**Kuala Lumpur:** Pengasas Hot Burger Malaysia, Mohd Asri Hamid atau Asri Janggut, mengesahkan dipanggil polis untuk dirakam keterangan di Ibu Pejabat Polis Kontinjen (IPK) Selangor Selasa ini.

Mohd Asri berkata, ia bagi membantu siasatan kes kegiatan perjudian di Bandar Baru Sungai Buloh, yang ditularkannya sebelum ini.

"IPK Selangor hubungi saya sebentar tadi. Saya diminta untuk hadir beri keterangan di pejabat Bahagian Siasatan Jenayah IPK Selangor.

"Percakapan diambil mengenai kes mesin judi di Sungai Buloh. Saya akan hadir bersama pegawai," katanya pada BH, semalam.

Bulan lalu, Mohd Asri mendakwa dua rakaman video menerusi laman sosial Facebook, berhubung apa yang didakwanya sebagai aktiviti perjudian, penjualan rokok seludup dan perniagaan haram, di Bandar Baru Sungai Buloh.

\* Susulan pendedahan itu, Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM) menahan seorang penggaruh Jabatan Pengurusan dan lapan pegawai Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam (MBSA).

Hasil siasatan Jabatan Integriti Pematuhan Standard (JIPS) Bukit Aman, kemudian mengenal pasti beberapa fakta tidak tepat yang didakwa menerusi video terbabit, selain tiada laporan menunjukkan pegawai dan anggota Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Sungai Buloh terbabit dalam kegiatan berkenaan.

## Kutipan turun, Lzs potong elaun masjid, surau

### BICARA ZAKAT

Oleh HAMIZUL ABDUL HAMID

BARU-BARU ini tersiar di media, elaun masjid di Selangor dipotong. Berita itu menimbulkan perdebatan. Di manakah logiknya ia dipotong. Ada pihak dengan nada sarkastik membidas, demikianlah nasib institusi agama Islam. Tidak habis-habis ditimpai malang.

Lebih menyedihkan kerana ia berpuncu daripada tindakan pengurusan zakat. Maka ada yang berhujah, pusat zakat sepatutnya membantu institusi agama. Apa lagi masjid dan surau adalah rumah Allah SWT. Masakan rumah Allah SWT dibiarakan tanpa dana.

Sebenarnya, tidak sukar untuk membaca naratif di sebalik semua ini. Senarionya sejernih air di dalam akuarium. Begini plotnya. Apabila pandemik Covid-19 melanda, ia sangat mengganggu perekonomian, baik lokal malu pun global. Kesannya, banyak syarikat rugi besar. Banyak perniagaan ditutup. Ramai diberhentikan kerja. Pengangguran meningkat. Ringkas bukan?

Tetapi, apa kaitannya dengan zakat? Ya, kesan berantai fenomena ini kepada zakat ada dua. Pertama,

jumlah pembayar zakat (termasuk kutipan zakat) akan menurun. Kedua, jumlah penerima zakat pula akan meningkat. Jika diibaratkan graf, ia adalah graf yang bersilang. Agihan menukik ke atas, kutipan menjunam ke bawah.

Dalam agihan zakat, Islam mempunyai keutamaannya. Allah SWT menggariskannya di dalam al-Quran, surah at-Taubah ayat ke-60. Ada lapan asnaf dan Allah SWT membahagikannya kepada dua golongan. Golongan pertama yang diutamakan, dan golongan kedua yang ditakhirkan. Istilah fikahnya, asnaf *muqaddam* dan asnaf *muakkhar*.

Asnaf *muqaddam* terdiri daripada fakir, miskin, amil (pengurus zakat) dan mualaf (dilunakkan hatinya kepada Islam). Asnaf *muakkhar* pula terdiri daripada *riqab* (hamba atau orang yang terbelenggu), *gharimin* (orang berhutang), *fisabilillah* (berjihad di jalan Allah) dan *ibnu sabil* (orang yang ketiadaan belanja dalam perjalanan).

Apabila berlaku sesuatu peristiwa luar jangka hingga mengganggu kutipan zakat, pengagihan zakat juga terganggu. Kita ibaratkan seperti pintu yang mempunyai lapan daun pintu, maka apabila ada keperluan mengelakkan mudarab yang lebih besar, maka pintu itu akan ditutup satu persatu.

Pintu yang perlu ditutup lebih awal ialah pintu *ibnu sabil*, kedua (pintu *fisabilillah*), ketiga (pintu *gharimin*), keempat (pintu *riqab*), kelima (pintu *mualaf*), keenam pintu amil, ketujuh sudah tentu (pintu miskin) dan kelapan (pintu fakir). Dengan ini, fakir dan miskin menjadi golongan yang paling lambat terkesan.

Fuqaha membahagikan keperluan manusia mengikut tahap tertentu. Imam as-Syatibi misalnya, membahagikannya kepada tahap *daruriyat* (asasi), *hajiyat* (kesenangan dan kemudahan) dan *tahsiniyat* (kesempurnaan hidup).

Dalam kondisi kutipan zakat yang menyusut, pusat zakat tidak mampu menampung perkara-perkara bersifat *tahsiniyat*. Memberi elaun masjid dan surau adalah perkara *tahsiniyat*.

Masjid dan surau masih mempunyai sumber pendapatannya sendiri. Oleh itu, pihak pengurusan zakat tidak boleh dipersalahkan atas keputusan ini.

Ia adalah suatu tindakan yang betul, memandangkan golongan fakir dan miskin adalah kumpulan manusia paling terjejas dengan kemelut ekonomi hari ini.

## **Borhan, Mohd. Zawawi muka baharu Exco Selangor mulai Sabtu**

**KLANG** – Ahli Dewan Undangan Negeri (ADUN) Tanjung Sepat, Borhan Aman Shah dan ADUN Sungai Kandis, Mohd. Zawawi Ahmad Mughni dilantik sebagai anggota Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri (Exco) Selangor yang baharu berkuat kuasa Sabtu ini.

Bagaimanapun, portfolio bagi kedua-dua mereka dari pada PKR itu akan ditentukan kemudian.

Kedua-dua mereka mengangkat sumpah jawatan di hadapan Sultan Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah di Istana Alam Shah di sini semalam.

Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berakta, portfolio bagi kedua-dua Exco baharu akan diketahui pada minggu depan.

Katanya, tiada rombakan besar-besaran akan dilakukan tetapi hanya melibatkan portfolio yang perlu diganti sahaja.

“Mungkin saya akan umumkan pada minggu hadapan ataupun dalam masa terdekat selepas berbincang dengan pihak-pihak terbabit.

“Rombakan tidaklah ‘major’ (besar) hanya akan melibatkan portfolio yang diganti atau diubah, mungkin melibatkan

portfolio saya dan beberapa Exco yang lain,” katanya selepas majlis angkat sumpah pelantikan tersebut di sini semalam.

Berdasarkan rekod, portfolio yang belum diisi adalah Kebudayaan dan Pelancongan, Peradaban Melayu dan Warisan selepas ADUN Selat Klang daripada Bersatu, Datuk Abdul Rashid Asari ditamatkan pada Mac lalu berikutnya penajaran semula politik di peringkat Persekutuan.

Sementara, portfolio Exco Perumahan dan Kehidupan Bandar kosong selepas ADUN Lembah Jaya, Haniza Mohamed Talha dilucutkan keahliannya daripada PKR pada Julai lalu.

Dalam pada itu, Mohd. Zawawi dalam kenyataannya di sini semalam menzahirkan penghargaan kepada Presiden PKR, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim dan Majlis Pimpinan Negeri susulan mandat dan amanah yang diberikan kepada beliau.

“Saya akan berusaha untuk sentiasa berlaku adil dan sakama tanpa mengira fahaman agama dan politik dan memberi yang terbaik untuk kepentingan rakyat dan pembangunan negeri ini,” katanya.

# Penjara mandatori pesalah alam sekitar

**"KETIADAAN** air memang menyusahkan saya sekeluarga, lebih-lebih lagi kami tidak dimaklumkan lebih awal oleh pihak berkaitan."

Itulah luahan salah seorang penduduk negeri Selangor, Muhd. Rafie Rasol, 29, yang mengeluh akibat insiden terbaru gangguan bekalan air di beberapa daerah di Selangor minggu lalu disebabkan pencemaran Sungai Gong, Rawang.

Isu pencemaran sungai hingga mengakibatkan gangguan bekalan air yang menjelaskan kira-kira 5 juta penduduk di Selangor dan Kuala Lumpur itu bukanlah perkara baru.

Kelemahan penguatkuasaan undang-undang dan kesedaran sesetengah pihak mengenai kepentingan penjagaan kebersihan sungai serta alam sekitar dikatakan punca utama kepada permasalahan ini.

Sikap sesetengah pihak yang suka membuang sampah merata-rata juga mencerminkan betapa pemikiran masyarakat masih lagi terkebelakang.

Selain itu, pembangunan yang

tidak terkawal di kawasan hulu sungai seperti projek pembinaan perumahan dan aktiviti pembuangan sisa kilang juga diperdayai antara punca kepada permasalahan ini berlaku.

Ia secara tidak langsung menunjukkan kelemahan pada sistem pengurusan serta penguatkuasaan pihak berkuasa berkaitan dalam hal ini.

Langkah kerajaan untuk menambah baik Akta Industri Perkhidmatan Air & Akta Kualiti Alam Sekeliling dilihat dapat membendung masalah pencemaran sungai dan alam sekitar yang boleh mengakibatkan kesensaraan kepada masyarakat.

Penasihat Persatuan Aktivis Sahabat Alam, Meor Razak Meor Abdul Rahman berkata, sudah tiba masanya kerajaan mengambil serius permasalahan ini demi kepentingan negara.

Bagaimanapun, beliau menyarankan pihak berkuasa agar menguatkuasakan undang-undang sedia ada terlebih dahulu sebelum penambahbaikan akta dilaksanakan kerajaan.

"Apa yang penting sekarang, pihak berkuasa perlu menguatkuasakan peruntukan undang-undang sedia ada dan jika tambah baik akta sekalipun tapi tiada penguatkuasaan, maka tiada makna ia dipinda.

"Sebagai contoh, di dalam Kanun Tanah Negara jelas menyatakan rizab sungai tidak boleh

diceroboh, tapi kebanyakan daripada kawasan ini telah dibangunkan kerana kelemahan penguatkuasaan," katanya.

Sementara itu, aktivis Alam Sekitar, Profesor Dr. Maketab Mohamed berkata, hukuman penjara mandatori perlu dikenakan kepada mereka yang melakukan pencemaran sungai hingga menjelaskan kepentingan awam.

"Pendek atau panjang tempoh penjara tidak menjadi isu, tapi yang penting adalah hukuman tersebut perlu dilaksanakan secara mandatori mungkin dalam satu hingga lima tahun.

"Jika didapati bersalah, maka tertuduh mesti dipenjarakan baru orang ramai takut," ujarnya.

Selain itu, Maketab menyarankan supaya sistem pengurusan lebih sistematik dapat diwujudkan agar kualiti air sungai dapat pertingkatkan.

"Kaedah lebih sistematik perlu dilaksanakan dengan tidak membenarkan kilang baharu dibina di kawasan hilir sungai sumber air mentah loji rawatan air.

"Sementara kilang-kilang lama terutamanya yang mempunyai air sisa tercemar, perlu diarahkan untuk berpindah bagi meningkatkan kualiti air," jelasnya.

Di samping itu, beliau turut menggesa agar pihak kerajaan mewartakan semua kawasan tadahan air supaya kualiti air sungai mencapai tahap terbaik iaitu kelas 1.

## Antz Gaming Studio nadi para atlet e-Sukan Pulau Pinang

**MEMPUNYAI** minat mendalam terhadap sukan elektronik (e-Sukan) telah memberi ruang kepada anak muda ini mengorak langkah untuk meningkatkan pembangunan industri e-Sukan dalam kalangan peminat permainan video kompetitif itu di Pulau Pinang.

Bekas penuntut Diploma Perbankan Islam di sebuah kolej swasta, Zulhilmi Salim, 29, berkata, dia yang bermula sebagai pemain e-Sukan FIFA memiliki pengalaman selepas menyertai beberapa kejohaan di Pulau Pinang sejak dua tahun lalu.

Malah, Zulhilmi pernah tersenarai sebagai 32 pemain terbaik daripada 200 peserta dalam pertandingan Rah Rah Russia pada tahun 2018.

Menurutnya, idea membuka pusat e-Sukan yang dikenali sebagai Antz Gaming Studio di Bayan Lepas, Pulau Pinang adalah disebabkan sambutan membangunnya terhadap permainan video dalam kalangan anak muda di negara ini.

Katanya yang juga peminat pasukan Liverpool, Antz Gaming merupakan perniagaan keluarga yang diusahakan bersama isteri, Nurin Najmina Fauzi, 30, dan bertujuan untuk menggilap bakat pemain e-Sukan FIFA dan Pro Evolution Soccer (PES) di negeri ini sekali gus melahirkan lebih ramai pemain bertaraf profesional.

"Sejak beroperasi pada Februari tahun ini, lebih 300 pemain e-Sukan telah digilap bakat menuju tiga penganjuran kejohanan FIFA dan PES yang diadakan di studio ini sejak Julai lalu. Terbah-

ru, kami menganjurkan FIFA Malaysia Day yang disertai seramai 22 peserta pada 16 September lalu.

"Menerusi penganjuran sebegini, kita berperluang mengketengahkan e-Sukan ke peringkat lebih tinggi selain melahirkan lebih ramai pemain sukan elektronik yang berasal dari Pulau Pinang," katanya ketika ditemui Kosmo di sini baru-baru ini.

Mengulas lanjut, Zulhilmi mendekah, studio yang berkeluasan 1,400 kaki persegi dengan konsep santai itu juga dijadikan sebagai pusat latihan dua atlet masing-masing bertanding untuk Sukan Malaysia (Sukma)

dan Majlis Sukan Universiti Malaysia (Masum).

"Saya hanya bertindak sebagai pemerhati dan mereka (atlet) menjadikan studio ini sebagai medan latihan sebelum menghadapi perlawanan sebenar."

"Pada masa sama, studio ini juga berpotensi menjadi sebuah platform untuk mengasah bakat pemimin-pemimin sukan elektronik dengan menjadikan atlet sebagai 'role model,'" ujarnya yang turut menambah, sambutan luar biasa diterima daripada pelanggan selepas tempoh Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) fasa pertama Mac lalu.

Mengenai cabaran dalam menyediakan perkhidmatan e-Sukan setanding dengan sukan dunia yang lain serta melahirkan lebih ramai atlet kebangsaan yang beraksi di pentas dunia," jelasnya.

"Tambah Zulhilmi, studio berkembang juga menawarkan perkhidmatan servis, menyewa permainan video PS4 serta menjual cakera padat dan aksesori permainan video."

Jelasnya, Antz Studio Gaming merancang menyediakan konsol permainan video PlayStation 5 (PSS) sebaik dilancarkan November nanti selain mempunyai bilik streaming dan saluran YouTube sendiri.

## Waspada fenomena air pasang besar

**SHAH ALAM** - Penduduk negeri ini yang tinggal di kawasan pesisir pantai atau berhampiran diingatkan berhati-hati terhadap ramalan fenomena air pasang besar dijangka berlaku pada September sehingga November ini.

Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berkata, lima daerah dijangka terkesan akibat fenomena terbabit melibatkan daerah Klang, Kuala Langat, Sepang, Kuala Selangor dan Sabak Bernam.

Menurutnya, ia dijangka melanda pada tarikh 19 dan 20 September sekitar 7.16 pagi dan 7.53 pagi, pada Oktober iaitu pada 17, 18 dan 19 Oktober dalam anggaran jam 6 hingga 7.30 pagi serta pada 15 November dan 16 No-

vember sekitar jam 5.40 pagi dan 6.25 pagi.

“Mengikut maklumat diterima, tahap ketinggian maksimum dijangkakan mencecah 5.8 meter dan juga pada tahap-tahap tertentu,” katanya menerusi siaran video di platform Media Selangor di sini semalam.

Beliau berkata, fenomena itu juga akan mengakibatkan limpah-

an air di kawasan daratan dan berkemungkinan menyebabkan banjir di lokaliti-lokaliti berhampiran laut.

“Mereka yang tinggal berhampiran dengan pantai harus berhati-hati, elakkan aktiviti di tepi pantai dan bersedia dengan sebarang kemungkinan yang mungkin wujud daripada fenomena air pasang besar ini,” katanya.

## Licensed to trade

In a move to help those whose livelihoods have been affected by the Covid-19 pandemic, all local councils in Selangor are offering temporary business permits for street stalls. However, traders are reminded to strictly adhere to the conditions imposed by the respective councils or risk having their licence revoked. >2&3

THE Covid-19 pandemic that led to the movement control order (MCO) in March may have affected many people, with some losing their jobs. While being self-employed is a choice for many, Selangor government has introduced a programme where temporary business permits will be issued by the local councils to Malaysians who wish to set up roadside stalls to sell household items and food.

This is to ensure that they operate within the guidelines and regulations set by the respective local council.

Under normal circumstances, those planning to set up a hawker stall need to apply for a business licence in person at the relevant council. This process takes time.

With the licensing programme which is currently ongoing, council officers visit trading sites and issue the temporary business permits.

This is to help those whose livelihoods have been affected by the pandemic without causing any unnecessary problems.

Selangor local government department's transport and new village development committee chairman Ng See Han said that 10 councils in the state were taking part in the programme and issuing temporary licences.

"This move will help those who are unable to go to work and earn some money to support their families," he said.

"Those who are given business licences must not misuse them and must not rent it out to others," said Ng.

He warned that this was a one-off offer and any illegalities would be taken against culprits.

The traders must also comply with the rules and regulations set by the respective local councils.

"Those who are required to renew their temporary licences and there is no renewal date, do not renew."

"The renewal process at the council will be suspended."

"So far we require the temporary business licence holders to renew every three months," he said.

"Those doing business must file an application for renewals and take the necessary steps," he added.

"On a positive note, Ng said the state government had decided to extend the issuance of temporary business licences until Dec 31 next year.

**Keeping tabs on hawkers**

Over at Shah Alam City Council (MBSA), a total of 689 temporary business licences have been issued to date.

The Licensing Department will carry out regular checks at the sites to ensure hawkers follow regulations and do not encroach on the public space.

We also want to make sure no new stalls pop up at random," said MBSA Corporate Communications head Mohd Firdaus.

He said stall operators must be present during business hours and not allow others to operate on their behalf.

### Business opportunity

At Subang Jaya Municipal Council (MBSA), 689 temporary business licences for roadside hawkers in Subang Jaya have been issued since the MCO.

Segar and five other roadside hawkers also from 1B to 1E have been given temporary business licences and will operate there until MPSA

officers have been

accustomed to accepting an invitation into a suitable location for them.

## MPS charges RM50 for assessment transfer process

EFFECTIVE Oct 1, Selangor Municipal Council (MPS) will be imposing a fee of RM50 for the assessment tax transfer process (Forms I and J).

MPS said in a statement that the fee would be borne by the seller, buyer or property owner's representative, depending on the type of form and transaction.

The transfer process for rateable

holding (*pegangan berkadar*) is based on Section 160 of the Local Government Act 1976 (Act 171), which states that:

- Whenever any rateable holding within a local authority's area is sold or transferred, it shall be the duty of the seller or transferer and the purchaser or transferee, within three months after such sale or transfer, to give notice to the local authority

in Form I of the First Schedule.

- Whenever the owner of any rateable holding within a local authority area dies, it shall be the duty of the person becoming the owner, by succession or otherwise, to give notice to the local authority within a period of one year of the death in Form J of the First Schedule.

Any property owner who fails to give any notice shall, upon conviction,

be liable to a fine not exceeding RM2,000 or be jailed for not more than six months, or both.

Property owners can get a copy of Forms I and J at the Property Management and Valuation Department's counter at MPS' headquarters, MPS branch office counters or via [www.mps.gov.my](http://www.mps.gov.my).

The documents required for the transfer process are as follows:

- A copy of the transferrer or transferee's identity card;
- A copy of the land title, sale and purchase agreement or auction contract (one set); and
- A copy of the latest fully paid assessment tax receipt.

## **Kedah MB negative for Covid-19 after exposure**

**ALOR SETAR:** Kedah Mentri Besar Muhammad Sanusi Md Nor tested negative for Covid-19 after he attended an event where an attendee was later found to have been infected by the virus.

State health director Dr Mohd Fikri Ujang said Sanusi had undergone the test before he left for the Northern Corridor Implementation Authority meeting in Pulau Pangkor, Perak, on Tuesday.

The day before, Sanusi had attended an event in Alor Setar, where a state Information Department photographer who was present later tested positive for the disease. However, Sanusi was not listed as a close contact of the photographer, said Dr Fikri.

"The risk evaluation process will only be done if there are positive cases and only those who are listed as close contacts will be tested.

"Close contact means those who are near a Covid-19-positive person, being less than 1m away for more than 15 minutes," said Dr Fikri.

He advised those who were at the event to contact the Kota Setar health department for evaluation.

Meanwhile, in Petaling Jaya, the Public Works Department (JKR) confirmed that one of its employees was hospitalised after testing positive for Covid-19 on Sept 16.

All the close contacts of the patient among its staff had undergone the necessary health screening and were carrying out self-quarantine at home, it said in a statement.

JKR also released the employee's movement history, including being at its headquarters on Sept 7 to 9 and in Parliament on Sept 10.

On Sept 14, the employee flew to Kuching for a meeting and stayed in Hilton Kuching.

# Selangor is committed to investors

Invest Selangor has taken steps to sustain their confidence during these hard times

**S**ELANGOR remains an attractive investment destination for foreign direct investment (FDI) despite the weak economic environment.

Invest Selangor Bhd chief executive officer Datuk Hasan Azhari Idris said the prospects of FDI inflow this year would depend on how long the Covid-19 pandemic lasts and the effectiveness of policies in mitigating the economic impact.

Hasan said global FDI inflows were expected to plunge 40 per cent this year from US\$1.54 trillion registered last year.

In Asia, such investments were also forecast to fall between 30 per cent and 45 per cent.

“However, despite the negative outlook, Selangor remains an at-

tractive investment destination. “Year to date, we have managed to secure several projects from multinational corporations (MNCs), and many are still in the pipeline,” he told the *New Straits Times* recently.

Hasan said the Covid-19 pandemic had dramatically impacted Selangor, causing a major disruption in FDI inflow.

However he said, Invest Selangor had taken immediate steps to sustain investors’ confidence by providing assistance through a special task force to communicate with the industry and investors.

He also said Invest Selangor had continued to facilitate, manage and provide clarification or recommendations to government agencies under the International Trade and Industry Ministry on essential manufacturers and their supply chain operations during the Movement Control Order (MCO).

“Invest Selangor has also conducted a survey on the impact of MCO on companies in the state.”

The information will help provide an assessment which will be forwarded to the state government for action.”

Before the pandemic, Selangor continued to function as the engine of national economic growth,

recording the biggest contribution to the country’s gross domestic product at 24.2 per cent share last year.

The state also recorded the highest number of approved investments in the country amounting to RM47.8 billion, and the highest number of approved investments in the manufacturing sector valued at RM17 billion last year.

Specifically, 315 manufacturing projects were approved last year, potentially creating 21,085 job opportunities in the state.

Hasan said Selangor is focusing on five core clusters with the highest potential in driving economic growth, in addition to quality investments that provide value-added returns for the people and the state.

The five core clusters are electrical and electronics, transport equipment, life sciences, food and beverage manufacturing, and machinery and equipment.

“According to 2019 statistics by the Malaysian Investment Development Authority (Mida), the combined investment value for the five core clusters rose substantially by

157.28 per cent last year, earning RM10.4 billion.

“The five clusters are driving the state’s economy in attracting investments from Japan, China, Singapore and the United States. The investors are also looking for a location that can offer excellent connectivity into ASEAN markets,” he said.

And Selangor has the qualities to become a gateway to Southeast Asia as a business hub.

Hasan said the strong presence of MNCs and local corporations, such as Spirit AeroSystems, Nestle, IKEA, Panasonic, Q-Cells, KL-Kelpong Oleomas, Nippon Electric Glass, Perodua, Proton, Top Glove and Hartalega, represents a true testimony of what Selangor has to offer.

On top of that, he said Invest Selangor, as the state’s investment promotion agency, will continue to provide facilities and assistance to investors operating in Selangor in these times of uncertainty.

“It is crucial for us to be able to bolster the aftercare aspect of our services to investors as an attempt to retain their presence in the state and restore their confidence.”

According to Hasan, various developments and projects are taking shape in the state, which will elevate Selangor’s position as an ASEAN market gateway.

For instance, IKEA’s new regional distribution and supply chain centre is being developed in Pulau Indah, near Port Klang.

It will be the world’s third-largest distribution centre for the Swedish furniture maker, and it is scheduled to open this month.

Toyota Motor Corp also made Selangor its distribution centre for Southeast Asia, while Volvo AB has made the state capital, Shah Alam, its distribution hub for East Pacific outside China.

“These are some of the indicators that manufacturers have started to move into Selangor as their gateway to this region,” said Hasan.

“With a determined state government and close collaboration among stakeholders, including technical agencies, local councils and federal agencies such as Mida, Selangor will be able to offer a safe and viable option as an investment destination not only in Malaysia, but also the ASEAN region,” he added.

## Selangor asks federal govt to reconsider ECRL route

*Teng says the original proposed routing of the ECRL would benefit land speculators more than it would the state*

SELANGOR is asking the federal government to abandon changes it is set to make to the proposed route of the East Coast Rail Link (ECRL) mega project.

Selangor's executive councillor for investment, industry, commerce and small and medium enterprises Datuk Teng Chang Khim said the federal government's decision to revert to the original proposed route

of the trans-state railway would disrupt development plans for parts of the state. Teng stressed that the water catchment areas of the state ECRL would benefit land speculators more than it would the state.

The previous administration had realigned the ECRL alignment in 2019 and decided on a new route that cuts off Sungai Buloh and will spur the economy on a greater scale.

"However, the current government has changed its mind, which I think will only profit land investors and parcel owners in Bentong and not for the benefit of the people of Selangor and Kuala Lumpur as a whole," Teng told *The Malaysian Reserve* (TMR).

He said if Putrajaya pursues the Section C of the alignment, the plan to reroute the ECRL through Bentong, Pahang and Gombak,

"We had three engagements that resulted in the diversions of the routes to the south in Negeri Sembilan, with the intention that it will then spread the economy on a greater scale.
