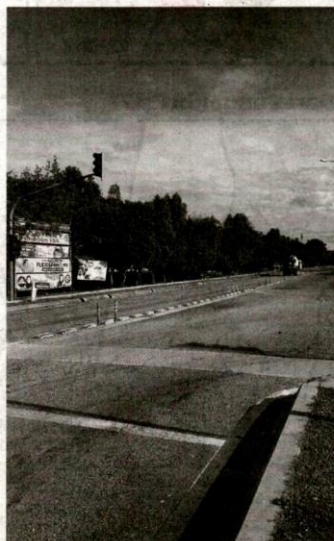

# Catat 3,638 kes pulih

*3,048 kes harian baharu dilaporkan, Selangor catat kes tertinggi*

### Kuala Lumpur

Sebanyak 3,638 kes sembuh dilaporkan semalam menjadikan jumlah kumulatif kes sembuh sepenuhnya daripada Covid-19 sebanyak 145,084 kes atau 77.6 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan.

Ketua Pengarah Kesihatan, Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah berkata, jumlah kes sembuh itu mengatasi jumlah kes harian baharu

iaitu sebanyak 3,048 kes, menjadikan jumlah keseluruhan kes positif Covid-19 dalam negara kini mencecah 186,849 kes.

Menurutnya, jumlah kes aktif dengan kebolehjangkitan kini adalah 41,076 kes.

"Selangor melaporkan kes harian baharu tertinggi sebanyak 1,035 kes (34.0 peratus). Daripada jumlah ini, 720 kes adalah daripada kluster dan saringan kontak rapat yang aktif dijalankan di lapangan. Ia diikuti Johor sebanyak 529 kes dan Sabah sebanyak 348 kes.

"Sebanyak 62 kes yang di-

## Making greater uptake of public transport a reality

Most projects outlined in Selangor master plan have not started due to lack of funds, says exco

 SELANGOR has been in public transport development mode since the proposal that would help improve connectivity within the Klang Valley have not been set in motion.

The state government is keen to improve the sustainability of its transport system, says Transport Minister Haniffa Usman, general secretary of the state government and a deputy director of the Federal Government.

State road development, public transport and low-charge transportation committee chairman Ng Sze Han has told reporters that the state will continue to work with the federal government to make the state's public transport system more sustainable and cost-effective.

“We have to make a plan of public transport to get more people out of their cars in the state by incorporating a lot of road network as well as other public transport services,” he said.

“In the meantime, the state will also try to increase the number of public transport services. **RM420 price tag**

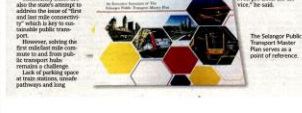

## 'Improving accessibility key to encouraging more to use public transport'

AS SELANGOR aims to expand its public transport networks, stakeholders say that the basics such as covered walkways and affordability need to be addressed.

Taman Melawati Residents Association chairman Azhari Abd Taharim said that while existing buses and rail networks were good, it remained a challenge getting to and from these hubs without driving.

"There are some areas, especially in the centre of Kuala Lumpur where sheltered walkways allow for disembarking passengers to walk to their destination.

"But this is largely non-existent in most other areas. This can be a turn-off for many who prefer to drive instead," he said.

Besides being sheltered, Azhari said these walkways must be well-lit and safe to make it conducive for pedestrians.

"Another option the state can consider is to have an expanded feeder service to train stations by using smaller buses.

"These buses can pick up passengers within housing areas and take them directly to train stations.

"Within Taman Melawati for example, the nearest train stations are LRT Gombak, Wangsa Maju and Sri Rampai," he said.

Sales associate Shanthi S, 32, hopes that public transportation access can be improved for persons with disabilities.

"My mother is wheelchair-bound, but she volunteers for an NGO several times a week at their office in Kuala Lumpur.

"From our house in Ampang, she has to wait for a bus that is wheelchair-friendly and even then the space usually allocated for wheelchairs is taken up.

"When she reaches the train station, it is another hassle as the ramp is often blocked by cars," she said.

Shanthi said while staff at the train stations were always helpful, these services need to be improved.

Meanwhile, Cheras resident Terrance Lee, 35, pointed out that building more urban highways would not encourage public transport use.

He said there were currently two new highways being built in the area, plus the existing MRT line.

"Many would rather drive to their destination instead of taking the train because they have become used to it.

"The authorities should look at limiting the construction of new highways and focus on expanding public transport," he said. — **By SHALINI RAVINDRAN**

# 'Economic recovery takes time'

**Azmin: There's no instant revival as it can't be switched on or off**

**PETALING JAYA:** The notion of an instant economic revival after the lockdown is lifted has no real basis as the economy does not "switch off or switch on", warns Senior Minister Datuk Seri Azmin Ali.

The International Trade and Industry Minister said Malaysia is a global supplier of personal protective equipment (PPE) and an economic shutdown would cause a chain of unwanted consequences.

He said re-imposing an economic lockdown should be a last resort.

"When the movement control order was introduced in March last year, the overarching priority was to strike a balance between protecting lives and livelihoods.

"Miti (International Trade and Industry Ministry) was entrusted with coordinating the list of essential economic activities that were allowed to operate.

"This proved to be a major challenge as the economic value chain is deeply interlinked and highly complex.

"Malaysia is an important player in the global supply chain, and it was incumbent on us to ensure minimal disruption to the supplies of essential products such as rubber gloves, PPE, parts and components for medical devices," said Azmin in a statement yesterday.

He said constant engagements with industry associations and trade chambers assisted Miti in making such decisions.

"In our efforts at fighting this pandemic, a host of unintended economic consequences were unleashed.

"In the second quarter of 2020, Malaysia's GDP (gross domestic product) suffered its worst ever decline in our history at -17.1%.

"The government pumped in a massive RM320bil worth of stimulus packages to mitigate the adverse economic impact on the rakyat, to jump-start and revitalise the entire economy.

"By the third quarter of 2020, we managed to bring down the decline in growth to -2.7%," said Azmin.

He added that while this shows the effectiveness of the stimulus

packages, actual positive growth of the economy will still take at least another quarter or more.

"The notion that the economy can revive instantaneously after a lockdown has been lifted has no real basis.

"The fact of the matter is that the economy does not run on a 'switch off-switch on' mode.

"In this regard, recent calls to re-impose a total lockdown in order to deal with the massive spikes in the number of infections attendant on this third wave must be viewed along with other suggestions concerning alternative strategies and options," said Azmin.

He suggested that standard operating procedure be tightened and

clear guidance be given on quantifying indoor settings at any time.

He further proposed more targeted testing as well as regulating the price of RTK-Antigen test kits to make them affordable for mass screening in industries.

"The call is for businesses to open on the condition precedent of full compliance with stricter SOP.

"One loss in income affects the whole household. In practical terms, the loss of income for one breadwinner may well adversely affect the livelihoods of at least four persons in a family.

"Public-private-rakyat synergy is an invaluable value proposition for nation building and should be embraced by all," said Azmin, paying tribute to all security and medical frontliners.

Malaysian Rating Corporation Bhd senior executive Firdaos Rosli said while the government grapples between saving lives or livelihoods, it must be decisive.

"It is realistically impossible for any government to undertake both objectives at the same time.

"Either way, the policy objectives carry different political impact in the short and long term," he added.

Firdaos also said the government must realise the snowballing impact on the labour market due to the prolonged MCO.

"When recovery is in sight, the crisis cohort will be entering a smaller labour market.

"Underemployment will be a more pressing issue than it is now," he added.

# 'Make Covid-19 test more affordable'

Ramp up RTK-AG testing nationwide, rep urges govt

THE first week of the affordable Covid-19 test initiative at the Bukit Gasing constituency saw 988 people coming in for screening.

From those who took the rapid antigen (RTK-AG) test, 28 tested positive.

All the positive cases were then given a referral letter to their nearest district health office (PKD) to conduct a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test, which gives more accurate results.

Bukit Gasing assemblyman Rajiv Rishyakaran, who initiated the screening, said doctors advised those who tested positive to be on home quarantine and informed them on the safety measures to be taken so as not to



infect family or friends living under the same roof.

Rajiv has now extended the initiative, which resumed on Jan 25, and it will go on for an indefinite period.

In addition to the current screening location at MBPJ Multipurpose Hall on Jalan 51A/22, tests will also be conducted at Pusat Rakan Muda Kompleks Arena PJ on Jalan Selangor.

"Both locations will now con-

duct daily tests from Monday to Sunday with the exception of public holidays.

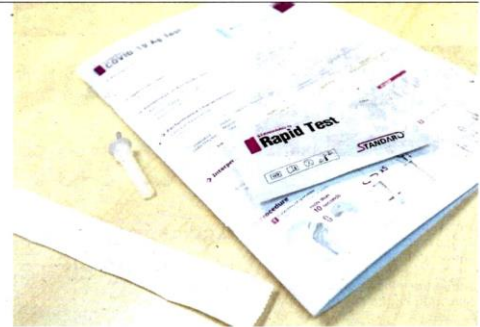
"The test screening at MBPJ Hall remains between 1pm and 5pm, while at the Section 3 centre, it will be conducted between 10am and 7pm.

"No appointment is necessary, just walk in to get tested," he said during a virtual press conference.

Rajiv said the price for each test remained at RM70 for everyone, regardless of nationality and the state they are from.

He said the Health director-general had announced plans to increase PCR testing to 100,000 and eventually 150,000 people per day.

"Its current test rate is 47,000 tests daily, which is about 63% of

its maximum capacity.

"He acknowledged there were manpower and time management issues when it came to PCR tests," he added.

Rajiv said health experts had been calling for a ramp up in tests with triaged, mass and frequent test regimen, utilising RTK-AG instead of PCR to help reduce Covid-19 transmission.

He called for the government to look into rolling out affordable testing nationwide.

"Mass testing using RTK-AG helped manage the outbreak in

Sabah and among the foreign workers because it was made mandatory.

"So why not ramp up RTK-AG testing first and foremost for everyone?" he added.

Rajiv said the problem with PCR tests was that it took too long.

"Currently, only those who are symptomatic are tested, while the asymptomatic ones are told to quarantine at home without a test," he said.

# Appetite for change

Khalid hopes food business will help bid to become pro coach

PETALING JAYA: From selling Golden Boot to food, former national striker Khalid Jamlus is looking forward to a new beginning in his life as he bids to become a professional coach.

The 43-year-old had opened a new stall "Daging Salai Masak Lomak Cili Api" at the Lepak Court in Kuala Langat with two partners Mohd Fauzi Basah and Saliza Subisman.

And he is hoping that through the food business, he will be able to fund for his pro coaching licence in the future.

"It is a new beginning, and I've to admit, it's not been easy because I faced some challenges along the way," said Khalid.

"I met Lepak Court owner Haji Mohd Tajur Haji Asemawi one day, and he gave me a section to do my business."

In July last year, the mercurial player from Perak had to sell his prized Golden Boot, which he won in 2001, due to hardship.

He went through bad times after losing his coaching job with Pahang. His previous business ventures had also failed.

Fortunately, his Golden Boot was eventually bought by the Sultan of Selangor Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah and is now displayed at the Istana Alam Shah's Selangor Football Gallery in Klang.

It is through the proceeds from the sales of his boot and other football memorabilia that he has started the food business.

"At first, the business was slow because of the Covid-19 pandemic. But I did not give up, and now we see steady sales," said Khalid who has also played for sides like Kelantan and Selangor in the M League.

"We do not see daily profits yet, but we can pay our workers and survive with what we have."

Khalid said he has shared his plan with the Football Association of Malaysia (FAM) on acquiring the professional "A" licence, but he couldn't go for the course earlier due to the movement control order.

"I had to hold my plan to undergo the licence course due to the pandemic. I used some of the

money I had to start this business. Once things have settled down, I will surely apply for the course," he said.

"Then, I can start my football career as a coach again," he said.

Khalid donned the Harimau Malaysia jersey 25 times and scored 10 goals from 1998 to 2005.

At his peak, he even went on trials with Bundesliga club Eintracht Frankfurt in 2002.

An illustrious figure in Perak, he has helped his state to the then Premier League 1 title in 2003 and 2004, the FA Cup in 2004 and the Malaysia Cup in 2000.

He was also successful in Selangor, winning the treble - Premier League, FA Cup and Malaysia Cup - in 2002.

KUALA LUMPUR (Jan 25): Malaysia's economic growth has shown improvement over the past few months thanks to the government's stimulus packages, but it does not work on an "off-on" switch basis and will therefore need more time to fully recover from the impact of the Movement Control Order (MCO), said Senior Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali.

He said the government has taken the initiative to pump in a massive RM320 billion worth of stimulus packages not just to mitigate the adverse economic impact on the rakyat but also to jump-start and revitalise the entire economy.

This helped the economy recover from a deep contraction by 17.1% in the second quarter of 2020 to a decline of 2.7% in the third quarter, said the international trade and industry minister.

"While this definitely manifests the effectiveness of the stimulus packages, it should be borne in mind that it would still take at least another quarter, if not more, before the economy could see actual positive growth. This underscores the fact that despite the best efforts at economic recovery, it would take an extended period of time before the economy can actually pick up to show positive growth after the lifting of the MCO.

"Hence, the notion that the economy can revive instantaneously after a lockdown has been lifted has no real basis. The fact of the matter is that the economy does not run on a 'switch off-switch on' mode," Mohamed Azmin said in a statement on his website titled "Going forward in our approach to overcome the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic".

## Azmin: Economy does not run on 'off-on' mode, will take time to recover after MCO

The minister noted that today marks one year since the first case of the Covid-19 pandemic was detected in the country.

In the face of seemingly insurmountable challenges, he said Malaysia has been able to remain resilient, thanks to our robust

public health system and sound economic fundamentals.

Nevertheless, with the onset of the third wave of the outbreak, the country's health-care system has been subjected to even greater pressure, testing its capability and capacity to the limit.

In light of the recently reimposed MCO on Jan 13, which has been extended to Feb 4, Mohamed Azmin said it must be viewed along with other suggestions concerning alternative strategies and options.

For instance, he noted the government could consider tightening the standard operating procedures to prevent outbreaks at ignition sites and introducing clear guidance on geospatial planning such as quantifying indoor settings at any given time.

Additionally, the government could also step up targeted testing as well as regulate the costs of RTK-Antigen test kits to make Covid-19 testing more affordable and on a larger scale, particularly for industries, he said.

"It is important to note that apart from the toll on health and the economy, Covid-19 has a direct impact on the people. One loss in income affects the whole household. In practical terms, the loss of income for one breadwinner may well adversely affect the livelihoods of at least four persons in a family," he said.

Acknowledging the strong support and collaboration by industry stakeholders and the rakyat towards ensuring economic recovery and sustainability during the pandemic, he added: "Public-Private-Rakyat synergy is an invaluable value proposition for nation building and should be embraced by all."

市议会即日起，已圈定在 154 个地区放置垃圾槽 2 天，希望民众善用，以丢弃大型垃圾。



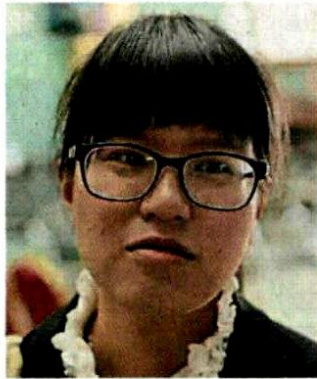

# 无拉港又一厂爆发疫情 逾40员工患冠病

(加影 25 日讯) 继昨天卫生部公布一家工厂出现感染群后，无拉港工业区 KPB 11 路 A 今日再有另一家工厂出现 40 多名员工确诊冠病，厂商在报告结果出炉初期就立刻启动防疫措施，阻断员工继续在外趴趴走。

无拉港州议员王诗棋受受询时《南洋商报》说，有关厂家是在安排全体员工检测时发现上述感染现象，并在报告陆续出炉时发现 2、3 名员工确

诊后，马上启动防疫措施。

“当中包括禁止所有员工外出及与其他人接触，直至全部检测报告结果出炉后，再发现有更多确诊者时，也宣布停止运作，直至另行通知。”

她说，确诊员工大部分是外劳，目前厂商已将其中一个楼房作为确诊员工的隔离中心。

“我服务中心的消毒队早前曾协助该厂消毒，当时该厂未出现疫情，直到近期厂方安排员工检测时，才发现大批员工确诊，不过源头不明。”

她欣慰的是，厂方尽企业社会责任，发现员工疫情后立刻采取风险管理措施，以阻断疫情蔓延。

## 黄诗棋：情况受控

黄诗棋说，目前，无拉港地区有 2 家规模较大的工厂出现确诊病例，一个是昨天公布在 KPB 11 路 A 的感染群，另一家则是上述工厂，其他小厂房也有出现零星病例，惟情况受控。

卫生部昨天已安排巴士，将首家工厂出现确诊的 80 多员工载往隔离中心，其中 70 人是外劳，18 人是本地人。

无拉港州选区内有 6 个工业区，即无拉港新村工业区、无拉港再也工业区、陈明再也

工业区、利丰工业区、蕉赖再也工业区和锡米山工业区，卫生部昨天公布的 11 路感染群 (Kluster Jalan Sebelas) 是位于无拉港新村工业区内的塑料厂。

在上周三 (20 日)，杨桃岭 (Bukit Belimbing) 一间大型工厂也传出疫情，至今该厂已有 40 名工厂员工染疫。
