MPS removes barriers in residential areas for flouting guideline



MPS enforcement officers removing the barriers from two residential areas, which the council said were not in compliance with MPS' gated-and-guarded scheme guideline.

A TEAM from the Selayang Municipal Council (MPS) carried out an operation to remove barriers in two residential areas as the structures were not in compliance with MPS' gated-and-guarded scheme guideline.

The team comprised officers from the Enforcement, Engineering and Town Planning departments.

The operation was carried out at Jalan Samudera 7 and Jalan Samudera 9 in Taman Samudera Utara as well as Jalan Wangsa 1/1 in Taman Wangsa Permai.

"At the Taman Samudera Utara

location, enforcement action was taken after MPS found that the barriers were chained and locked, thus preventing the public from using the road and making it difficult for residents to enter and exit the area," said MPS Corporate Communications director Mohamad Zin Masoad in a statement.

"Action was taken to remove the barriers after an internal review showed that the residents association did not submit any application or receive any approval for a gated-and-guarded scheme."

As for the Taman Wangsa Permai location, Mohamad Zin

said MPS took action after checking that the approval for its gated-and-guarded scheme had expired.

"Both operations were carried out under Section 46 1(a) of the Street, Drainage and Building Act 1974 (Act 133) for causing obstruction in a public place," he said.

"We would like to remind all residents associations that if they want to instal barriers in residential areas, they must ensure that their applications comply with the conditions of the gated-and-guarded community scheme set by the council."

WITH the prospect of some 100 new houses looming over their homes, residents of De Puncak Ukay in Taman Ukay Perdana, Ampang, want proof that the development is safe.

They want the Ampang Jaya Municipal Council (MPAJ) to reveal geotechnical and safety reports for the housing project on a steep hillslope in their neighbourhood.

MPAJ had approved the housing project consisting of 100 superlink houses on a Class IV slope in 2018.

Class 1 is the least severe in terms of terrain grading whereby slope angles are less than 15 degrees.

Slopes with angles greater than 35 degrees are classified as Class IV as they pose the highest risk.

De Puncak Ukay Residents Association (DePura) chairman Wan Zaidi Wan Jaafar said that residents had been asking for MPAJ to show them the documents related to the project's safety for the past two years.

"We have been denied access to documents such as slope strengthening procedures, drainage and other geotechnical reports as they claim it is an integrity issue.

"But by not showing us, how can we be sure that it will be safe in the long run?" he asked.

Residents are also questioning the basis of the approval as they claim that it is based on a 2008 application.

Chairman of newly set up Steep Slopes Action Front, Datuk Nik Haidi Nik Mohamad said MPAJ should not have approved the project in 2018, based on a 10-year-old application.

"How can this be when there is a two-year limit to any development order issued?"

Ampang residents want MPAJ to give geotechnical and safety reports for hillslope housing development



De Puncak Ukay residents in Ukay Perdana are concerned about the development of 100 superlink houses on a Class IV slope in their area.

"Under the Guidelines for Hillside and Highland Areas Development Planning 2015, any further project approvals should be subjected to the latest conditions set under the guidelines."

He said that a resident-commissioned geotechnical report did not endorse having such a development on the slopes.

"We are not being emotional by showing our concerns but there is strong evidence to suggest that this development should not go on," said Nik Haidi.

StarMetro previously highlighted residents' concerns in March 21, 2018 ("Uneasy over Ampang hillslope project") and in Nov 5, 2018 ("Residents against hillslope

development").

At that time, MPAJ councillor Suzana Saharudin said she would arrange for a discussion between MPAJ, the developer and residents over the matter but no three-way meeting ever took place.

Zaidi and Nik Haidi said that several dialogue sessions with MPAJ were held but no satisfactory

answers had been forthcoming. "The residents here are the ultimate stakeholders.

"It is not enough for MPAJ to merely say that the project is safe," Nik Haidi emphasised.

Ukay Perdana and Bukit Antarabangsa are landslide-prone areas, the most recent taking place on May 30, when soil erosion at the bottom of a slope caused a retaining wall to collapse, leading to the evacuation of seven families living along Jalan Kelab Ukay 4.

An online petition against the new hillslope project was initiated a week ago by concerned residents.

At press time, almost 2,000 people signed the "We Don't Want Another Landslide In Ulu Klang" petition addressed to MPAJ and Ampang MP Zuraida Kamarudin.

StarMetro has reached out to MPAJ but has yet to receive a reply at press time.

SOME 30,000 accounts in Kuala Langat, Selangor are being supplied water from the Labohan Dagang water treatment plant that has been in operation since November last year.

The plant, which currently operates at a quarter of its full capacity, supplies 50 million litres of water daily (MLD) to users in the region. Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor) chief executive officer Suhaimi Kamaralzaman said the plant was expected to operate at full capacity by 2022 after works to instal the main pipes were completed.

"Before this, water for Kuala Langat users was sourced from the Semenyih 2, Bukit Tampoi and Sungai Selangor plants," he said.

"This meant that if there was a shutdown, users here would be the last to receive water when those plants resumed operation.

"With the Labohan Dagang plant operational, consumers in Kuala Langat will recover their supply faster as the plant is closer to them," he said.

Facility utilises latest extraction technology to treat raw water

He added that the plant was meant to primarily service the Kuala Langat region.

Suhaimi said the Labohan Dagang treatment plant extracted raw water from Sungai Langat downstream.

"This is a new technology in which water is sourced from a river downstream compared to technology in the 1980s that sourced water from upstream.

"There are currently two other plants in Selangor with similar technology, namely Sungai Labu plant in Sepang and Semenyih 2 plant in Dengkil," he said during a media visit to the Labohan Dagang plant.

Also present were Air Selangor corporate communications head Sharizatul Elina Baseri, southern region head Mohd Yunus Othman and plant manager (production) Zulkefly Abdullah.

Separately, Air Selangor has spent RM162.2mil in 2019 to replace 111.8km of aged pipes. The old pipes was the reason for 9.6 burst-pipe cases per 100km. The works had the effect of reducing non-revenue water (NRW) to 29.6% last year, a 2% decrease from 2018, Suhaimi highlighted.

"This was achieved by sensors installation and replacement of

aged pipes and meters, which reduced incidents of burst pipes," he said, adding that Air Selangor aimed to reduce NRW by 1% annually.

Servicing 29,270km of water pipes across Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya, Air Selangor manages more than 2,100,000 individual accounts and almost 310,000 industrial accounts.

This was after an agreement between the Federal and Selangor governments to restructure the water supply industry, which made Air Selangor the sole supplier in these states effective Sept 13, 2019. The agreement saw four water

concessionaires — PNSB Water Sdn Bhd that was formerly known as Puncak Niaga (M) Sdn Bhd, Syarikat Bekalan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Syabas), Konsortium Abass Sdn Bhd (Abass), Syarikat Pengeluar Air Sungai Selangor Sdn Bhd (Splash) and Konsortium Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (KASB) — being acquired.

Meanwhile, commenting on the proposed Sungai Rasau plant, Suhaimi said construction was expected to begin early 2022.

"The plant is expected to be completed by end of 2024 or early 2025. "It will extract water from Sungai Klang," he said.
