya kos itu akan ditanggung rakyat," katanya pada sidang media disertai AJK Y2D di Denai Alam Curry House, Denai Alam, di sini.

Menurutnya, pihak Y2D percaya Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali prihatin dengan masalah dihadapi majoriti penduduk itu.

"Hanya sedikit yang menentang, namun ia harus dinilai pada meritnya bukan berdasarkan sentimen.

"Tambahkan lagi, kesemua faktor diambil kira dan dipatuhi semua agensi kerajaan negeri dan persekutuan," katanya.

Sementara itu, Setiausaha Y2D, Mohd Azamanizam Baharon turut menyuarakan kekecewaan penduduk yang tidak sanggup lagi berdepan kesesakan lalu lintas saban hari, terutama pada waktu puncak di sepanjang Persiaran Mokhtar Dahari, Jalan Batu 3 ke Sungai Buloh dan Persiaran Surian, Kota Damansara.

"Kami anggarkan sebanyak 10,000 kenderaan melalui laluan itu setiap hari, tiada jaringan jalan raya mahupun lebuhraya untuk terus ke Kuala Lumpur dari Shah Alam, Kampung

Melayu Subang dan Institut Penyelidikan Getah Malaysia (RRIM).

"Trafik hanya tertumpu ke Lebuhraya Baru Lembah Klang (NKVE), Lebuhraya Damansara-Puchong (LDP) dan Sprint untuk ke Kuala Lumpur," katanya.

Lebih mengecewakan menurutnya, apabila trafik bertambah sesak dengan pembukaan beberapa taman perumahan baharu yang mempunyai kepadatan penduduk tinggi.

Difahamkan, Dash yang bernilai RM4.2 bilion, sepanjang 47 kilometer itu antara projek yang diumumkan Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak dalam Bajet 2015.

Itu adalah lebuhraya tiga lorong bermula dari persimpangan Puncak Perdana, Shah Alam dan menghubungkan Alam Suria, Denai Alam, Jalan Sungai Buloh, Kota Damansara dan Mutiara Damansara sebelum berakhir di persimpangan Penchala dengan tiga plaza tol.

Selain Mastura, PAS diwakili Dr Najihahussalehah Ahmad, Dr Ahmad Termizi Ramli (PAN) dan Izzat Bukhari Ismail Bukhari, calon Bebas yang menggunakan simbol pen.

Dengan kedua-dua PRK itu yang terakhir diadakan sebelum Pilihan Raya Umum (PRU) ke-14, ia

sebenarnya mengesahkan cerminan awal senario parti bertanding nanti.

Pada PRU ke-13, BN hanya berdepan saingan daripada satu blok pakatan pembangkang, Pakatan

Rakyat (PR) terdiri daripada PAS, DAP dan Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR).

Namun, perubahan landskap politik semasa yang menyaksikan PR kini berkubur dengan PAS

disingkirkan, PKR dan DAP kini membentuk pakatan baru bersama PAN dalam Pakatan Harapan.

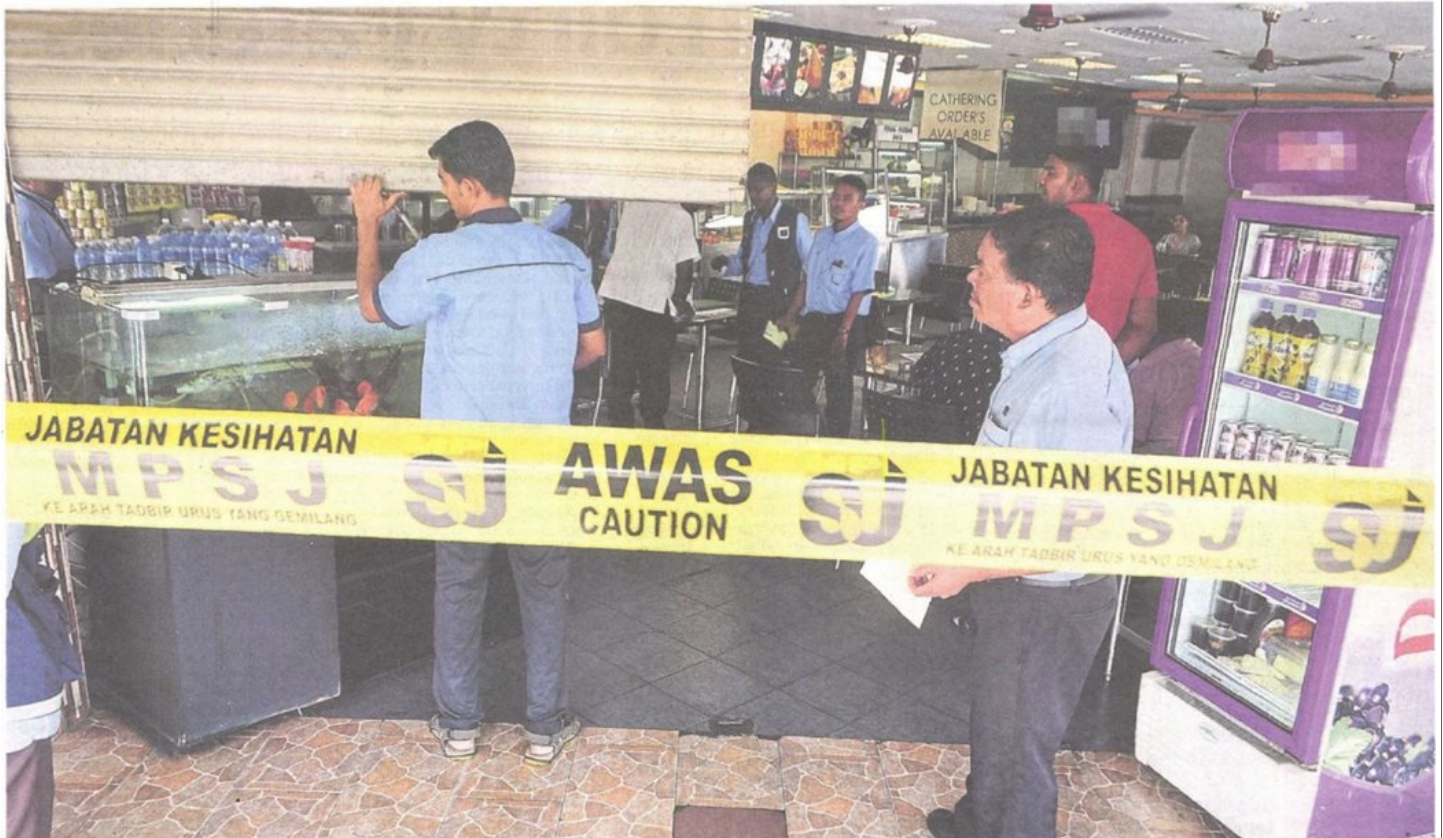

YOU could cut the tension in the air with a knife when the Subang Jaya Municipal Council (MPSJ) Health Department was sealing a dirty restaurant in Taman Puncak Jalil, Seri Kembangan, for 14 days.

MPSJ councillor Anbarasan Murugesu took *StarMetro* to the upper floor of the shophouse. The owners had converted it into a kitchen without council approval.

On the way upstairs, flies flitted around a dark, grimy passage.

At the kitchen entrance, open sacks of rice grains sat on the floor.

A slight wind blowing in through the windows brought whiffs of foul smells.

Just a few steps away from the kitchen were the toilets.

Inside the kitchen, broken egg shells and dried pandan leaves littered the floor, which looked like it had not been washed for weeks.

Just below the sink was a shallow drain that ran to a raggedy hole in a facade wall. This is so that food waste and sillage from the sink can slosh through a pipe all the way into the back-alley drain.

Downstairs, a look through the grids revealed a curry cesspool stewing in the drains.

But the most disturbing sight was to see customers continuing to eat their food as enforcement officers were sealing the premises.

Catherine James, who lives in the area, was tucking into a plate of fried noodles and chicken, and did not even realise the premises was being sealed.

She went a little green in the face when told that the premises was being shut down for not observing proper food hygiene.

The number of eateries the Health Ministry (MOH) was compelled to close in the past two years reflected a poor awareness among Malaysians

on food safety and hygiene.

"In 2015, a total of 124,254 food premises were inspected. Of this 2,422 (1.9%) were ordered closed.

"A total of 8,210 compounds were issued to food premises operators for offences committed under the Food Hygiene Regulations 2009," said MOH director-general Datuk Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah.

The situation shows no sign of improving.

Up till March this year, 645 of the 28,026 food premises inspected were ordered to close.

Already, 3,418 compounds have been issued for various offences.

A circular issued by the ministry

on Food Hygiene Regulations 2009, which was fully enforced from January 2014, stated 33 compoundable offences for food operators.

They range from licensing to the transportation of meat, cooked food and raw fruits as well as vegetables.

Maximum penalties include fines not exceeding RM10,000 or not more than two years' jail, or both.

Food handlers including hawkers must be licensed by their respective councils who will ensure that they have been vaccinated against typhoid.

A food handlers training programme was also started by MOH in 1996 in preparation for the 1998 Commonwealth Games.

Today, 251 entities are recognised by the Government as training centres.

Those applying for restaurant and hawker licences are advised to attend the course.

Continual public patronage is the reason why dirty eateries thrive, said MPSJ Corporate and Strategic Management Department deputy director Muhammad Azli Miswan.

He cited an example of an eatery in USJ 10, Subang Jaya, which had been issued with 30 compounds but continued to run on full house daily.

"People who care about their health should give dirty eateries a wide berth.

"But in Malaysia, a dirty food stall or restaurant is not a deterrent to customers," he observed.

It does not help that Malaysians have a "forgiving" and tolerant nature towards dirty food handlers.

Customers should rightly boycott eateries that are seen practising unsanitary habits.

At food courts and stalls, hawkers and restaurant workers openly peel prawns and cockles beside drains, reuse water already logged with food waste to wash dirty dishes, and store food in holey containers which are often seen left on roadsides or on wet kitchen floors.

Now with the influx of foreign workers operating food stalls, no one seems to be questioning if they have acquired the proper health checks and vaccinations.

Dirty eateries have proliferated in office buildings too.

In one such building in Shah Alam, a cafe was seen offering customers food on crockery speckled with dried gravy.

Flies teemed over the buffet line and the cashier-cum-waiter was smoking.

"People do not mind eating in

such dirty environment, until they fall very sick, that is," said Universiti Putra Malaysia Food Science Department Associate Prof Farinazleen Mohamed Ghazali.

Farinazleen, a microbiologist and food safety expert, said the public might change their minds after looking at things from a microscopic level.

"Microorganisms in food can produce toxins under dirty conditions and wreak havoc on the body," she said.

She cited the well-known incident of food poisoning at a wedding in Sungai Petani, Kedah, which claimed the lives of four victims in 2013, and of 40 schoolchildren in Buntong, Perak, the same year who had to be admitted for treatment after eating contaminated fried rice.

In Malaysia, a case of food poisoning involving more than two patients can be legally declared as an outbreak.

But alarm bells are not often set off because patients who may have eaten at a shop in Cheras may be living in Subang.

Hence when the person falls sick, the victim will most likely go to a clinic in Subang.

Meanwhile, another patient who has eaten at the same shop may seek treatment at a clinic in Bangsar.

As medical records of the two clinics are not correlated, there is no way to prompt the authorities to conduct a check at the eatery in Cheras, unless they get a tip-off from the public.

Farinazleen advised the public to be more selective when frequenting food outlets.

"The rules of food safety are easy to follow. For example, if food has to be left out, it has to be stored either above 60°C or, in the case of cut fruits and dairy, below 5°C.

"Raw meat must be refrigerated and must never be mixed with cooked dishes.

"Handlers must wash their hands before and after touching food.

"And most importantly, those in the food business must operate in a premises with running tap water," she said.

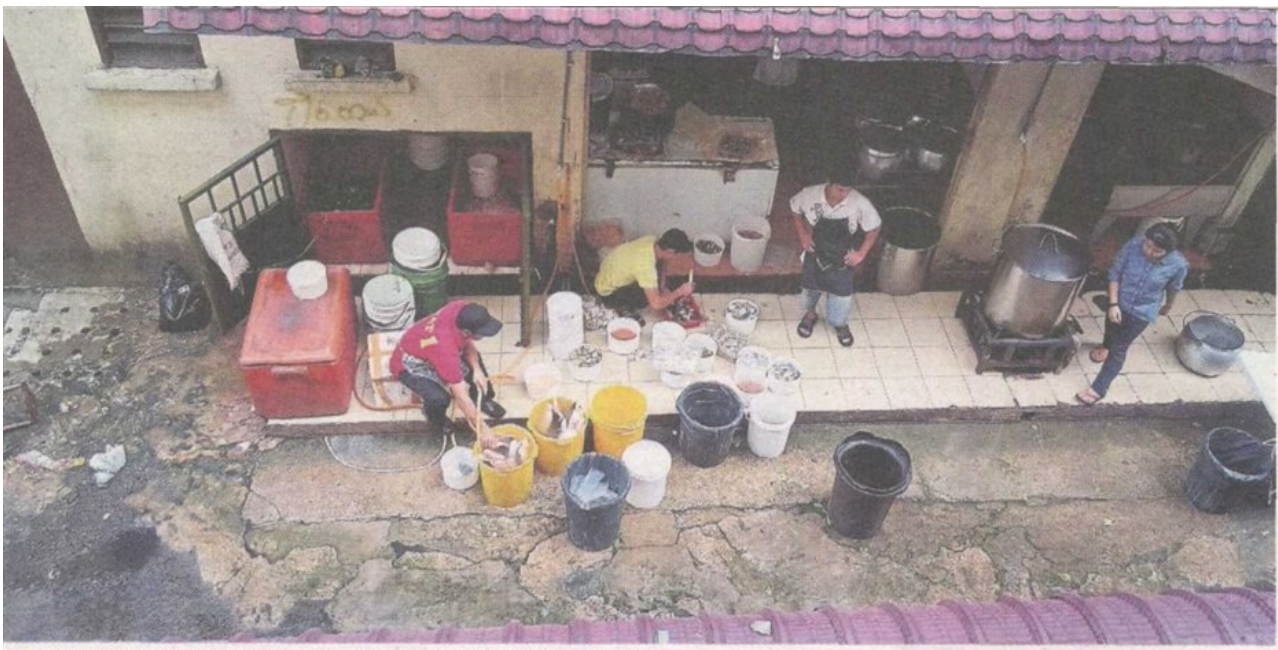

Shoddy upgrade in PJ areas

Section 5 and PJS6 folk see red over poor road resurfacing and mini park repairs

RESIDENTS at two neighbourhoods hoping for improved facilities have instead been saddled with poor road resurfacing and shoddy playground upgrade.

At Kampung Lindungan in PJS6, Petaling Jaya, long-time resident Jayakumar Chelliah pointed out to *StarMetro* the areas that had been poorly resurfaced without milling the road.

Some of the affected roads were Jalan 6/4E, Jalan 6/4F and Jalan 6/4A.

Jayakumar, a civil engineer, said it was obvious some portions of the roads were not milled as they were higher on one side.

"This has resulted in a higher road level and at some spots, the scupper drains are now covered," he said.

The neighbourhood is prone to flooding and residents want the council to resolve this issue fast.

Jayakumar said the residents were not notified to remove their vehicles for the resurfacing work.

"I know how roads should be resurfaced and this contractor skipped a part of the process. When queried, he told me that he had returned the milling machine when it came to my road. There are spots on the road that have not been resurfaced.

"This is unacceptable as it is a council project," said Jayakumar.

He also noted that there were no supervisor or engineer from Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) to check on the work.

He added that he had contacted the area councillor several times but the issue remained unresolved.

In Section 5, Petaling Jaya, residents were happy over news that the mini park and playground in Jalan 5/46 was to be upgraded.

But they question the work quality after the project was completed in March.

When *StarMetro* visited the site, park users highlighted the broken pavements and railings.

They also complained that the basketball court at the playground was closed for about four months but there was not much renovation done.

"Instead, the cracks on the basketball court were covered with a thin layer of cement. Within weeks the cement had started cracking," they noted.

Those using the basketball court, mostly teenagers, worry that the uneven surface could cause them injuries.

A park user, Charlie Ng, said the playground used to be prone to flood.

"After the park upgrade, that problem seems to be solved.

"However, my friends and I began to notice the cracks on the walkway pavements just weeks



after it was upgraded."

He said the park was popular among residents of all ages and it was well used.

"We hope the council will investigate why the job was not well done. These projects are funded by the council and we hope money is not wasted," he added.

Former Petaling Jaya councillor Chan Chee Kong said his son used the basketball court and complained about the shoddy

upgrading job.

"My son and his friends were excitedly waiting for a new court.

"But they noticed that no major or substantial renovation was done.

"The old nets were refitted back. The court used to have cracks but the cement used to seal those cracks is damaged and the court is ugly and unsafe," said Chan.

MBPJ has not responded to *StarMetro's* request for comment.

No escape, mayor warns illegal traders

MBSA will not think twice about removing stalls set up without permit

SHAH Alam City Council (MBSA) will not compromise with errant traders who carry out business illegally this Ramadan.

Shah Alam mayor Datuk Ahmad Zaharin Mohd Saad said the council was on the lookout for illegal traders, especially at locations such as Dataran Kemerdekaan.

"We have issued several warnings and notices but they do not heed them. Some even pushed past the barricades we put up and set up their stalls there," he recounted.

He said places like Dataran Kemerdekaan were not for petty traders' business.

"There are plenty of alternatives approved by MBSA for the traders to set up shop.

"We anticipate more of these illegal stalls all over Shah Alam during Ramadan and we will remove them. Even if they set it up again the very next day, we will be there to bring it down," he added.

Ahmad Zaharin said traders who still wished to open a stall for Ramadan could submit their applications and MBSA would try to fit them in at any of the Ramadan

bazaars if there was space.

He was speaking to reporters after presenting certificates to 17 new enforcement officers who completed their basic training.

The mayor said the no-compromise stance extended to enforcement officers who were found guilty of wrongdoing, revealing that one personnel was terminated for drug abuse.

"If there are complaints against any officer and investigations reveal the allegations to be true, the offender will be sacked with immediate effect," he reiterated.

During the ceremony, the 17 recruits, including one assistant safety officer and enforcement officer, displayed their march-past skills to thunderous applause from the spectators.

Among the recruits were four female officers selected from more than 400 applications following a physical endurance test and other stringent criteria.

Omar Latiff won the Overall Best Private award.

The 24-year-old said he had participated in uniformed bodies since his school days and had attempted to join a council's enforcement team three times before.

"Finally I did it," he said with a big smile.

Omar said his parents, trainers and fellow trainees were his motivation to perform better, giving him advice whenever he needed it.

PAS has three representatives in the Selangor state executive council, they being Iskandar himself, who is housing, building management and urban living committee chairman; Selangor PAS deputy commissioner Datuk Dr Ahmad Yunus Hairi (Islamic religious affairs, Malay customs and heritage, and rural and traditional village development committee chairman); and Zaidy Abdul Talib (infrastructure, public amenities and agriculture modernisation and agro-based industry committee chairman). — *Bernama*

Khalid: PAN means no disrespect to Pas by contesting

SUNGAI BESAR: Parti Amanah Negara (PAN) is now saying that it does not mean to disrespect Pas by contesting the Kuala Kangsar and Sungai Besar by-elections, despite throwing down the gauntlet more than two weeks ago.

At a press conference yesterday, PAN communications director Khalid Abdul Samad said the decision to run for both seats was made collectively by the opposition pact Pakatan Harapan members.

"The issue of PAN going against Pas is a non-issue. It is only an issue in the minds of Pas leaders, who think that we contest for the seats, because they did so, too.

"It has nothing to do with that. We did not mean to create disrespect or create conflict with Pas," said Khalid, when asked whether PAN was "disrespecting" Pas by contesting the seats traditionally reserved for the Islamic party.

On May 23, Khalid was reported to have said PAN had offered itself to go against Pas in both

by-elections "so that the latter can prove it is strong enough to contest alone".

He also said PAN's participation in the by-elections could promote Pakatan Harapan as the alternative to Barisan Nasional.

"After Pakatan Rakyat was disbanded, people began to say that the oppo-

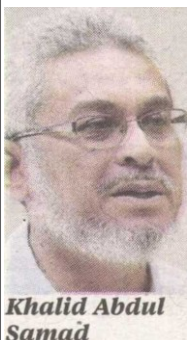
sition was no longer united. Therefore, we want to highlight the emergence of a new opposition pact to challenge BN."

Present were PKR vice-president Nurul Izzah Anwar and DAP publicity chief Tony Pua.

Earlier, Pas deputy president Datuk Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man told a press conference that PAN should have respected Pas's decision to lock horns with BN in a straight fight.

"The other party (PAN) should honour (the opposition's understanding of) having a straight fight with BN in this by-election.

A NON-ISSUE: It's normal in politics, says BN candidate Budiman

SUNGAI Panjang state assemblyman Budiman Mohd Zohdi has called on all quarters not to turn the Barisan Nasional Sungai Besar parliamentary by-election candidate into an issue.

“So, it is better to do detailed homework before making statements. For those who are unaware, Sungai Panjang has a lot to offer in ecotourism, such as homestay and attractions like fireflies and hornbills.

“Every week the coastal areas of Sungai Panjang are filled with tourist and anglers. Apart from that, we also have a Maktab Rendah Sains Mara and a Health Clinic in Simpang Lima,” he said.

In another development, the BN candidate said he received very good response from Chinese voters in Sekinchan when holding programmes there.

In fact, he said they called him “Ahmad” and helped him put up a fanpage in Chinese.

The by-election on June 18 would see Budiman challenged by Meru Pas state assemblyman Dr Abdul Rani Osman and PAN’s Azhar Abdul Shukur.

The by-election is being held following the death of Tan Sri Noriah Kasnon in a helicopter crash in Sebuyau, Sarawak, on May 5. **Bernama**

Budiman a people person, say village elders

SUNGAI BESAR: Pensioner Mdnor Hasan had long known that a boy from his village of Kampung Sungai Limau was destined for bigger things.

But the 71-year-old never thought that Budiman Mohd Zohdi would go as far as becoming a state assemblyman, who is now vying to be a member of parliament (MP) on Barisan Nasional's ticket.

"I am friends with his father, so I practically watched him grow up.

"He has always been a people person, ever since he was a young boy.

"Budiman and I are of Javanese descent, too. Coincidentally, previous assemblymen were from Kampung Sungai Limau as well," he said, referring to the late Tan Sri Noriah Kasnon and former Sabak Bernam MP and Sungai Besar assemblyman (before redelineation) Datuk Mahbud Hashim.

Yatimi said unity was an enduring quality of the constituents here.

Kok: Rethink PKR, Pas ties

Islamic party not committed to unity, says DAP vice-chairman

DAP has told PKR to consider severing ties with Pas as the latter was not committed to the unity of the previous opposition pact Pakatan Rakyat.

DAP vice-chairman Teresa Kok said it was time for PKR to rethink its partnership with Pas following similar calls by some of the Islamic party's leaders at the Pas muktamar recently.

"If I were a PKR member, I would feel hurt because there were motions tabled against PKR during the muktamar.

"The fact that they (Pas) are in the Selangor coalition government and yet, had allowed motions like that to be passed during the muktamar, what does that tell you?

"(Pas information chief) Nasrudin Has-

san Tantawi had also said Pas should review its ties with PKR. They do not treasure the efforts in place to (sustain) the Selangor government," Kok said.

She also revealed that Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Azmin Ali, who is also PKR deputy president, had "refused to give Pakatan Harapan" his full support because of Pas.

"Azmin had, all this while, refused to fully support Pakatan, because he cared about (PKR's) relationship with Pas and the party's role in the Selangor government.

"But it looks like his efforts in defending Pas are not appreciated, so I will leave it to PKR (to rethink about its pact with Pas)," Kok told the *New Straits Times* yesterday during a Parti Amanah Negara (PAN) campaigning round in Sekinchan.

Kok said she was glad that Azmin had openly expressed his support for PAN's Sungai Besar parliamentary by-election candidate Azhar Abdul Shukur.

"Azmin has sent a strong signal (on his stand) and we hope it will remain so."

Selangor DAP chairman Tony Pua also approved of PKR's support for PAN.

"They (PKR) have always supported PAN and that (PKR's loyalty) has never been a problem (to DAP and the opposition pact)," he said.

'PAN will not replace Pas in Selangor govt'

SUNGAI BESAR: Parti Amanah Negara (PAN) can forget about replacing Pas in the Selangor government administration, said Selangor Pas commissioner Datuk Iskandar Abdul Samad.

Whatever the outcome of the Sungai Besar parliamentary by-election on June 18, Pas would remain in the state government and continue to hold posts in the state executive council, he said.

"PAN must remember that it was Pas, DAP and PKR that formed the state government after the 13th general election, before the existence of PAN," he said in a press conference here yesterday.

Dr Abdul Rani is involved in a three-cornered contest with Sungai Panjang assemblyman Budiman

Mohd Zohdi of Barisan Nasional and Sungai Besar PAN chairman Azhar Abdul Shukur in the by-election.

The by-election is being held following the death of Sungai Besar member of parliament Tan Sri Noriah Kasnon, who died in a helicopter crash in Sarawak early last month.

Noriah was also deputy plantation industries and commodities minister.

Pas has three representatives in the Selangor state executive council, namely Iskandar himself, who is housing, building management and urban living committee chairman; Selangor Pas deputy commissioner Datuk Dr Ahmad Yunus Hairi (Islamic religious affairs, Malay customs and heritage and rural and traditional village development committee chairman) and Zaidy Abdul Talib (infrastructure, public amenities and agriculture modernisation and agro-based industry committee chairman). **Bernama**
