Kerjasama pulihara HSKLU diperhebat

Kuala Lumpur: Kementerian Tenaga dan Sumber Asli (KeTSA) sudah mengarahkan Jabatan Perhutanan Semenanjung Malaysia serta Jabatan Mineral dan Geosains memberi kerjasama membantu kerajaan Selangor untuk memelihara dan memulihkan kawasan Hutan Simpan Kuala Langat Utara (HSKLU).

Menterinya, Datuk Seri Takiyuddin Hassan, berkata ia bagi memastikan fungsi hutan paya gambut itu memberi perkhidmatan ekosistem yang sentiasa terpelihara, selain bagi mencegah kebakaran.

Katanya, kementerian juga menyalu-alukan pembabitkan semua

pihak, termasuk pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) dan komuniti setempat untuk memulihkan hutan simpan itu.

"Kita menyambut baik keputusan kerajaan Selangor menghentikan cadangan pelan pembangunan ke atas kawasan HSKLU seluas 536.7 hektar yang dinyahwartakan baru-baru ini, sekali gus akan memulakan proses pewartaan semula sebahagian besar kawasan terbabit sebagai Hutan Simpan Kekal (HSK).

"KeTSA juga menyambut baik keputusan kerajaan negeri untuk mengekalkan status kawasan gantian seluas 579.64 hektar yang diwartakan sebagai HSK, iaitu

Hutan Simpan Sungai Panjang, Hutan Simpan Buloh Telor Barat, Hutan Simpan Buloh Telor Timur dan Hutan Simpan Broga.

"Ia bertepatan hasrat kerajaan untuk memastikan sekurang-kurangnya 50 peratus keluasan tanah negara dilitupi kawasan berhutan selaras komitmen dinyatakan pada peringkat antarabangsa," katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

Pada 8 September lalu, kerajaan Selangor memutuskan untuk menghentikan cadangan pelan pembangunan ke atas HSKLU dan membatalkan pemberimilikan tanah kepada syarikat yang terbabit.

Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari, dilaporkan berkata keputusan itu dibuat melalui Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Selangor, dengan beberapa perkara berhubung HSKLU turut ditetapkan.

Antaranya, 42 hektar akan kekal dinyahwartakan bagi melengkapkan pemberimilikan tanah kepada Kampung Orang Asli Busut Baru untuk menyelesaikan isu yang tertangguh sejak 2006.

Kerajaan Selangor turut menegaskan segala proses penyahwartaan sebelum ini mematuhi segala prosedur dan tatacara dinyatakan mengikut lunas undang-undang.

Tong sampah berkapasiti 1,100 liter itu bernilai RM1,700 setiap satu unit

Kumpulan Darul Ehsan Berhad Waste Management (KDEBWM) Sdn Bhd mengambil tindakan segera menggantikan enam buah tong sampah jenis *leach bin* di Pangsapuri PJS7/15 yang usang dan rosak teruk.

Pengarah Urusannya, Ramli Mohd Tahir berkata, pihaknya mengambil tindakan berkenaan selepas mendapat maklumat mengenai keadaan *leach bin* di kawasan tersebut menerusi Ahli Dewan

Undangan Negeri (ADUN) Subang Jaya, Michelle Ng Mei Sze.

Menurutnya, menerusi sumbangan itu, pihaknya berharap agar sistem pengurusan sampah domestik di pangsapuri berkenaan dapat dilaksanakan dengan lancar selepas ini.

"Ini bukan kali pertama kita beri sumbangan sebegini kerana pihak kami kerap turun padang meninjau lokasi-lokasi yang memerlukan sumbangan seperti tong sampah," katanya kepada pemberita selepas turun padang bagi penyerahan tong sampah tersebut di Pangsapuri PJS7/15 di sini pada Rabu.

Hadir sama bagi menyempurnakan majlis penyerahan tersebut ialah Michelle bersama Wakil Penduduk Pangsapuri PJS7/15, L Baranitharan.

Mengulas lanjut, Ramli berkata, tong sampah berkenaan berkapasiti 1,100 liter dan bernilai RM1,700 bagi setiap satu

"Saya berharap agar penduduk dapat menggunakan dan menjaga tong ini dengan sebaiknya demi kemudahan semua," katanya.

Dalam perkembangan berkaitan, Ramli berkata, seluruh kakitangan KDEBWM berjumlah

10,500 orang telah menerima vaksin Covid-19.

Tambah Ramli, pihak KDEBWM turut berbesar hati dengan bantuan yang diberikan Michelle bulan lalu yang menggunakan peruntukan kuota vaksin menerusi Program Vaksin Selangor (SelVAX) untuk di-

berikan kepada 250 krew KDEBWM di Subang Jaya.

"Pihak kami sangat berbesar hati dengan inisiatif yang diambil itu bagi membantu kakitangan KDEBWM mendapatkan vaksin Covid-19 secepat mungkin," kata beliau.

Kekal pendirian ECRL melalui jajaran selatan

Ia sejajar dengan pendirian mahu membangunkan zon selatan negeri Selangor

Kerajaan Selangor masih berpendirian Bahagian C pembinaan projek Laluan Rel Pantai Timur (ECRL) perlu kekal melalui jajaran selatan termasuk di kawasan Kuala Langat iaitu di bahagian selatan negeri itu.

Exco Kerajaan Tempatan dan Pengangkutan Awam Selangor, Ng Sze Han berkata, melalui sesi libat urus dengan pemilik projek iaitu Malaysia Rail Link Sdn Bhd (MRL) sebelum ini, kerajaan negeri juga tidak pernah memberi sebarang kata putus untuk bersejajar dengan cadangan pembinaan ECRL melalui jajaran utara.

Menurutnya, pendirian itu sejajar dengan pelan pembangunan ekonomi negeri termasuk beberapa perancangan

jangka masa sederhana dan panjang pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) di kawasan tersebut untuk membangunkan zon selatan negeri Selangor.

“Antaranya, Majlis Perbandaran Sepang (MPSp) yang telah memasukkan elemen pembinaan dan penggunaan ECRL dalam Rancangan Tempatan 2025 MPSp.

“Persediaan yang sama juga sedang dilakukan PBT lain untuk memudahcaraan pembinaan ECRL melalui jajaran selatan iaitu pelan yang sebelumnya telah dipersetujui oleh kerajaan negeri dan kerajaan Persekutuan pada tahun 2019,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan pada Rabu.

Justeru, katanya, kerajaan negeri menafikan laporan sebuah portal berita berhubung penjajaran laluan semasa ECRL tidak melintasi Hutan Simpan Kuala Langat Utara (HSKLU), selain menganggap laporan itu tidak tepat.

Sze Han memberitahu, melalui perancangan yang rapi dan menyeluruh, pengoperasian ECRL di kawasan selatan

itu pastinya akan memberi lebih limpahan ekonomi kepada rakyat, seterusnya menyumbang kepada pembangunan mampan negeri.

Tegas beliau, kerajaan negeri telah membuat ketetapan bahawa pembinaan rel kereta api ECRL tidak boleh melalui kawasan utara sejak projek itu dilancarkan pada 2017.

“Disebabkan itu, tiada langsung kelulusan yang diberikan untuk pembinaan rel di kawasan berkenaan.

“Sebaliknya, kelulusan pembinaan telah diberikan kepada pihak MRL pada tahun 2020 melalui jajaran selatan,” katanya.

Tegas beliau lagi, pihak MRL melalui satu kenyataan pada 14 Januari tahun lalu telah menyatakan jajaran Mentakab-Pelabuhan Klang yang melibatkan laluan di kawasan Negeri Sembilan dan pusat pentadbiran kerajaan Putrajaya akan dipamerkan di tapak Pemeriksaan Awam untuk cadangan serta maklum balas awam bagi tempoh tiga bulan.

Sedia 50,000 dos vaksin untuk SelVax bergerak

SHAH ALAM - Kerajaan Selangor memperuntukkan 50,000 dos vaksin sempena Program Vaksin Selangor (SelVax) secara bergerak di beberapa kawasan di negeri itu.

Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berkata, program itu bermula sepanjang minggu ini.

“Alhamdulillah, sambutan yang diterima amat menggalakkan dan akan diteruskan,” katanya yang memuat naik status di Facebook beliau pada Rabu.

Menurut Amirudin, beberapa golongan layak menerima vaksin secara bergerak bagi memastikan rakyat di Selangor mencapai imuniti kelompok.

“Antara mereka yang menerima

manfaat ialah warga emas, mereka yang masih belum menerima vaksin kerana tidak mempunyai pengangkutan dan warga asing,” katanya.

Sebelum ini, Exco Kesihatan Awam, Perpaduan serta Pembangunan Wanita dan Keluarga Selangor, Dr Siti Mariah Mahmud berkata, kerajaan negeri bersedia menambah dos vaksin sekiranya program berkenaan terus mendapat permintaan.

Beliau berkata, Ahli Dewan Undangan Negeri (ADUN) dan ahli Parlimen diminta untuk menjadi tuan rumah serta menyediakan senarai individu yang akan menerima vaksin pada hari program dilaksanakan.

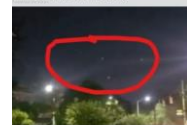

Amirudin puji Putrajaya ikut jejak langkah Selangor

MENTERI Besar Amirudin Shari memuji keputusan Putrajaya bekerjasama dengan Pakatan Harapan (PH), yang antara lain akan membawa kepada reformasi parlimen.

Dalam penutupan Hari Malaysia hari ini, Amirudin berkata pendekatan tersebut tidak sebarang diikat sebagai gencatan politik sebaliknya usaha meningkatkan keselamatan parlimen.

Amirudin berkata Selangor telah mengamalkan persofahaman tersebut sejak 2008 di bawah pemerintahan Pakatan Rakyat sebagai langkah kepada pembangkang dan membenarkan jawatan dalam Jawatankuasa Kita-Kita kepada pembangkang.

"Selangor juga menyediakan dana khas untuk Adun pembangkang dan menjemput mereka untuk mengahuti mesyuarat Jawatankuasa Kerja Keselamatan Khair Selangor," kata Amirudin.

Perkembangan di Putrajaya, katanya, adalah pelanda bahawa Parlimen tidak dianggap sebagai tempat yang hanya mengutamakan satu pihak.

"Sekarang Parlimen dapat berfungsi lebih baik dengan mengahuti dominasi satu pihak dan menggantinya dengan keadilan dan kesepakatan antara gabungan atau pihak lain," katanya.

Pada 13 Sept lalu Perdana Menteri Ismail Sabri Yaakob memarahkan Memorandum Pemahaman (MDU) Tradisional dan Kesepakatan Politik dengan PH.

Berdasarkan pemahaman itu, Ismail Sabri berjanji akan melabangkan beberapa pembaharuan yang telah lama dipelejarang oleh PH.

Setelah bakaan, PH berjanji - dengan beryarat - tidak akan menggagalkan Ismail Sabri dan menyumbang bagi 2022.

Antara lain, Ismail Sabri berjanji akan menubuhkan lebih banyak jawatankuasa pilihan parlimen dan menyesuaikan jawatankuasa sedia ada.

Ini adalah badan yang diarahkan oleh ahli parlimen dan mereka boleh memanggil badan eksekutif atau agensi kerajaan untuk mendapatkan penjelasan.

Mereka biasanya memimam semak dan imbang di seperti kebanyakan sistem Westminster.

Ismail Sabri juga berjanji bahawa keanggotaan jawatankuasa terpilih terbahit akan dibahagikan secara sama rata antara ahli parlimen kerajaan dan PH.

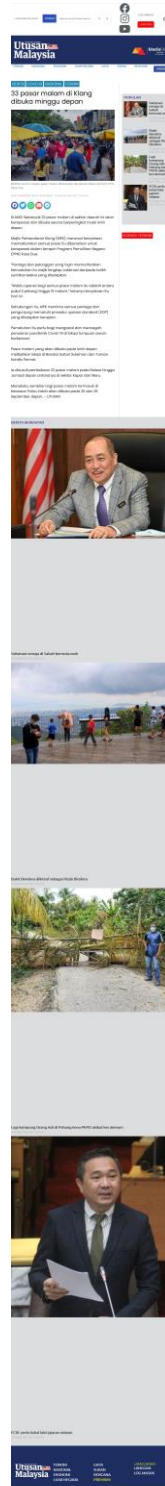

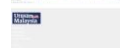

120 Seri Kembangan roadside hawkers receive temporary licences

A TOTAL of 120 temporary licences were issued to roadside hawkers in Taman Puncak Jalil, Seri Kembangan.

This initiative was carried out via Subang Jaya City Council's MBSJ Prihatin programme.

Selangor local government, public transportation and new village development committee chairman Ng Sze Han, who is also Kinrara assemblyman, said prior to this, only six out of the 80 stall owners had MBSJ trading licences.

"In considering their plight, we discovered there were new traders who had set up shop after losing their income because of the movement control order," he said.

The temporary licences were issued to those setting up small food businesses during the Covid-19 pandemic.

"These licences will help the traders do business in a safe and structured environment," added Ng before visiting the stalls in Jalan PUJ 3, Taman Puncak Jalil Business Centre.

He urged other hawkers in Selangor to also apply for temporary licences.

Applications can be made online and approved in a short time, provided all relevant documents are submitted to the respective local councils.

Ng said these temporary licences were to cease last year, but Selangor government decided to extend the duration until December this year.

"The state government will study the need to extend it further, depending on the Covid-19 situation here.

"An important criteria is traders have to be fully vaccinated," he highlighted.

He added that a long-term solution would involve MBSJ relocating the traders to a suitable trading site within the PUJ 3 area.

"We hope to accommodate as many of them as possible," he said.

Meanwhile, MBSJ Licensing Department director Muhammad Azli Miswan said there were too many traders in PUJ 3, therefore they were allowed to temporarily do business at the parking area.

"We will move them to a permanent location and free up the parking area eventually," he said.

Ng said based on Statistics Department data, unemployment in Malaysia had increased to 4.8% in the second quarter of this year, with more than 750,000 people without jobs, 4.4% of whom were in Selangor.

He said the state government, through all 12 local councils, had issued 8,300 temporary licences to hawkers since August last year.

SELAYANG Municipal Council (MPS) raided a cafe in Desa Aman Puri, Kepong in Selangor, following complaints that unsavoury activities were taking place there.

MPS Corporate Communications director Mohamad Zin Masoad, in a statement, said officers discovered that the cafe's only entrance and exit was through the back door while the front door was locked.

"The cafe was also found to have violated council licence conditions and the standard operating procedure under Phase Two of the National Recovery Plan," he elaborated.

He said MPS took action under its Trade, Business and Industry Licensing By-law (2007) and Food Establishment By-law (2007) to confiscate the cafe's chairs, tables, fridge, speakers, television and its stock of alcoholic drinks.

"Several customers and foreign workers managed to escape but seven foreign women were arrested by Immigration Department."

The operation headed by MPS Enforcement Department director Ahmad Faisal Badiuzaman involved some 75 personnel from the council's Enforcement and Licensing departments as well as Immigration Department officers.

MPS also conducted an enforcement operation against illegal

roadside traders in the area of Selayang Jaya.

"We took action following complaints that several traders were obstructing traffic and taking up parking bays," said Mohamad Zin.

fiscated items belonging to 10 illegal traders.

COMMUNITY gardens play a special role in fostering closer ties among residents.
 Being able to share the fruits of their labour with other needy residents as well as agricultural knowledge has helped community gardeners foster camaraderie and develop a sense of purpose, which has become especially useful during the Covid-19 pandemic period.
 An earthworm farmer by profession, Ting Teck Loong never had much time for ornamental plants until the movement control order kicked in in March 2020 and he had to put all his work projects on hold.
 With time on his hands and anxiety of an uncertain future weighing on his mind, the 46-year-old sought solace in his monstrous delicious and *colours aiti artis*, the sale of which now provides him with an alternative source of income.
 "Eventually I had 5,000 ornamental garden plants. They took up every inch of my home garden, and I had to park my car outside," said the father of one.
 The Taman Putra resident's efforts did not go unnoticed.
 About two months ago, Ting received a call from Ampang Jaya Municipal Council (MPAJ) councillor Chua Yew Chong to help develop the ornamental plant section at the Teratai Hijau Harmony community garden in Taman Putra, Ampang, Selangor.

It would be a nice addition to the existing vegetable patch for residents as well as a platform to showcase the efficacy of Ting's earthworm castings which he used to fertilise his plants, said Chua.
 Not only did Ting successfully fill up several beds with various ornamental plant species, he also helped the community garden chief Choo Yew Kee, 74, and his wife Doris Lee, 70, as well as another resident to set up water sprinklers and storm protection systems for their vegetable uses using PVC pipe frames and mesh cover.

Like Ting, tending to the Teratai Hijau Harmony community garden has helped Choo and Lee pass time productively during the lockdowns.
 "My husband and I have grown even closer working in the garden. Planning for crops has given us a sense of purpose and kept us active," admitted Lee.
 "When land-clearing work started in July last year, people said the programme would never get off the ground," said Choo.
 A former dumping site for construction debris, the place was riddled with rocks and concrete blocks.
 Choo said 16 large bins of construction debris had to be carted away.
 Now that the beds are lush with vegetables and ornamental plants, naysayers are beginning to look at the garden differently.
 Though it is a non-profit entity, visitors can buy fresh vegetables and plants.
 In a month, the 17 beds can generate up to RM2,500 in sales. Together with funds collected by members, the money goes towards sustaining the community garden.
 "We don't take money from everyone. We use discretion. Senior citizens and the needy don't have to pay," said Choo.
 Aside from Ting, 11 other residents help Choo and Lee with the community garden.
 An MPJ project in the LA 21 programme, the two-year-old community garden has so far received RM20,000 from Chua's yearly budget allocation of RM75,000 for set up, machinery and fertiliser.
 Since the first planting of vegetables in July last year, 30 houses in

trees in the community garden's hilly terrain and the leaves, in addition to being used by residents for tea, are used as cricket feed at fellow resident Au Yong Soon Kok's farm.

The 60-year-old farmer, who was exporting his cricket frass to the international market, said his business was affected when the Covid-19 pandemic resulted in port lockdowns and disruptions in the container shipping industry.

Au Yong's crickets are now being fed to tilapia fish at the community garden. The tank is filled with an overland rainwater harvesting system built by Leong.

The fish project is only three months old but residents are already looking forward to harvest once the fish are big enough.

As for the mulberries, Yuan has plans to turn them into jam.

A place for wholesome activities

As interstate travel bans continue to remain in place, more people are taking up gardening as a way to pass time, observed Burhanuddin Mohd Ghazali who is chairman of KK4 Precinct 14 Community Garden in Putrajaya.

This community garden is one of 11 urban farms in the administrative capital under the national Local Agenda 21 programme.

Located beside a five-block apart-

ment estimated to house 750 units, Burhanuddin said the 35 members tending to the community garden were mostly civil servants.

"They still have their jobs, but many are experiencing work pressure."

"So, they are turning to the therapeutic benefits of gardening to de-stress."

"The satisfaction of seeing the herbs and vegetables one has cultivated grow, is something one has to experience to know how it feels."

"The feedback I have from them is that gardening is like a sport too. It can be a wholesome family activity," he said.

To sustain the garden, members derive proceeds from the sale of surplus seedlings, soil and fertiliser. Most of it is sold to the community at below market prices.

"A daily price check with the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority (Fama) is done for spinach, bok choy, mustard leaves, lettuce, cherry tomatoes, turmeric, torch ginger, *pandan*, English parsley, lemongrass and coriander because these are grown in our garden. They are sold below the Fama listed prices," said Burhanuddin.

To encourage more residents to cultivate edible gardens, members have come up with a solution — hydroponics.

"Our hydroponics have built in water level indicator that tells when a plant needs watering. It's good for beginners," he said, adding that hydroponic planting and fertigation method was widely practised at the Precinct 14 community garden.

Another reason that should motivate more to invest their time in home edible gardens was the cost savings factor, noted Burhanuddin.

"From feedback, members and some residents who started as early as 2018 say they can save as much as 50% in grocery bills. Sure, it may cost as much as RM150 to invest in a home hydroponic planting system but bear in mind that one can get as many as 40 plants from just one system."

"We have gardeners in our group who tell us that they no longer need to buy vegetables daily," he said.

Joining forces for public welfare

Local authorities and govt agencies step up to the task in Covid-19 battle

LOCAL councils in Selangor have been kept busy caring for public safety and welfare since the Covid-19 pandemic started.

With people frequenting public places like markets, cleaning works and regular sanitisation efforts have been intensified to ensure such premises remain safe for traders and visitors.

"Shah Alam City Council's (MBSA) Environmental Health Department carries out weekly sanitisation exercises at public markets but efforts are increased if there are reported Covid-19 cases," said MBSA Corporate and Public Relations head Shahrin Ahmad.

"Common areas such as railings and walkways outside banks and supermarkets are also sanitised on a scheduled basis.

"If there are requests, the same team will carry out sanitisation services for free at mosques and surau," he added.

Over at Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ), its contractors are instructed to step up daily cleaning works at city council-owned assets such as public markets, food courts and stalls.

"This includes floors, table surfaces, chairs, toilets, prayer rooms and high-touch surfaces such as switches and railings," said MBSJ Corporate and Strategic Management Department deputy director Azfarizal Abdul Rashid.

"Disinfection works are done at markets after operating hours, on a needs basis," he said.

Local councils have also been busy conducting regular enforcement in checking on businesses' compliance with the National Security Council's (NSC) standard operating procedure and council bylaws as part of efforts to safeguard the people against Covid-19.

Such operations are carried out jointly with the police and other government agencies including Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry, Immigration Department, Home Affairs Ministry, Occupational Health and Safety Department and Construction Industry Development Bhd.

MBSJ has held 43 joint operations during the movement control

order this year," said Azfarizal.

"We have issued 172 compound notices, closed two premises, carried out five rounds of confiscations and held two demolition exercises for various offences thus far," he elaborated.

"Petaling Jaya City Council's (MBPJ) SOP compliance inspections and enforcement operations are targeted at commercial areas, shopping complexes, supermarkets as well as manufacturing and service sectors," said MBPJ Corporate Communications officer Ahmad Iskandar Mohamad Mukhtar.

"Between May and July 2021, MBPJ carried out 13,117 inspections at business premises, factories, hawkker stalls and recreational spaces including Bukit Gasing Educational Forest.

"Based on those inspections, 1,570 enforcement actions were taken, including issuing compounds for various offences (eight under the Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases Act 1998), verbal warnings, confiscations and closure notices."

Iskandar said that while most of the inspections were done by MBPJ's enforcement team, there were also 155 joint operations with the Petaling Jaya police and other enforcement agencies.

Food distribution partnerships

Being aware of how some folk in their administrative areas are struggling to get by, the local councils have stepped beyond their customary roles.

They are actively distributing food aid, either through collaborations with partners or contribu-

tions from donors to run in-house campaigns.

"We introduced the *'Program Bakul Prihatin MBSA - Rezeki Kasih'* (MBSA Caring Basket Programme - Sustenance of Love) early this year," said Shahrin.

"The programme is run in partnership with 99 Speedmart supermarket chain.

He said people could contribute by purchasing vouchers, priced between RM10 and RM50, which covered basic food items and nutritional food for babies.

"The vouchers can be purchased at any of the 80 99 Speedmart stores under MBSA's jurisdiction.

"From Feb 8 until June 30, the public contributed RM148,240 to the programme and MBSA distributed 5,054 food baskets to people in need," said Shahrin.

He added: "The programme's target recipients comprised those from B40 groups, individuals with disabilities or have dependants with disabilities, senior citizens, those who lost their jobs, single parents and families with many dependants (more than five persons)."

On the other hand, MBPJ has set up PJ City Food Bank that collects food donated by private companies and organisations which is then sent to senior citizens, welfare homes and the hardcore poor.

"MBPJ ran a Covid-19 assistance programme last year, channelling foodstuff to 509 Petaling Jaya residents who were affected by the movement control order and the economic downturn," said Iskandar.

"In conjunction with the 15th anniversary of Petaling Jaya's city

status this year, MBPJ continued extending assistance under its food bank's social outreach efforts.

"As of late July, 1,023 hardcore poor individuals and 21 welfare aid," he added.

Facilitating PICK

In supporting the government's drive to get as many people vaccinated as possible, local councils have stepped up and played a role in ensuring the success of the National Immunisation Programme (PICK).

Employees of city councils in Selangor volunteered at Sunway Pyramid Convention Centre vaccination centre (PPV), which was also the first large-scale private PPV under PICK.

There were 40 employees from MBSA, 16 from MBSJ and 10 from MBPJ.

During the two-month stint, the staff-volunteers helped facilitate the vaccination process by working as ushers, counter personnel and traffic guides.

In addition, several community halls have been turned into PPV, such as MBPJ Civic Hall near Petaling Jaya New Town starting July 9 and MBSJ Multipurpose Hall in Puchong Indah starting July 26.

"The initiative was done through a strategic collaboration with the National Covid-19 Immunisation Task Force (CITF), which oversees the PPV operations, while MBSJ provided the venue and logistics at no additional cost," said Azfarizal.

"MBSJ's personnel are not involved in volunteering at the

MBSJ Multipurpose Hall PPV as the 100 non-medical volunteers were appointed by CITF."

Similarly, Iskandar said MBPJ provided logistics and services support for the disabled at MBPJ Civic Hall PPV while CITF supervised and managed operations.

"To ensure PICK's success, MBPJ's PJ City Bus provides free rides, through designated routes, for those with vaccination appointments at the Civic Hall.

"MBPJ also provides free transit van service for the disabled to get to their vaccination appointments at selected PPV locations in the Petaling district," he added.

Over in Shah Alam, Shahrin said, "MBSA Hall in Section 19 was turned into a PPV by the Selangor Health Department and Petaling Health Department. MBSA has been assisting in terms of logistics and other needs since May."

In Subang Jaya, MBSJ Multipurpose Hall at 14th Mile functions as a Covid-19 screening centre while Laman Puteri 3 Multipurpose Hall in Puchong is used as a food aid storage centre.

MBPJ has also been involved in offering assistance and manpower at locations in Petaling Jaya placed under enhanced MCO since last year.

The city council provided logistical support, such as trucks, tents, tables and chairs needed by the secretariat, while PJ City Food Bank contributed food aid to affected residents and packed meals to frontliners stationed at enhanced MCO sites such as Mentari Court and Damai Apartment in PJS 8 and Petaling Jaya Old Town back in July.

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 15 — The Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI) has carried out planned and organ steps especially in facilitating the phased and safe reopening of economic sectors in order to reduce the unemployment rate.

Senior Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali, who is also Miti minister, said the reopening of the manufacturing se which hinges on strict compliance with the standard operating procedure as well as worker vaccination rate, was dri by the need for the national economy to remain competitive by ensuring that the supply chain is not disrupted and investments are not affected.

"I would like to give the electrical and electronics (E&E) sector as an example. The government's decision to allow the sector to operate throughout the movement control order, enhanced MCO in Selangor, Seremban and Senal, as well the National Recovery Plan is based on facts and data in order to achieve a balance between protecting public health people's livelihoods," he said in a written reply to a question from Datuk Seri Mukhriz Mahathir (Pejuang/Jerun) in th Dewan Rakyat today.

Mukhriz wanted to know the rationale for allowing more factories to operate amid rising Covid-19 cases in the court. According to Mohamed Azmin, the E&E sector is a key contributor to the nation's economy accounting for RM20.771 or 25.4 per cent, of the manufacturing sector's Gross Domestic Product in the second quarter of 2021.

He further said the sector contributed RM386.29 billion or about 40 per cent of the total export value of goods up to 2021 in addition to providing more than 400,000 jobs.

"At least 20,000 small and medium enterprise-status companies are involved in the supply chain to the manufacture These facts demonstrate the importance of operational continuity for this sector to ensure the country's economic sustainability especially in the manufacturing sector," said Azmin.

He also said that new positive cases reported for the E&E sector amounted to 9,026 cases, or just 2.2 per cent of the combined daily cases, in the period from June 1-July 23, 2021, based on data from the National Crisis Preparedness a Response Centre.

"Therefore, I am of the view that a targeted lockdown approach is more effective than taking the easy way out by clo all factories even when there is no surge in cases, which can hurt the livelihoods of many Malaysians," he added. — Bernama

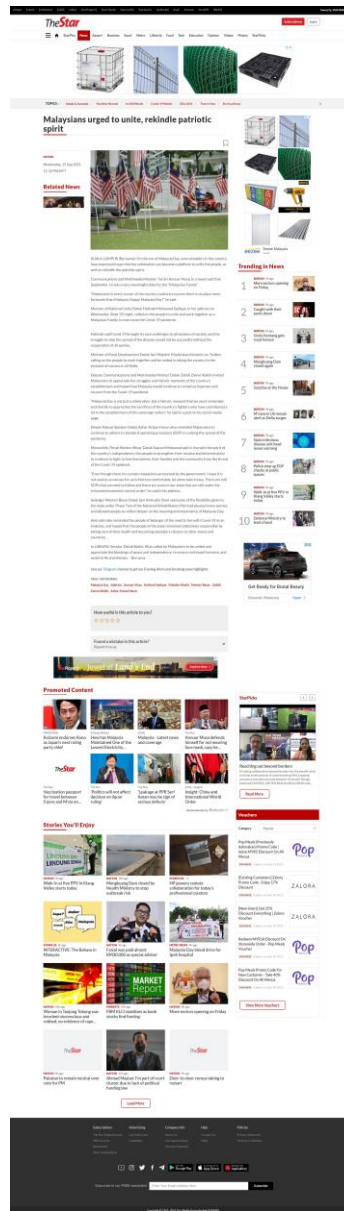

士拉央再也第24路 换水管工程全面竣工

(士拉央15日讯) 随着承包商为长达540公尺的道路铺上沥青, 意味着士拉央再也第24路更换地下水工程, 在经历一波三折后, 正式宣告全面竣工。

负责该区的士拉央市议员余深恩周一晚上巡视铺路工程并聆听工程顾问汇报后表示, 雪州水务管理公司 (Pengurusan Air Selangor) 的这项工程于去年10月12日开工以来, 面对不少阻力, 除了行管令也遇上分包商半途退出, 因而工程多次被延迟。

“最终问题也都一一克服, 新旧水管成功在上周接驳之后, 整个工程也就此告一段落, 紧接的最后一个重铺道路项目更为此写下句号, 感谢各方的努力及居民充分地配合与忍耐。”

根据原定计划, Air Selangor 在士拉央再也第24路进行更换地下水工程, 以新科技的球墨铸铁管 (Ductile Iron) 取代陈旧的石棉水泥 (Asbestos Cement), 将耗时5个月。球墨铸铁管寿命超过百年, 而石棉水泥最多可用

三四十一年, 加上水压的冲击, 迫切需要更换。

士拉央再也第24路是雪州政府2019年所批准更换地下水工程的其中一个路段, 另一个位于第12区的路段包括斯里美拉蒂第1、4、7路, 已在原订的时间内完成。士拉央再也第24路与美拉蒂第1、4、7路皆为水管破裂“黑区”。

换水管能减低制水次数

(士拉央15日訊) 斯里士拉央花園 (Taman Sri Selayang) 商業區大路旁水閘閘漏水問題多年不被解決，以致淨水長年累月不斷流出，浪費水源之余，還造成附近路面被水淹壞的問題。

据了解，水閘閘漏水問題已有3年，雖然居民多次向多個單位作出投訴，但問題依然遲遲未能解決。

甲洞社區服務中心主任余保瓚接獲投訴後，于今日聯同投訴者前往巡視情況，同時也促請雪州水務管理公司盡快處理及解決問題。

多次向雪水務投訴不果

投訴者吳永源 (58岁) 指出，他是在3年前发现水閘閘漏水問題，在多次向雪州水務管理公司投訴不果下，也曾向公正黨州議員服務中心作出投訴，但問題仍遲遲不被解決。

“漏水問題至少有3年以上，雖然一直都有作出投訴，但都不能解決。我一开始是向水供公司投訴，当时也有派人来视察，但却没有任何行动。我后来再次投訴，反而被该公司指責，并反駁水閘閘不能关闭以进行修理，否則会造成整个地区面对制水。”

此外，他说，水因为长期溢出路面，更造成附近的道路不时损坏，常常需要修补及重鋪。

因此，他也特别找上余保瓚协助，希望能透过召开新闻发布会唤起大众及有关当局关注。

他也说，他随后曾陆续向公正黨服務中心作出投訴，也曾联系市議員前往巡視，甚至州議員服務中心协助向雪州水務管理公司投訴，但该公司依然没有采取任何行动。

余保瓚：不應等問題惡化才解決

余保瓚指出，他是在7月时接獲投訴，并随即向雪州水務管理公司反映，无奈至今已两个月了仍不获处理。

“我投訴后有承包商前来巡視，惟他们表示这涉及较大的项目，并非他们能解决的范围。”

他说，自己随后也向该公司士拉央區副主任反映，对方当时表示刚接管有关职务，正调查这項問題。

他也在该公司依然没有采取任何行动上再次作出詢問，对方表示若要修理必须先关闭水閘閘，屆时将造成皆都嗚一带数万用户受到制水影响。

无论如何，他认为，当局应该在问题不严重时处理及解决，不要拖至问题变得更严重时才解决，否則将带来更大的影响。

“水供公司可以发出通告，先通知当地居民有关修理所带来的影响，在这段期间也可安排水车等协助减低居民的困扰，并争取在最短的时间内处理好所有问题，避免造成太大的影响。”

他也希望雪州水務管理公司总部及高层重视这項問題，指示區负责人立刻采取搶修行动，毕竟淨水是很珍贵的，如今却因为漏水問題不被解决而流失，非常浪费。

(賽城15日訊) 雪州將迎來新公共交通系統，初步计划在賽城設立我國第二個智能軌道快運系統 (Automated Rapid Transit, 簡稱ART或智軌電車)，邁向綠色低碳節能城市。

繼柔佛州在近期展開依斯干達快捷巴士系統計劃測試項目，引入中國的智軌電車進行試點測試，成為我國首個智軌電車公共交通系統。

雪州賽城也即將引入智軌電車，預計最近將在今年展開為期3個月的試跑計劃。

据了解，智軌電車是一款于道路路面行駛的無軌電車。

運用電動巴士技術，通過車載傳感器識別地面繪制的虛擬軌道從而讓列車自動跟隨運行，就像是巴士、輕軌及電車的結合體。

賽城迎智軌電車

黃思漢：目前仍處初步階段

掌管雪州公共交通事務的行政員黃思漢向《大都會》社區記者證實，雪州將引入智軌電車作為新的公共交通系統，惟目前仍處於初步階段。

他指出，智軌電車的設計像是電動火車或輕軌，但却是行駛在路面上，無需軌道。

他也曾于2019年前往中國考察時，參觀研發智軌電車的中國中車公司，了解智軌電車的運作。

他透露，智軌電車是賽城發展商Cyberview公司的一項計劃，目前只是初步建議，尚未納入賽城交通大藍圖，等待有關公司在下一次的部門會議上作出匯報。

他指出，州政府將評估在賽城交通大藍圖中納入智軌電車的可行性，作為城市內部公共交通系統，與周邊的其他公共交通系統，包括捷運第二路線及東鐵等進行銜接。

將評估綜合交通發展環境

他說，當局將會評估智軌電車在賽城的綜合交通及城市發展環境，包括安全評估、風險評估、交通衝突及人群管理，進行一系列詳細評估，並將測試整合公共道路交通系統及賽城智能交通燈。

阿都哈密：3節車廂提倡綠色概念

据《The Vibes》報道，雪州州議會主席拿督阿都哈密透露，智軌電車試跑計劃將沿賽城峇林巴剎道 (Persiaran Rimba Permai) 及柏斯達里道 (Persiaran Bestari) 路線進行，以測試智軌電車的能力及綠色科技的運用。

他指出，這項3節車廂的綠色公共交通系統提倡綠色出行概念，非常適合市議會低碳及精明城市的理念，該試跑計劃的成功將有助於賽城在2030年實現碳排放量減少40%的目標。

“如果一切進展順利，我們將在今年開始試跑，不過這取決于技術討論的進展，利益相關者之間簽署的諒解備忘錄，以及所有安全及技術問題都得到解決。”

他補充，智軌電車一次最多可容納307名乘客，最高時速可達每小時70公里，可自動駕駛或由司機手動操作的行駛。

(沙亚南15日讯)雪州政府坚持，东海岸铁路计划 (ECRL) C段 (文德甲至巴生港口) 还是必须走“南线” (经森州和雪州南部)，经过雪州南部好几个地区如瓜拉冷岳，因此州政府维持小部分瓜冷北部森林保留地撤充决定，以保留作为东铁路线开发用途。

掌管雪州地方政府、公共交通及华人新村事务行政议员黄思汉，今日发文告驳斥东铁持有单位马来西亚铁道衔接公司 (MRL) 昨日告诉网媒《当今大马》，称东铁路线完全不会经过雪州南部和瓜冷北森林地，所以雪州政府没必要维持局部森林保留地撤充，以保留作为铁路开发用途的说法。

黄思汉今日声明，雪州政府在同MRL展开的多次接洽上，不曾同意东铁要走“北线” (经彭亨文冬和雪北部双文丹) 的建议。

“州政府的严正立场符合雪州的经济发
展蓝图，包括相关地方政府的中长期规划，以开发雪州南部地区。”

他举例，这包括雪邦市议会在《2025年地方规划蓝图》中，把建造和使用东铁元素纳入规划中。

他说，其他 (南部) 地方政府，也给予东铁路线的经过给予方便和做好准备，即早在2019年便获得雪州政府和 (希盟) 联邦政府同意的地方规划蓝图。

黃思漢：不曾批准走北線 完善規劃 南線可惠民

黃思漢強調，從東鐵計劃於2017年推介以來，州府便表明立場，不接受鐵路經過雪州北部，因此從沒對北線路段給予批准。

“反面，州府於2020年批准MRL，開發和使用雪州南部為東鐵路線 (南線)。”

他聲言，只有通過完善和全面的規劃，從而使東鐵南線發揮更大的經濟效益惠民，進而為雪州永續經濟貢獻更大成長和價值。

他披露，MRL於2020

年1月14日的一項文告中證實，文德甲至巴生港口路線經森州和布城行政中心的路线图，將在經過路段進行公共展示，以在3個月內獲取公眾反饋和建議。

黃思漢強調，這證明了MRL和雪州府，已對C段路線達成了決議，即將經過雪州南部。

他認為，有鑒於此，州府維持把一小部分瓜冷北森林保留地從州府撤出的決定，以保留作為東鐵路線用途，是合乎時宜、也符合州府堅持東鐵南線的立場。

歡迎瓜冷北林地重納憲報 能源部促2單位助維護

(八打灵再也15日讯)能源及天然资源部长拿督斯里达基丁说，该部对雪州政府议决重新将瓜拉冷岳北部森林保留地 (HSKLU) 纳入宪报一事表示欢迎。

他今日发文告指出，该部已经指示大马半岛森林局和地质矿物局 (JMG) 给予合作，协助雪州政府保护和维持瓜拉冷岳北部森林保留地，以确保当地作为泥炭沼泽森林 (Hutan Paya Gambut)，维持生态系统的功能受到保护，同时防止火灾。

他指出，该部也欢迎雪州政府议决，早前取代纳入宪报的另579.64公顷的土地，即双溪班让森林永久保留区、布鲁特鲁西部 (Buluh Telur Barat) 森林永久保留区、布鲁特鲁东部 (Buluh Telur Timur) 森林永久保留区以及武来岸 (Broga) 森林永久保留区的地段，不会撤出宪报地位，反而会持续归类为永久保留森林。

“这也符合大马政府的愿景，即按照在国际上的承诺，确保我国至少50%的土地面积被森林覆盖。”

他说，该部也欢迎各方包括非政府组织和当地社区，参与维护该森林保留地。

雪州瓜冷北部森林保留地从宪报中撤除引起各界挾伐后，雪州大臣拿督斯里阿末鲁丁随后发文告指，雪州行政会议开会拍板定案，会重新将该保留地纳入宪报中，惟只有少部分地段依旧会保留给原住民村落及作为兴建东海岸铁路计划 (ECRL) 路线用途。
