Abdul Hadi juga memberi reaksi sama manakala Vigneswaran sekadar memaklumkan datang untuk makan. Utusan Malaysia difahamkan pertemuan itu hanya berkisar persidangan hari ini, selain memberi tumpuan kepada Belanjawan 2021 yang dijadual akan dibentangkan pada Jumaat.

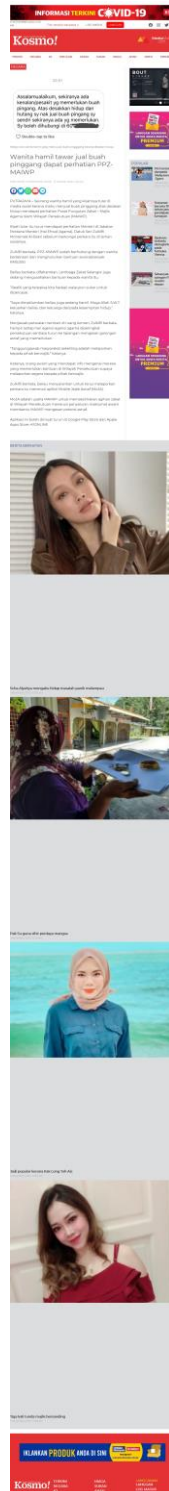

Water disruption prevented

Luas' swift action in Sg Kuang stops river water from being polluted

KLANG Valley folk were spared another water supply disruption, thanks to the quick action by Selangor Water Management Board (Luas), which mitigated the inflow of odorous soot into the waterways of Sungai Kuang.

The soot was from a fire at a plastic processing factory at Sonstar Industrial Park in Rawang.

Yesterday, in its Facebook page, Luas said the odour pollution in Sungai Kuang was measured at three TON (threshold odour number).

Subsequent tests at three locations showed readings of less than one TON each, while at Sungai Kundang, the reading was at 0 TON.

Luas said continuous monitoring would be conducted to ensure no odour pollution in Sungai Selangor.

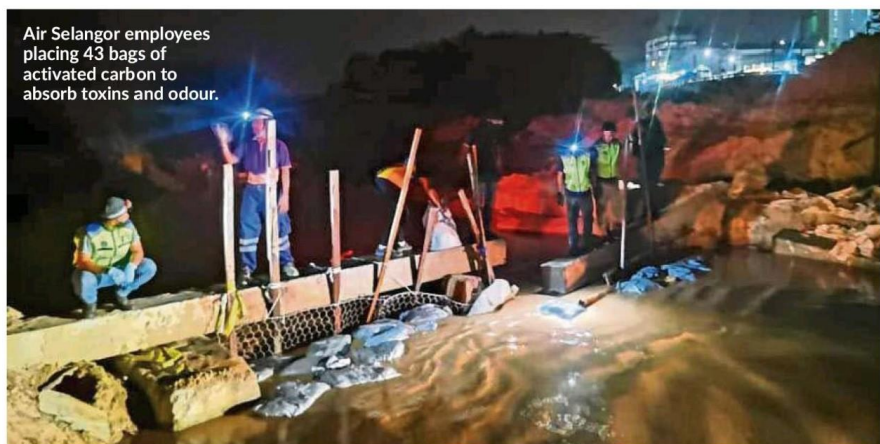
The water management board also reported that the factory had been issued a water protection order under Section 122 of the Selangor Water Management Authority Enactment 1999.

The order requires the factory owner to cease from further acts that can pollute the river. Non-compliance will subject the factory owner to a fine no more than RM50,000 or jailed not exceeding one year or both, upon conviction.

The factory owner also faces further fines of RM3,000 for each day the offence continues until the order is revoked.

Selayang Municipal Council (MPS) was also said to have issued a public nuisance notice to the owner of the premises and requested that cleaning work be carried out immediately.

The timely intervention by Luas was made possible with the establishment of its Skwad Pantas which performs 24-hour monitoring of



Sungai Selangor, Sungai Langat and Sungai Klang.

Selangor environment, green technology, science, technology and innovation and consumer affairs committee chairman Hee Loy Sian, in a statement, said Luas was alerted of the situation when its round-the-clock monitoring team was informed of the incident from the Selangor Fire and Rescue Department at 10pm on Saturday.

Following checks at the site, it was found that fire waste was flowing into the drains and waterways of nearby Sungai Kundang, a tributary of Sungai Kuang.

Hee said site images from Luas' social media page showed a thick, black, lava-like substance smothering the water surface.

A response unit comprising personnel from the Luas Ops Water Source surveillance team, Air Selangor and MPS built an earth bund to prevent further inflow of the soot into the river.

Hee said the barricade effectively

stopped the flow of odorous pollution to Sungai Sembah, which lead directly to Sungai Selangor where the Rantau Panjang Water Treatment Plant is located.

The distance of the factory and water treatment plant, he added, was only about 33km.

Air Selangor has placed 43 bags of activated carbon at the source of the fire waste to absorb toxins and odour.

Batu Arang Fire and Rescue Station senior Fire Officer 2

Aminuddin Derani, who was on duty at the scene, said seven fire-fighting teams from Sungai Buloh, Bestari Jaya, Rawang, Subang, Sungai Pinang and Petaling Jaya were called to the scene.

The factory fire was put out at about 4.30am, he said, adding that the cause of the fire was still not known.

He said no one was injured in the fire but 90% of the factory was damaged, adding that foam had been used as a retardant.

Klang council urges engineers to design innovative road markings

ROAD markings can be used to encourage motorists to exercise care for other road users and emphasise safety habits.

Klang Municipal Council (MPK) president Dr Ahmad Fadzi Ahmad Tajuddin said the council's road engineers must innovate common painted road line designs to make this possible.

"Our environment has been going through unprecedented change and we use smartphones to navigate new neighbourhoods.

"Most of the time, we are taken through shorter routes that bring us into housing areas. Innovative road designs that are interactive

will guide motorists and improve public safety," he said after a full board meeting.

"Road users now are different from motorists three decades ago.

"With the movement control order (MCO) still in effect, many food delivery riders can be seen weaving through traffic and this is where new road line designs can influence better behaviour among motorists."

Fadzi added that innovative road lines could be combined with thermoplastic special paint that was luminous to create an interactive and sustainable method to better guide traffic at night.

"Council employees must understand the people's needs and offer the right solutions to these prob-

lems," he said.

He added that MPK's Engineering Department, Planning Department and Corporate Communications Department must hold a brainstorming session.

"We can learn from Petaling Jaya City Council's engineering department, which innovated and standardised the construction of road humps with the hump-fit contraption," he said.

Earlier, Lee Fu Haw, 39, who served as councillor from 2014 to 2018, was sworn in to serve as councillor once again until December 2022.

Lee will oversee Pulau Ketam, Bagan Hailam and Bandar Sultan Suleiman in Port Klang. He said his first task was to

resolve the issue of industrial rubbish in Bandar Sultan Suleiman and help people engage with the council on various basic amenities.

On the 31 *pasar pagi* and *pasar malam* trading areas in Klang that were not reopened because of the conditional MCO, Fadzi said reopening would take place gradually

in stages as the operators need to be cautioned and briefed on the strict standard operating procedures (SOP).

"The SOP is important and we need all traders and market-goers to comply with it.

"We cannot afford to be lax," he said.

EFFECTIVE contact tracing is necessary if we are to contain Covid-19. And for that to happen, Malaysians will have to be willing to share some of their personal data with the authorities — their names, contact details and the places they visit.

It, however, also underscores how important it is for those collecting the data to ensure that the information they use is secure and safe from misuse.

For this to happen, three basic principles must be observed: data protection, law support and individual privacy.

On Malaysia's frequently asked questions (FAQ) section on its website, the government assures the public that their personal information "will only be used for the purpose of managing and mitigating the Covid-19 outbreak" and that it will not be shared with any other party.

The app was developed through a strategic cooperation between the NSC, the Health Ministry, MAMPU, the Multimedia Commission (MCMC) and Science, Technology and Innovation Ministry (MSTI).

By October, nationwide registration of MySejahtera reached more than 60% of the country's population. This is welcome news because 60% is the threshold for an effective contact tracing ecosystem according to a recent Oxford University study.

Your data or your life: Can we have both?

With no foreseeable end in sight yet for the Covid-19 pandemic, some Malaysians are growing concerned about the long-term accumulation of their personal data for contact tracing.

Director, says Abu Bakar. The PDPA regulates the processing of personal data in commercial transactions and protects personal data from being abused. The general principle behind the Act is that any processing of your personal data requires your consent. The penalty for non-compliance is a fine of between RM100,000 to 500,000 and/or between 1 to 5 years' jail.

In the case of Covid-19, the PDPA has provisions which allow for the collection of necessary data in situations which require the protection of "vital interests" relating to the life, death or security of the data subject.

A contentious aspect of the PDPA is that Section 3(1) states that the Act does not apply to the federal and state governments.

"I have been arguing against the exemption since the Act was enacted in 2010. It is not in line with international standards to give exemptions under the PDPA to the public sector and Government. It is high time for us to amend the Act," says Abu Bakar, who was one of the advisers during the drafting of the law.

Abu Bakar also emphasises the importance of efficient enforcement.

"The Department of Personal Data Protection (DPDP) has issued guidelines for businesses on how to manage the data that they have collected, but we do not know how well these individuals comply with the guidelines. Who are those using charge, who are those collecting the data, what are they going to do with it and how long will they keep it?" he asks.

There is concern that while businesses may not have any intention to misuse data, the way the data is stored may still not be secure. For example in September, a group of people posed a Health Ministry personnel and stole Covid-19 record books from businesses' premises around Melaka.

PDPA's adoption was based on data as a reference for business owners. It listed non-Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for contact tracing data collection, processing and storage.

Among the directives imposed (DPI) to that businesses were only allowed to record names, contact numbers, and date and time of visit. While temperature checks are necessary to enter a premise, body temperature does not have to be recorded or stored down as it is sensitive personal data and its recording requires express consent

from the data subject. Personal data collected at business premises to facilitate contact tracing during the Covid-19 pandemic should be deleted or destroyed six months after the end of the government control order (MCO).

However, due to the continuous extension of the MCO, PDPA will be issuing another advisory which will provide further clarifications on how to dispose collected personal data as it is currently seeking input from MAMPU and NSC on the allowable retention period for contact tracing data.

Cross-agency effort to step up data protection

PDPA reassures the public that it has been working closely with other law enforcement agencies and technical entities to guarantee the personal data ecosystem would thrive in Malaysia.

"The Covid-19 outbreak has ignited up new ways on how we approach problems and tasks in hand. PDPA is always keeping abreast and being well equipped with new methodologies and technologies to combat any issues related to privacy," the department said in response to queries.

By Sanjay Sagar, a data scientist at the Health Ministry has reiterated many times through different platforms such as daily briefings and social media that the collected personal data would only be used for contact tracing while businesses entities were given consent to store their data for contact tracing purposes other than contact tracing.

In terms of enforcement, the department has conducted 804 inspections in total as of Oct 2 on business premises throughout Malaysia through tabung and

Sarawak to ensure full compliance on the issued advisory.

"PDPA enforcement teams have also conducted investigations on formal complaints received from the general public wherever their personal data were being used for other purposes such as direct marketing, spam or, by the Data Officer," he adds.

A meeting was conducted on June 19 between PDPA, the Health Ministry, NSC, National Cyber Security Agency (NCSA), Selangor State Government and Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DKL) to gather feedback on their contact tracing initiatives. During the meeting, a Personal Data Protection Commissioner urged the parties to adopt the 7 Data Protection Principles and embedded them in their contact tracing applications.

"Although Section 3 of the Personal Data Protection Act 2010 (Act 709) states on the non-application of Act 709 to the Federal and State Governments, by adopting these Principles, they would send a firm message to the general public on the Government's commitment to safeguard the collected personal data and only for the purpose of contact tracing," it says.

Address issues of transparency

Because the data collected goes straight into the app, there is a low risk for businesses to misuse the information. However, lawyer Adlin Abdul Majid, who specialises in data protection, believes that there are still issues that need to be addressed such as introducing

more transparency in how the Government uses the information collected by MySejahtera.

"App like MySejahtera are OK as long as the Government doesn't misuse it. The issue with the PDPA is that the government is exempt from that law. What we need to do is to introduce amendments to make the PDPA also apply to federal and state governments," she says.

"When it comes to public health, concerns and data protection, it is not a case where one wins over the other. Both are necessary but the key is that we need to have laws in place to regulate the use of data."

"It is not wrong for the Government to collect information for contact tracing, but there should be protection mechanisms in place," he explains.

Adlin adds that one of the amendments being looked into is the application of PDPA on the Government.

In August, the Government said that it is currently in consultation with relevant agencies to see if there is a need to amend the PDPA. This was in response to a Parliament question tabled by former Communications and Multimedia Minister Gobind Singh Deo on whether provisions taken to ensure personal data collected through Covid-19 contact tracing applications was secure.

Selangor's Budget 2021 aims to generate 15,000 job opportunities

The state also aims to elevate the start-up scene by allocating RM100m under the SIF and RM200m to solve its water crisis

SELANGOR Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said the state Budget 2021 is able to create 15,000 job opportunities for the people of Selangor, especially those who are badly hit by the Movement Control Order (MCO) as a result of the pandemic.

Among the state's effort to generate more job opportunities is through the "Selangor Kerjaya" initiative which targets to provide 10,000 vacancies that are suitable with the Industrial Revolution 4.0 via upskilling and reskilling. The targeted groups for this initiative are university and high school graduates including those with vocational training and employees who were laid off.

Selangor also aims to elevate the start-up scene by allocating RM100 million under the Selangor Innovation Fund (SIF).

The initiative will identify potential technology start-up companies in Selangor to be given venture capital investment.

"It has the potential to support the third economic stimulus package where the targeted group is technology start-up companies that can bring in the latest technology to lead the transformation of Smart State 2025 and develop new economic growth in the state," he said.

To further develop Selangor as a smart state, Amirudin said the leaders wish for the state to have the widest 5G network coverage.

Widest 5G Network

Under the pilot project titled SMARTSEL, the government has allocated RM3 million to develop 5G infrastructure at the Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Building, which is Selangor's state secretariat building, to ease operations for employees, as well as the public who are in the building and around the premises.

Meanwhile, noting the need to uplift and motivate small businesses, Amirudin announced the "Niaga Darul Ehsan" initiative which enables budding entrepreneurs and hawkers to apply for licence from local authorities to

run their businesses without having to submit a certificate from the Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM).

"They are also qualified to apply for loans from as low as RM1,000 until RM3,000 without having to have a permanent premise such as online businesses.

"However, these traders still need to get a certificate from SSM within six months. If they fail to do so, their licence from the local council will not be renewed," he added.

Amirudin also announced that the state government has agreed to give a half month salary incentive to civil servants Grade 54 and below as a token of appreciation for their efforts and commitments.

He said the incentive under "Bantuan Khas Kewangan" (BKK) totalling RM16.53 million will be paid on Dec 29, 2020.

It will be the second round of BKK for the civil servants. The first round of the incentive was executed in June where all Grade 54 civil servants and below received an incentive of RM1,000.

As the pandemic hampered operations in the entertainment industry, Amirudin announced a reduction in entertainment tax from 25% to 15%, which will be enforced on Jan 1, 2021, specifically for the organisation of arts activities or ticketed events for local artists.

"With this initiative we hope it

would help the local entertainment industry increase productivity, quality and competency to be better than foreign artists," he said.

Solutions for Water Pollution

Touching on the water crisis that has plagued Selangor over the years especially during the MCO this year, the state government has allocated RM200 million in the state's budget solely to solve water pollution issues.

The first solution highlighted by Amirudin is to implement an amendment in the Selangor Water Management Authority (LUAS) Enactment 1999 to increase the fine for polluting water sources. "The proposal to amend the

LUAS Enactment will be brought up to get an approval in the state legislative assembly sitting," he said.

Amirudin had previously said the state government will push to double the penalty for water pollution from RM500,000 to RM1 million.

Other solutions include the implementation of the Bio Remediation Project for the conservation of Sungai Gong's water quality. The pilot project will be replicated at Sungai Sembah, Sungai Beranang and Sungai Buah, which were identified as the main source for pollution at Sungai Selangor and Sungai Langat.

The Selangor government will also enable a 24 hour surveillance at sensitive water sources areas such as Lembangan Sungai Selangor and Sungai Langat, and it will also implement raw water pumping project from HORAS 600 reservoir in Sungai Selangor and Sungai Semenyih to ensure Phases 1, 2, and 3 of the Sungai Selangor Water Treatment Plants (LRA), Rantau Panjang LRA and Semenyih LRA will not stop operations when water pollution occurs.

"The state government had allocated RM200 million for the implementation of these four projects which will commence this year and is expected to complete within 18 months.

"We are confident this will reduce up to 90% risks for Phases 1 and 2 of the Sungai Selangor LRA, Rantau Panjang LRA and Semenyih LRA 1 and 2 to stop operating which will cause water disruptions to 1.6 million users due to the pollution," said Amirudin.

The Selangor government unveiled its Budget 2021 worth RM2.32 billion last Friday, slightly lower than the budget allocated for this year which was RM2.33 billion.

Amirudin said 53% of the total, or RM1.22 billion is allocated for administrative cost, while the remaining 47% or RM1.1 billion will go towards development expenses.

"Taking into account the state revenue of RM2.2 billion and an estimated budget of RM2.32 billion, the 2021 budget will face a deficit of RM123 million due to a substantive development allocation to meet the needs of sustainable development."

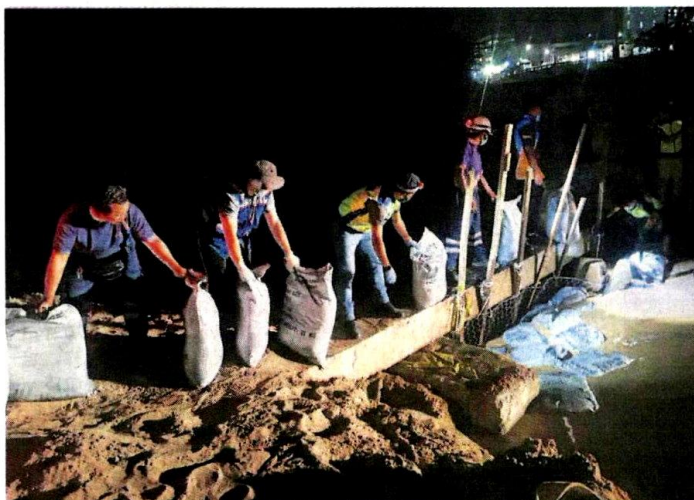

上述事件起因于一名网友在“巴生人”专页发布2张照片,还在贴文中写道“各位巴生人,我想问看看这是什么作用?”,随即引起各大网民的关注与共鸣,在短时间内就累积327次赞、157条评论及41次分享。

留言处更有网民调侃该路堤作用为“防止水沟流入马路”、“肥水不留别人田”等等让人啼笑皆非的留言。
 《大都会》社区报记者依据网民的留言电访负责卫星市区域的巴生市议员黄智荣,他表示,根据该贴文的讯息,贴主指是在百家利;但恰好卫星市也正在进行有关提升道路及排水道的工程。

他说,据照片,该处是正在进行排水道的提升工程,但由于仍未施工完毕,才会让该名网民不晓得该路堤的用途;因此希望该网民给予地方政府耐心,待施工完毕后就会恢复该有的面貌。

他补充,虽然图片中的工程并不是他所负责的区域,但相信该工程也还未施工完毕,否则一般上市议会是不会有这样的疏忽事件的。

另一方面,黃智榮表示,目前在他负责的区域范围也正进行有关提升排水道及行人道的工程,因此他也促请民众若看见一些结构怪异的工程,请不要惊讶,并希望民众能耐心等待施工完毕。

老婦意外墜溝死 州議員速修溝填平

(巴生31日讯)疑路边沟渠暗藏危机而酿成命案，班达马兰州议员梁德志马上拨款展开维修工作。

班达马兰新村占布路 (Jalan Jambu) 逾20年来越铺越高，导致路面和毗邻沟渠不均，容易造成脚车骑士因道路倾斜而掉入沟渠。

其中约3个月前就曾有一名70岁老妇不幸掉入沟渠内，以致昏迷不醒长达1周后离世，令家人非常悲痛。

道路沟渠高度不一致

梁德志是在出席老妇丧礼时向其家属了解情况后，马上拨款展开维护沟渠的工作，改善沟渠的设计，避免再酿任何悲剧，并呼吁市民若遇到基建问题，应尽快和他服务中心接洽。

他说，他当时马上到该路段了解情况，发现道路经多年铺路后已越铺越高，导致两旁的杂草泥地，向沟渠方向倾斜。

“民众骑脚车经过路边草地时，容易因失去平衡而倒向沟渠的方向，不慎坠入沟渠内，尤其是当地长者多，多数都是骑脚车，脚比较没有力。”

他说，他动用州议员约2万令吉拨款，在经过县土地局的同意后，就马上展开改善沟渠的工程。

“我们重建洋灰沟渠，然后把两旁的草地填平，和沟渠的高度一致；目前所涉及的工程共有两条道路，即占布路和美兰迪路 (Jalan Meranti)，全长224尺，工程在前天展开，估计一周内

可竣工。”

他希望居民一旦发现任何基本建设有安全隐患，可以马上向他投报，让他尽快做出改善与安排，避免类似悲剧再发生，毕竟当局未必察觉到问题。

陈志昇： 母亲坠沟脊椎重创

当地居民陈志昇 (36岁) 指出，母亲林玉是在3个月前经过该路段时，不幸坠入沟渠内，随后被邻居发现。他并不知事情的发生经过，但母亲被发现时已坠入沟渠内，且已经昏迷。

“母亲脊椎重创以致当场昏迷不醒，送医院抢救一周后，最终宣告不治。”

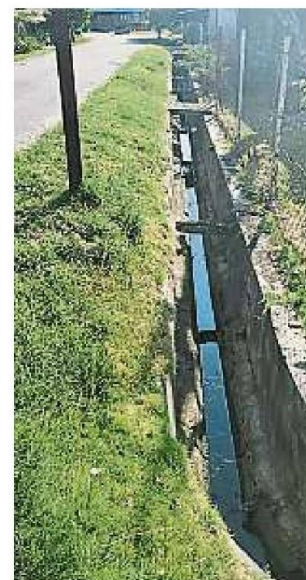
他说，根据当地邻居告知，该路段已经是黑区，一直以来都有不少人跌倒。

他们申诉,市议会官员在派通知信时,也没有向他们表明垃圾承包商收垃圾的时间,对部分迟开店的业者造成不便,担心错过承包商收取垃圾的时间。

“官员当时说明可向市议会购买垃圾桶,惟要价是250令吉一个,也可以自行购买,但必须是240公升垃圾桶及拖拉式,垃圾桶的市价是150至250令吉之间。”

他们指出,市议会是在三四个月前发出这项通知,当时有业者担心被罚款,继而纷纷购买,惟其中有部分业者的垃圾桶不幸被偷走,其他业者听闻后都在垃圾桶上锁链。

不过,也有业者表示,置放垃圾桶能维持商业区的环境整洁,因此是可以接受的。

设计，以避免再酿任何的悲剧，并呼吁市民若遇到基建问题，请尽快和他服务中心接洽。梁德志说，在丧礼后，他马上到该路段了解情况，发现道路在经过多年铺设后已越铺越高，导致两旁的杂草泥地，倾斜向沟渠方向去。

他说，这导致很多骑脚车经过该路段的骑士很容易失去平衡而倒向沟渠的方向，不慎坠入沟渠内，尤其是当地老人家多，而且多数都是骑脚车，脚比较没有力，很容易就坠入沟渠。

他说，在经过县土地局的同意后，他动用州议员拨款，马上展开改善沟渠的工程。他说，希望居民一旦发现任何基本建设有安全隐患，可以马上向他投报，让他尽快做出改善的安排，以

避免类似悲剧再发生，毕竟有时当局并没有察觉到。

另一方面，不幸坠沟逝世的林玉的儿子陈志升 (36岁) 表示，母亲是在3个月前经过该路段时，不幸坠入沟渠内，随后被邻居发现。

“我不知道事情的发生经过，母亲是在沟渠内被人发

现，当时她已经昏迷，医生后来诊断她脊椎重创，母亲入医院一周抢救后，最终宣告不治。”

他说，根据当地邻居告知，该路段已经是黑区，一直以来都有不少人跌倒。(LPP)
