Selangor ke Fasa 2 PPN September ini

Shah Alam: Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari yakin Selangor mampu beralih ke fasa dua Pelan Pemulihan Negara (PPN) September ini berikutan peningkatan kadar vaksinasi.

Amirudin berkata, berdasarkan kemas kini daripada Badan Bertindak Imunisasi Covid-19 (CITF) dan aplikasi MySejahtera, 98 peratus rakyat Selangor sudah mendapat dos pertama vaksin.

"Minggu lalu, kita dapat 80 peratus warga Selangor menerima dos pertama, tetapi selepas dikemas kini menerusi aplikasi MySejahtera, ia sudah mencapai 98 peratus. Ia mungkin disebabkan ada yang menerima suntikan di pusat pemberian vaksin (PPV) di luar Selangor (Kuala Lumpur).

"Kes kemasukan pesakit Covid-19 kategori satu hingga tiga ke hospital di negeri ini menurun terutama di

Hospital Tengku Ampun Rahimah (HTAR) dan Hospital Sungai Buloh.

"Justeru kita jangka, menjelang September, Selangor bersedia memasuki fasa kedua PPN," katanya.

Menurutnya, bagi melengkapkan kadar pemberian vaksin, kerajaan negeri akan menyediakan 100,000 dos vaksin untuk diagih ke lokaliti memerlukan (kumpulan yang tertinggal).

Dalam pada itu, Amirudin memaklumkan ada berhubung dengan Ketua Pengarah Kesihatan Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah berkenaan usaha berganding bahu mengangani kes Covid-19.

"Selangor setuju meminjamkan stok 500,000 dos vaksin dibeli bagi kegunaan Selangor Vaksin (SelVAX) kepada CITF Kebangsaan supaya dapat digunakan di kawasan dan negeri mengalami peningkatan kes mendadak dengan kadar vaksin yang kurang," katanya.

Usaha keras pelbagai pihak atasi kebocoran paip dasar sungai

Gangguan bekalan air yang melanda Kuala Terengganu dan Kuala Nerus sejak 2 Ogos lalu berjaya diselesaikan lebih awal dari tarikh ditetapkan, hasil tindakan pantas serta kerjasama pelbagai pihak.

Menyatakan hal ini, Menteri Besar yang juga Pengurus Syarikat Air Terengganu (SATU), Dato' Seri Dr Ahmad Samsuri Mokhtar berkata, hasil kerja keras semua pihak, kerja pembaikan kebocoran paip dasar sungai dapat disiapkan dua hari lebih awal.

"Alhamdulillah, bekalan air mula disalurkan 13 Ogos bermula jam 12.00 tengah hari secara berperingkat. Manakala, bekalan air pulih 100 peratus pada 14 Ogos," katanya.

Menurut Ahmad Samsuri, kerajaan negeri menzhairkan rasa terima kasih kepada semua pihak yang terlibat membantu sama ada dari dalam dan luar negeri.

Katanya, penyelesaian kes ini adalah pencapaian yang bukan mudah untuk dijayakan.

"Apa yang berlaku akan memberi ilmu berguna kepada semua pihak untuk menghadapi krisis pada masa akan datang," katanya.

Dalam perkembangan sama, Ahmad Samsuri memaklumkan kerajaan negeri bersertuji memberikan air percuma selama dua bulan kepada seluruh pengguna terjejas di Kuala Terengganu dan Kuala Nerus sebaik proses membaik pulih bekalan selesai.

Ia sebagai menghargai kesabaran penduduk yang terjejas, maah pihaknya akan memperkenalkan langkah susulan dan menambah baik beberapa aspek penyelenggaraan SATU bagi memastikan krisis air tidak berulang.

Sementara itu, Exco Infrastruktur, Kemudahan Awam, Utiliti dan Teknologi Hijau negeri, Dr Mamad Puteh menyifatkan masalah yang

menjejaskan sebanyak 28,700 akaun pengguna itu berjaya diatasi dengan kesungguhan pihak SATU dan agensi lain.

"Kerosakan paip kali ini agak serius dan tidak pernah berlaku sejak 15 tahun, paip itu dipasang di dasar Sungai Terengganu iaitu antara sungai Losong Feri hingga ke Bukit Datu.

"SATU berusaha tanpa henti, dimaklumkan bekerja secara bergilir-gilir 24 jam sehari bagi menyelesaikan masalah tersebut.

"Pihak SATU dengan kerjasama Sumai Engineering Sdn. Bhd yang mempunyai kapakaran dalam bidang tersebut menggunakan 16 penyelamat yang bertugas secara berterusan membuat pemasangan 'clamp' bagi menampung kebocoran itu," katanya.

Kerjasama

Ahli Lembaga Pengarah Syarikat Air Terengganu Sdn Bhd (SATU), Burhanuddin Hilmi Mohamed @ Harun berkata, sebagai alternatif sementara menunggu masalah air di kawasan terbabit selesai, SATU menghantar lori tangki ke kawasan-kawasan tertentu sejak malam pertama masalah itu berlaku.

Katanya, syarikat air dari tujuh buah negeri bertungku lumus menghantar 14 lori tangki dengan kapasiti 70,000 liter air bagi membantu penduduk yang terjejas bekalan air.

Syarikat air berkenaan terdiri daripada Ranhill SAJ, Air Kelantan (AKSB), Syarikat Air Selangor (Syabas), Lembaga Air Perak, Syarikat Air Melaka (SAMB), Pengurusan Air Pahang (PAIP), Syarikat Air Negeri Sembilan dan Syarikat Air Darul Aman (SADA).

Selain agensi negeri dan Persekutuan, turut bertanggungjawab membantu menyalurkan bantuan air adalah wakil-wakil rakyat,

Jawatankuasa Pembangunan dan Keselamatan Kampung (JPKK) dan badan bukan kerajaan seperti Jabatan Amal Malaysia, Iman Care serta Khidmat Malaysia.

Sementara itu, Ahli Parlimen Kuala Nerus, Dato' Dr Mohd Khairuddin Aman Razali berkata, lebih enam juta liter air telah diagihkan kepada penduduk terjejas di daerah Kuala Nerus.

Pihaknya menerusi Pusat Khidmat DUN dan Parlimen telah membuka bilik-bilik gerakan bagi menyelaras semua gerak kerja sekali gus memastikan bantuan air disalurkan dengan baik.

"Antara yang dilaksanakan seperti

penyediaan 117 tangki air berkapasiti 500 hingga 600 gelon di setiap kampung dan JPKK untuk bekalan air diambil sendiri oleh rakyat," katanya.

Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berkata, usul itu akan dibawa pada hari kedua Sidang DUN Selangor yang dijadualkan

Amirudin berkata, selain itu Ahli Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri juga telah merangka untuk meminda

pindaan undang-undang tubuh negeri berhubung pelaksanaan kelayakan mengundi umur 18 tahun.

Mengulas lanjut, Amirudin memberitahu, sidang DUN yang akan bermula pada Isnin ini mempunyai tempoh selama dua minggu untuk bersidang.

Malah katanya, beliau bersama Speaker DUN Selangor, Ng Suee Lim dan dua Exco Selangor iaitu Datuk Teng Chang Khim dan Izham Hashim sudah menghadap Sultan Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah baru-baru ini.

“Baginda telah berkenan untuk hadir dan menyampaikan titah pembukaan sidang DUN, namun atas faktor kesihatan dan keselamatan awam ketika Covid-19 beberapa acara biasa ketika pembukaan dewan seperti perbarisan, bergambar, sesi menghadap dan santapan kita tidak laksanakan,” katanya.

MBSA to look into employers flouting SOP

SHAH Alam City Council (MBSA) will take seriously complaints on business premises that continue to operate despite having Covid-19 cases among its employees.

Shah Alam mayor Datuk Zamani Ahmad Mansor said some employers did not inform the authorities about their infected workers.

One of the cases involved a supermarket where several employees tested positive for Covid-19, which Zamani said was revealed after investigation by the Klang District Health Office.

“There are a few other complaints which I have also requested the district Health Office to confirm. If true, the officers will issue a closure notice to the premises,” he said during the council’s full board meeting.

The standard operating procedure when employees test positive for Covid-19 is for the premises to be closed for thorough sanitising and testing of workers.

Zamani was responding to councillor Papparaidu Veraman, who revealed the matter.

“It is only when we hear of complaints from the public that we know of such incidents,” said Papparaidu, adding that this had also happened at a business premises in Taman Alam Megah.

Meanwhile, Residents Representative Council (MPP) Zone 2 councillor Datuk Emran Kadir’s suggestion in an earlier meeting for MBSA to utilise its reserves to assist those unable to pay their bills, was rejected.

A report on this by the Corporate and Community Development Unit stated that after discussions between the mayor and the chief whips, the suggestion could not be considered due to the council’s lacklustre revenue performance during the pandemic.

The council’s ongoing efforts to alleviate the burden of those affected by the pandemic, however, received a shot in the arm with contributions from two companies.

Taman Berkeley folk object to plan via online survey

KLANG Municipal Council (MPK) plans to turn a 0.95ha recreational field in Taman Berkeley into an open-air carpark with 100 bays and a futsal court, a move that residents oppose.

They said the proposed project contradicted MPK's Low-Carbon City Action Plan 2027, which called for conserving Klang's environment to achieve a healthy environment suitable for outdoor activities and integrates with the objectives and values of a green community.

"I think it is absurd that MPK wants to turn a green space into a parking area," said Chong Jit Seng, 59, who has objected to the proposed project through the council's online survey questionnaire.

He said MPK should realise the importance of open green spaces for residents.

"Such areas need to be preserved, more so now with the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, when people need to physically distance themselves from one another while getting fresh air and carrying out their daily exercise," he added.

Apart from getting residents' feedback, the questionnaire also provided a brief description of the proposed 85m x 59m carpark and 30m x 20m futsal court.

MPK had sent out notices on July 20 informing residents about the online questionnaire. They were requested to answer the questionnaire within the week.

"Our residents do not need a futsal court as the field is for footbal

"They also use the field for brisk walks, jogging and *taichi*, among other exercises.


"Having access to this natural space helps boost our mental well-being," said Chong, who is a financial planner.

Established in 1971, Taman Berkeley is one of the earliest, well-planned housing estates in Klang and has grown into a township over the years.

It has 974 houses, 143 shoplots, an old cinema repurposed as a food court and a community hall that borders the field.

While officially known as Padang MPK, it is more commonly referred to as the Berkeley field.

Chong, who has lived in Taman Berkeley for some two decades, said the green area – the size of two football fields – also helped to retain surface runoff to curb flash floods.

"We residents are against having the field covered with asphalt as it will be impervious to rainwater."

"So when downpour, rainwater will have nowhere to go except into drains, thereby overwhelming them and setting off flash floods."

"It is, therefore, crucial to maintain the field in its natural state," he reiterated.

Social worker Shirley Sobey said the neighbourhood was designed with a large field to encourage social interaction and a better quality of life for residents.

"Other than being a recreational space, the field is now seen as a solution to environmental challenges.

"As residents, we are thankful for the green space as we can step out of our homes for our mental well-being," she added.

Former warehouse executive Yap Choon Hang, 61, said the proposal would see a rise in temperature due to loss of green cover and aggravate the situation if there was a heatwave.

"I have lived here since 1972 and the field creates a space for the people to move around."

"It provides a safe place for children to play while older folk enjoy their walks," the father of three added.

Yap said MPK had increased the number of parking bays along Lebuh Lang, close to the houses, a few years ago to cater to the higher traffic during peak hours.

He said residents accepted that there was a need for that project.

Former teacher LL Lim, 62, said most people in the area used the field for their daily walks and exercise.

Sobey says residents are thankful that they can use the field to ensure their mental well-being.

"In fact, it is the large field that has attracted many people to buy houses in this area, as green spaces do create a pleasing ambience."

"We are against the building of the carpark as it will compromise safety," she added.

MPK Urban Planning Department acting director Yusrina Mohamad Yusof told *StarMetro* that the council was waiting to collect all the responses from residents.

KUALA LUMPUR: Petaling Jaya City know what it takes to beat the giants of Malaysian football, Johor Darul Ta'zim (JDT).

And the Phoenix are ready to rise to the occasion one more time to do just that when the two teams square up for their Super League clash at the Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) Stadium tomorrow.

PJ City are among only a handful of teams to have upset the mighty JDT in the Malaysian League, having beaten the Southern Tigers twice – in a Malaysia Cup match in 2018 and a Super League tie in 2019.

PJ City head coach P. Maniam, while admitting that it will take a herculean effort to sink JDT this time, does not rule out his men's chances against the Super League champions.

"We will play our normal game because we know JDT have a very good team. Even their reserve

players are on another level, so they're not an easy team to take on ... You can't just mark one player, you need to mark all their players as they're also good in one-on-one situations," said Maniam.

"But I believe that when you play wholeheartedly, anything can happen."

"The players just need to show their commitment, eagerness, aggressiveness and a positive attitude ... and prove that PJ City's all-local line-up have the capability to tear the form book apart."

However, what is already sure to be a tough assignment has been made even tougher as Maniam has to deal with an injury crisis at the moment, with six players ruled out.

Among them are strikers Darren Lok and Muhammad Syahmi Zamri; midfielder K. Gurusamy; as well as defenders S. Subramaniam and M. Tamil Maran.

But Maniam is unfazed. In fact, he is confident that any player he fields against the title favourites will rise to the occasion.

"It is normal for us to rotate players regularly. So, anyone given the chance will grab the opportunity to perform," he said, citing young wingers V. Ruventhiran and Sunil Chandran as examples.

JDT are on the verge of an eighth straight Super League title as they sit atop the standings with 45 points after 18 games, eight points clear of second-placed Terengganu, who have 37 points, with just four matches left.

Penang are third with 31 points and can only challenge for the second spot while fourth-placed Kedah, with 29 points from 15 matches, still have a mathematical chance of catching the Southern Tigers.

A win against PJ City will see JDT get one hand on the trophy, as Terengganu are set to host Kedah at the Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin Stadium in Kuala Terengganu at the same time.

Meanwhile, PJ City, who have lost three matches in a row since escaping with a 1-0 win over Sabah on July 24, are in eighth place with 18 points from 17 games. — Bernama

Selangor may go to Phase 2 in September

Based on reports from Health Ministry, HTAR in Klang records a 50% reduction of Covid-19 hospitalisation

SELANGOR is expected to proceed to the second phase of the National Recovery Plan (NRP) anytime next month which will allow more economic sectors to reopen.

Mentri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said this follows the decline in hospital admission for Covid-19 in the state, attributed to encouraging vaccination rate.

"Based on reports and data from the Health Ministry, Hospital Tuanku Ampuan Rahimah (HTAR) in Klang recorded a 50% reduction of Covid-19 hospitalisation.

"I am still waiting for reports from other hospitals in Selangor but the signal is quite clear that the situation is improving," he said in a virtual press conference yesterday.

He said 90% of the state's adult population had been inoculated and at least 56% of them had received the second jab.

Amirudin said the proposal to move to the next phase had been brought to Health DG Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah's attention, who agreed that the reopening of

the economy would be allowed in Selangor soon.

However, strict health standard operating procedures (SOPs) must be continued.

"I also hope we will be cautious in allowing several sectors like education and schools to reopen. Premature decision can cause a spread of new infections," said Amirudin.

Selangor, together with Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya, Negri Sembilan, Melaka, Johor and Kedah are still in the first phase

of NRP since June 15.

A number of economic sectors are still closed, while social sectors are fully prohibited to curb the spread of Covid-19.

On Sunday, caretaker Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin announced 11 non-essential sectors to resume in Phase 1 states, provided that 50% of the adult population have been fully vaccinated.

This, however, is only applicable for those who have received full vaccination with customers entering the premises are required to

present their Covid-19 Vaccination Digital Certificate which also shows that 14 days have passed since their second jabs.

The Covid-19 vaccination rate in Selangor was ramped up after the federal and state governments agreed to work together on the Operation Surge Capacity initiative for the Klang Valley which began in July.

Selangor had earlier ordered 2.5 million of Sinovac Biotech Ltd vaccines for state use, in particular to fulfil the industry's demand and cater for vulnerable groups including the disabled.

With the demand for vaccines in Selangor almost filled up, Amirudin said the state has received a request from the federal-led Covid-19 Immunisation Task Force (CITF) to support a nationwide shortage of supplies to be distributed to other states.

"Selangor has agreed to lend some 500,000 doses of Covid-19 vaccines to CITF to cater other states' needs. We expect the replacement to reach the state within two months, so we can prepare in case booster doses are needed under the state vaccination programme.

"The need for a third dose will be determined after we have a clearer picture and guidelines from the World Health Organisation

(WHO)," he said.

According to the WHO, the Delta variant has been reported in 96 countries so far and is expected to continue spreading.

Pfizer Inc and BioNTech SE recently announced that they would seek regulatory authorisation for a third dose of their Covid-19 vaccine.

They cited that data from an ongoing trial, which showed that a third shot pushed antibody levels five to 10 times higher than the original coronavirus strain and the Beta variant, compared to the first two doses alone, saying a third dose was expected to perform similarly well against the Delta strain.

Moving forward, Amirudin said the state government will focus on searching for residents who are not yet vaccinated, including undocumented foreigners who are possibly hiding from the authorities.

The state's outreach project found that there were a number of people who had yet to receive the vaccine, including foreign students stranded in Malaysia.

Many have also not registered for vaccination through the MySejahtera application, said Amirudin.

He was also of the view that an extension is unnecessary for walk-in vaccination in Selangor, which will end this month.

Unity govt could solve political deadlock, says Selangor MB

THE political crisis in Putrajaya could be resolved if the next installed prime minister (PM) initiates the formation of a unity government, said Selangor Mentri Besar (MB) Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari.

Amirudin said this would also fulfil the wish of Yang di-Pertuan Agong Al-Sultan Abdullah Ri'ayatuddin Al-Mustafa Billah Shah that a stable government can be established to lead the nation out of the pandemic crisis.

The Pakatan Harapan (PH) Selangor chairman also said all parties including the PH bloc should find a consensus and restart a fresh political movement that can last longer.

"After several leadership crises, of course we are hoping that we can have a stable government, like what transpired by the Agong that a new government must consider all party's interests."

"Personally, I believe this is the best time to formulate the Unity Government. It is one of the best formulas to ensure government stability while we are facing this pandemic" Amirudin said in a virtual press conference yesterday.

The Unity Government, or bipartisan government was first proposed by the seventh PM Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, two days after he abruptly resigned from his post last year after stating he no longer hold the majority of support by the Dewan Rakyat members.

Dr Mahathir who was serving his interim PM-ship at that time said, should he be given the chance to lead the nation again, the formed Unity Government will mandate professionals to run the administration and focus will be given to only manage the pandemic.

It is understood that the idea was, however, rejected by Parliamentarians.

Following that, Muhyiddin was sworn in as the eighth PM on March 1, 2020. The Perikatan Nasional (PN) government managed the pandemic until daily cases were down to single digit through the Movement Control Order.

However, daily cases surged back in October 2020 and further climbed to almost 23,000 yesterday, while the national vaccination agenda is still far from completion.

"For the past 18 months, initially we see that there are not many problems when PN runs the administration but after several months, the PN formula was seen as unsustainable and could trigger instability.

"So, I think the Unity Government could be one of the solutions that we should think about," said Amirudin. He said with a continuous slim

support, whoever is appointed as the next PM will not be able to hold on to the position.

Additionally, Amirudin also said the new PM should call the Opposition bloc to discuss and fill up the Cabinet position.

"An inclusive Cabinet must be formed accordingly, so there will be no parties that feel left behind and

trigger any possibility or political movement that can cause the instability of the federal administration, which has greater power specially to tackle the current crisis," he added.

Meanwhile, Amirudin said Selangor is expected to continuously give focus on economic recovery in the state 2022 budget.

Selangor allocated RM2.23 billion for the 2021 budget with 53% for administration and 47% for development expenses.

"I am still analysing data, so we can strengthen the budget for welfare. More importantly, we also need to jump start the economy so jobs can be created and move the chain of the economy and escape the restrictions caused by Covid-19 disease," he said.

The Selangor State Legislative Assembly 2021 is expected to resume on Aug 23, after eight months postponed due to the proclamation of Emergency by the king in January.

Amirudin said Sultan of Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah has agreed to grace the opening ceremony. —by AFIQ AZIZ

“不过，州政府目前将进行相关分析整合，以取得相关数据后能作出更好的分配。”

他直言，州政府不仅需估计福利，也需要带头推动经济，创造更多就业机会，才能真正带领雪州走出疫情影响。

大臣：供分配他州 雪50萬劑疫苗借聯邦政府

(沙亚南19日讯)雪州大臣拿督斯里阿米鲁丁指出，由于雪州购买的冠病疫苗如今尚有库存，因此经过州政府与卫生部协商后，同意借出50万剂疫苗交给联邦政府，以分配给其他州属。

他说，雪州政府当初就有拨出2亿5000万令吉购买疫苗，以加速州内的接种疫苗计划，惟随着雪州在MY SJ已登记人口中，如今已有98%人接种第一剂疫苗，州政府接下来只需专注在流动疫苗计划，寻找出尚未接种的国人和外籍人士，预计只需要10万剂。

他今午召开线上新闻发布会时披露，经过统计后，州政府发现依然尚有多余疫苗的库存，所以他前日前与卫生部总监丹斯里诺希山召开会议后，双方就有达成共识，即雪州政府会借出50万剂疫苗，交给全国冠病疫苗免疫协调特别工作队(CITF)，以分配给其他州属。

助加速达致全民免疫

“疫苗可分配和其他州属，包

括吉打、槟城或沙巴，就能更快达致全民免疫的目标。”

阿米鲁丁指出，州政府虽借出疫苗，但联邦政府还是得需要“还回”给雪州，期限是1个月至两个月。

他说，一旦联邦政府还回疫苗后，雪州或许就能为接种第三剂疫苗做好准备。

最快明年施打第三剂

不过，他直言，若有实施接种第三剂疫苗，最快也会在明年才推行，尤其接种第三剂疫苗目前尚未获得世界卫生组织亮绿灯。

他解释，疫苗如今在全世界依然面对供应不足问题，一旦许多国家允许实施接种第三剂疫苗，肯定会影响到经济能力有限的第三世界国家，无法争取到疫苗。

“不仅如此，我们也需要等待疫苗生产药商进行相关临床实验和统计出相关报告，寻求各方专业的意见，甚至国内也需要卫生部拟定有关指南，所以州政府现阶段只能做好相关准备。”

部分接種中心停運作 雪專注流動接種疫苗

另外，阿米鲁丁披露，根据目前数据显示，雪州确实有些接种中心将在8月尾和9月初停止运作。

他说，州政府接下来会专注在流动接种疫苗方式，主动走入社区，寻找出还没接种的国人和外籍人士。

他披露，许多外籍人士，无论是合法或非法，可能在建筑业、园艺、渔业等领域工作，州政府需设法寻出“他们”，为他们接种疫苗，才能真正落实全民免疫计划。

这场雨大约是从上午11时开始下起，雨势时大时小，一直至晚上都未停止，部分地区的积水迄今都未消退。

受影响的地区，包括武吉拉惹镇、卫星市、珍珠花园第一区、中路、永安镇、百家利及第17区等。

武吉拉惹镇内的一些道路，目前还是受积水影响，尤其是苏玛召1/KU5路

转入双溪克拉末道的道路（通往中路方向）几乎被积水“淹没”，不少轿车选择U转，改用其他道路通往目的地。

沟渠水溢出路面

周遭一带的沟渠的积水迄今都还没有褪去，一些沟渠的积水已溢出路面，根本分不清沟渠或是道路，驾驶者

的安危受到影响。

巴生市议员颜友鹰说，相信是降雨量超过能负荷的范围，雨水排出的速度比不上下雨的速度，因此造成多地淹水，所幸水位没有到非常严重的地步。由于降雨量太大，以往淹水问题不严重的武吉拉惹镇和珍珠花园第一区，这次也难逃雨神的光顾。

他说，巴生市议会已在积极改善当地的水灾问题，包括计划兴建3座防洪池，分别是1个百家利和2个在巴生中路巴刹附近，不过尚未正式竣工就面对这场豪雨。

他指出，防洪池的兴建工程因受行管令影响而延迟竣工，但日后只要正式启用后，必定能大大改善水灾的问题。

永安鎮疫苗中心外馬路積水

巴生市议员柯鹏飞说，他也接获居民有关淹水的投诉，包括卫星市、珍珠花园第一区及武吉拉惹镇，而他所位于中路的诊所也一样面对淹水的问题。

“巴生北区多地都淹水，包括永安镇疫苗中心外围的马路，也无法逃过积水的问题。我随后和水利灌溉局了解后，对方指从下午至晚上12时的降雨量达85.5毫米，所以第一时间操作水闸，结果还是逃不了淹水的命运。”

巴生市议员刘贵城说，他昨日接获逾10宗的投诉，当

“其实谢凤园靠近中路大巴刹的蓄水池已发挥作用，至少已将淹水的情况缓和，不过降雨量实在太大，估计超过75毫米，导致谢凤园一些地区还是淹水。”

不过，他说，两个蓄水池还是不足以的，有待北干峇鲁26路的新蓄水池兴建后，才能一劳永逸的解决淹水的问题。
