## 38 penduduk flat ditawar pangsapuri RM300,000

**Kuala Lumpur:** Ritzy Gloss Sdn Bhd, anak syarikat Suez Capital Sdn Bhd iaitu pemaju yang menjalankan usaha sama Projek Pembangunan Semula Kampung Sungai Baru, Kampung Baru menawarkan pangsapuri bernilai RM300,000 kepada 38 penduduk flat Perbadanan Kemajuan Negeri Selangor (PKNS) yang masih belum menerima tawaran dibuat sebelum ini.

Pengarah Ritzy Gloss Sdn Bhd, Abdul Hadi Ahmad, berkata pangsapuri yang akan dibina di lokasi sama dengan pembangunan semula itu dikenali sebagai

Pakej Harmoni mewarkan kediaman 900 kaki persegi.

Katanya, penduduk berkenaan boleh memiliki kediaman lengkap tiga bilik, dua bilik air dan satu petak tanah untuk keperluan itu, dengan separuh harga daripada pampasan pengambilan tanah yang bakal diterima mereka.

"Sebagai contoh jika pemilik menerima pampasan pengambilan tanah RM250,000, mereka bo-

leh memiliki Pakej Harmoni dengan harga RM125,000 sahaja.

"Jika proses pengambilan tanah selesai tahun ini dan dilanjutkan pelan pembangunan siap tahun hadapan, kediaman berkenaan dijangka siap dalam tempoh tiga hingga empat tahun akan datang," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian pada sidang media berkenaan status isu Projek Pembangunan Semula

Sungai Baru di sini, semalam.

Turut hadir, Pengurus Persatuan Pemilik Hartanah Kampung Sungai Baru (PPHKS), Zulfakar Wahid.

Baru-baru ini, sebahagian penduduk Kampung Sungai Baru melahirkan rasa kecewa apabila mendakwa pampasan ditawarkan dianggap tidak munasabah kerana tidak mencukupi untuk membeli kediaman baharu.

Abdul Hadi berkata, beliau berharap penduduk terbabit menerima tawaran berkenaan bagi mempercepatkan lagi proses pengambilan tanah seterusnya me-

mulakan projek berkenaan.

"Mereka harus akur dengan jumlah ditetapkan dengan nilai pampasan yang dibuat oleh JKPTG WPKL."

"Ini kerana mereka tidak boleh samakan nilai kediaman mereka dengan kediaman di Kampung Baru kerana lokasi berbeza," katanya.

Sementara itu, Zulfakar berkata, ketika ini hanya 38 pemilik flat tidak bersetuju dengan tawaran berkenaan, manakala sebanyak 85 peratus pemilik lagi sudah bersetuju dengan tawaran awal yang dibuat sejak 2016.

# Siasatan ambil tanah ditangguh

**Pemaju, pemilik flat PKNS Sungai Baru mahu runding capai persetujuan**

**Kuala Lumpur:** Siasatan pengambilan tanah di flat Perbadanan Kemajuan Negeri Selangor (PKNS) Sungai Baru, Kampung Baru ditangguhkan ke tahun depan.

Perbadanan Pembangunan Kampung Baru (PKB) memaklumkan, ia hasil rundingan bersama Jabatan Ketua Pengarah Tanah dan Galian Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur (JKPTGWPKL), pemaju dan pemilik lot atau flat PKNS Sungai Baru berhubung isu berkenaan.

Katanya, keputusan itu bagi membolehkan rundingan di antara pemaju dan pemilik flat PKNS Sungai Baru mencapai persetujuan sewajarnya.

"Kementerian Wilayah Persekutuan (KWP) melalui PKB bertindak sebagai fasilitator bagi membantu melancarkan pelaksanaan pembangunan semula ini selaras fungsinya yang dinyatakan dalam Akta

Perbadanan Pembangunan Kampong Bharu (Akta 733).

"Menteri Wilayah Persekutuan akan sentiasa berusaha untuk membantu bagi memastikan rundingan di antara pemaju dan pemilik lot atau flat terbabit berjalan dengan harmoni," katanya dalam kenyataan, semalam.

Isu pengambilan tanah Kampung Baru kembali hangat apabila kerajaan didakwa menggunakan Akta Pengambilan Tanah 1960 (Akta 486) di kawasan segi tiga emas di ibu kota itu untuk dimajukan dengan pampasan hanya RM400 sekaki persegi.

Rancangan pembangunan semula itu meliputi kawasan penduduk yang mendiami dua jenis kediaman, iaitu flat PKNS dan rumah di tanah persendirian.

Difahamkan, 70 peratus pemilik di kawasan terbabit diakwa bersetuju dengan pembangunan semula kawasan berkenaan dan memberikan tandatangan.

Pada Ogos lalu, beberapa penduduk yang belum menuarkan tandatangan dilaporkan menerima notis siasatan mengikut Borang F Akta Pengambilan Tanah 1960 yang meminta mereka hadir secara bergilir pada 23 hingga 26 Ogos untuk diambil keterangan penilaian oleh PTG.

Penduduk rumah flat PKNS itu dikatakan mendapat keputusan pampasan antara RM200,000 hingga RM250,000.

## Kasih Sultan kepada rakyat

**SHAH ALAM:** Tiga perkara boleh disimpulkan menjadi perhatian Sultan Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah sepanjang tahun ini iaitu wabak Covid-19, isu rasuah dan alam sekitar.

Walaupun tiada aktiviti baginda mencemar duli bersama rakyat jelata seperti menzahirahi kampung atau mengunjungi mereka di tempat-tempat awam ekoran pandemik yang melanda, media sosial menjadikan 'jambatan' mendekatkan rakyat dengan raja mereka.

Isu Covid-19 sering kali disentuh baginda dalam menasihati rakyat supaya sentiasa mematuhi prosedur operasi standard (SOP) pencegahan wabak dan mengambil suntikan vaksin untuk mengurangkan jangkitan.

Malah, tidak terlepas satu detik pun nasihat berkaitan wabak itu dikongsikan Sultan Sharafuddin termasuk perkongsian menerima suntikan vaksin dos pertama pada 20 Mac dan kedua pada 10 April bagi meyakinkan rakyat.

Selain itu, baginda amat

mengikuti rapat isu wabak tersebut apabila berkenan menerima menghadap dua Menteri Kesihatan, Datuk Seri Adham Baha pada 29 Mac lalu yang

membawa berita gembira kepada penduduk Selangor khususnya di Kapar, Klang apabila memaklumkan tentang pembinaan hospital awam di sana.

Kemudian, baginda sekali lagi dikunjungi Menteri Kesihatan, Khairy Jamaluddin Abu Bakar pada 18 Oktober 2021. Pada kedua-dua pertemuan itu Sul-

tan Sharafuddin menzhirkan kebimbangan terhadap penularan wabak, namun suacita apabila semakin ramai rakyat khususnya penduduk di Selangor menerima suntikan vaksin.

Justeru, disebabkan kebimbangan itu juga yang dalam masa sama perisytiharan darurat oleh Kerajaan Persekutuan pada 10 Januari hingga 1 Ogos lalu, pelbagai usaha dilakukan baginda untuk memastikan ke-sejahteraan rakyat.

Antara dilakukan Sultan Sharafuddin bersama Tengku Permaisuri Selangor, Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin serta Raja Muda, Tengku Amir Shah adalah menyerahkan sumbangan kepada rakyat yang penerimaannya seperti penduduk Kampung Orang Asli Pulau Carey serta golongan asnaf fakir miskin.

Nasib pelajar asnaf turut dibela apabila sebanyak 7,000 menerima bantuan tablet melalui Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS) bagi memudahkan mereka belajar secara dalam talian ketika pelaksanaan Pengajaran dan Pembelajaran di Rumah (PdPR).

Isu rasuah turut mendapat perhatian baginda apabila sering menekankan 'barah' itu dalam satu kenyataan yang dikeluarkan oleh Setiausaha Sulit Sultan Selangor, Datuk Mohamad Muinir Bani apabila ramai pegawai dan kakitangan kerajaan negeri terlibat masalah terabit.

Malah, menjauhi amalan rasuah ditegaskan sekali lagi oleh baginda ketika merasmikan pembukaan Sidang Dewan Undangan Negeri (DUN) Segar Penggal Ke-4 pada 23 Ogos lalu dan menitahkan Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM) menjalankan penyiasatan menyeluruh bagi membersihkan negeri itu daripada rasuah.

Isu alam sekitar juga menjadi perhatian Sultan Sharafuddin dan ketika merasmikan pembukaan Sidang DUN pada 23 Ogos lalu, baginda menegaskan hutan simpan di negeri itu mestilah dikekalkan tidak kurang dari pada 30 peratus.

Perkara itu ditegaskan selepas terdapat isu penyahwartaan hutan simpan dibangkitkan seperti Hutan Simpan Kuala Langat Utara (HSKLU) yang melibatkan penempatan masyarakat Orang Asli di Kuala Langat.

Begitu kasihnya baginda kepada rakyat, tanpa mengira kaum. Pelbagai isu disentuh baginda demi kesejahteraan rakyat Selangor.

# Help the rakyat, says Sultan

Ruler dismayed over intense politicking amid multiple crises

**SHAH ALAM:** Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah has expressed dismay over the relentless politicking in the face of multiple crises currently plaguing the country.

The Sultan of Selangor admonished politicians who were still "going at each other" instead of addressing challenges brought on by the Covid-19 pandemic, which has affected the people's health, triggered an economic slowdown and political instability – a triple whammy for Malaysia.

"They are too busy fighting one another and have neglected efforts to overcome the problems caused by the pandemic.

"This is what's happening," the Ruler said in an exclusive interview with *The Star* in conjunction with his 76th birthday.

His Royal Highness revealed that ordinary citizens suffering from hardships were now turning to him for help as they felt politicians were "not around to help them".

"Maybe I am wrong, I hope, but I think the rakyat cannot get in touch with the wakil rakyat (elected rep) from their areas.

"Previously, letters to me were written anonymously, we used to call them surat layang. Now, they put their name, MyKad number, address and even their mobile number.

"This can only mean they are desperate," he said.

Sultan Sharafuddin chided elected representatives who were not around to carry out their duties for the very people who voted them into office.

"About a few months back, an area in Selangor was hit by a heavy flash flood.

"So I asked, 'Where is the wakil rakyat? Where is the adun, where is the MP?' The MP talks a lot on social media and in Parliament but in reality, there's nothing done," he said, without mincing his words.

"Only the non-governmental organisations are doing work on

the ground," the Ruler added.

Asked what issues were presented to him by the people, Sultan Sharafuddin said the rakyat pleaded for financial assistance and even highlighted local issues which should have been directed to their representatives.

His Royal Highness also expressed concern with the rise in the number of urban poor, noting that much

more should be done to help those affected by the pandemic.

Asked about the Selangor government's performance in managing the pandemic, he said: "It could be better. Politicians should focus on data and science."

"In Selangor, there may be many hospitals, but most are private and expensive. And (here), we have the urban poor."

## Poor upkeep of drains will lead to flash floods, say Klang folks

WITH heavy rain expected due to the north-east monsoon season, Klang folk say the authorities have not addressed issues that cause flash floods in their neighbourhoods.

They claim contractors hired to desilt monsoon drains have not been doing a proper job.

Mud and thick carpet of grass that impede water flow need to be urgently removed in Taman Bayu Perdana.

Klang Municipal Council (MPK) and Klang District Public Works Department (JKR) need to rebuild the neighbourhood's old drains that are broken and misaligned, which causes an overflow, stagnation or backflow of water.

Taman Bayu Perdana Residents Association (TBPRA) vice-chairman G. Mohan said high rainfall had become the norm but there was no comprehensive plan to address the deluge.

"Last month, workers desilted the monsoon drain along Jalan Pegaga, had not been desilted.

"But the contractor did a poor job, so clumps of grass and a bed of sand still covers the bottom of the monsoon drain.

"Most of the Taman Bayu

Perdana Residents Association and Rukun Tetangga (RT) members have urged MPK and Klang JKR to initiate measures for monsoon preparedness.

"Residents want the drains desilted but we are seeing a lackadaisical

attitude and the work is not carried out satisfactorily," he said.

TBPRA assistant secretary Wong Chee Meng said there was a sense of unpreparedness this monsoon season as an underground retention pond at Padang Enam, off

Jalan Pegaga, had not been desilted.

"It was built in 2012 after a major flood and until today, no effort has been made to remove the sand and silt inside.

"We want MPK's Environmental Services Department to clean up the retention pond soon to prevent flash floods," he said.

Wong said TBPRAs request was a basic preventive measure.

"Most of our residents are prompt in their assessment fee payments.

"Councillors for the area must check their neighbourhoods, see the condition of infrastructure and submit a complete report to the local council to have the damaged drains rebuilt," he added.

Taman Chi Liung Rukun Tetangga (RT) president Barrie Ganeson urged MPK to remove the hardened dirt in monsoon culverts along Persiaran Seraya, near the Lebuh Turi roundabout, as it impeded the smooth flow of surface runoff.

"It is crucial to ensure the monsoon drain is not clogged as it will help to curb flash floods," he said.

Ganeson added that the RT also wanted MPK to build a filter fence at a monsoon drain some 80m from the crossing in Jalan Bagor, next to the high-rise residential

apartments of Tengku Ampuan Rahimah Hospital.

Taman Gembira resident Amri Baharuddin said the monsoon drain outside Wisma Palmbase off Persiaran Raja Muda Musa, which falls under JKR Klang, was filled with waste and obstructed surface run-off that contributed to flash floods.

Klang Consumer Association president Devadas Anjan said MPK must set aside an allocation in Budget 2022 to build new drains in Taman Bayu Perdana, as a large portion of the drainage network had become dysfunctional because it was damaged and not aligned.

On the choked drains filled with dirt and waste, he said the lack of supervision by MPK had led to the workers' shoddy work.

When contacted, MPK Environmental Services Department spokesperson told *StarMetro* that desilting work was ongoing.

"We will also inspect the retention pond at Padang Enam and get it cleaned up.

"Other areas in Meru and the Taman Chi Liung monsoon drain culverts will be desilted as well.

"We will inform JKR Klang to clean up the monsoon drain outside Wisma Palmbase soon," she said.

### **Stop playing up racial issues, politicians told**

THE Sultan of Selangor has called for greater unity among the people and urged politicians to refrain from using race and religious issues to stir up emotions, saying there are more urgent issues to attend to.

Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah said that as a result of Covid-19, all races had been affected, citing instances of business closures, loss of jobs and reduction of wages.

"The number of middle-class folk has slid regardless of race. We are in the same boat. Economy and Covid-19 are our concerns.

"Please do not bring up unnecessary issues which can cause racial issues," he said.

The Ruler also urged the media, in particular, not to provide coverage to those pitting one side against another.

"Be mindful of what you share on social media. Don't amplify isolated cases. Most Malaysians are good people and rational," he added.

His Royal Highness was asked about non-Muslims having to turn to royal institutions for intervention when they felt marginalised.

Sultan Sharafuddin said he had been speaking about the need for unity since 2005.

"The ordinary people (the public) are okay, the hantu (devils) are the ones on top. The hantu provoke racial extremism and that is where the problem lies," said Sultan Sharafuddin.

On the infrastructure in Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin said delays by certain sectors were the main reasons projects were lagging.

"The bureaucrats are slow, the JKR (Public Works Department) is slow ... everything is slow. The Budget has been approved but we are too slow in utilising the money," said Sultan Sharafuddin, adding that the state had lost several opportunities due to delays.

On the plight of the Shah Alam Stadium, which has fallen into decay, Sultan Sharafuddin said its construction must be in tandem with the planned LRT station nearby.

He added that the Raja Muda of Selangor Tengku Amir Shah had asked if the stadium could be demolished and rebuilt exclusively as a football stadium.

"I have no objections to the stadium being demolished to be better but the name must be maintained."

"To conclude, it is my wish that we live harmoniously, full of tolerance and kindness regardless of race or beliefs. I wholeheartedly believe that unity shall bring prosperity and success to our country. That will surely be beneficial to the rakyat," the Sultan said.

## Sultan: Let qualified professionals run GLCs

SELANGOR elected representatives should stay away from being chairmen and directors of government-linked companies (GLCs) as these jobs should be left to qualified professionals, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah said.

The Sultan of Selangor said he had read about such appointments, often wondering if these elected representatives had the time or even the qualifications or experience in handling such tasks.

"They should focus on taking care of their constituents and the state. Leave it to the professionals."

"I hope they are not just thinking of the perks and remunerations in working for these GLCs, whether state or federal," he said.

His Royal Highness said the sluggish state economy and the little that was being done to rejuvenate it was

among the issues troubling him.

"Besides the Covid-19 pandemic, the never-ending water woe, which was a major bane to industries, is also a factor behind the declining economy."

"That's why they (businesses) run away to Vietnam one by one. We will lose investments," said Sultan Sharafuddin, adding that the lower costs of the labour force in Vietnam, Indonesia and Cambodia were competitive.

He added that the state's water troubles had to be settled without the involvement of politics.

"That's why I tell them, don't play political games. That's what happened in 2008 when the government changed and the start of politics involving water."

"What they (the state government) do not want to do, the Federal

(government) wants to do and when the state wants to do, the Federal does not want to," he said.

Sultan Sharafuddin said he had written many letters to the Prime Minister and Mentri Besar asking them to not get the water issue muddled with politics.

The Sultan said water was very crucial as it could not be substituted, unlike, for example, electricity supply, which, he said, could then

be substituted with the use of candles and generators.

"However, it was not the case with water. If there was a disruption, the people and businesses would suffer tremendously."

The Ruler opined that more needed to be done to attract investors to the state and reckoned the Selangor government had placed the wrong people, who lacked the experience, in positions involving investment.

However, Sultan Sharafuddin was quick to add that the executive councillor for industry and trade, Datuk Teng Chang Khim, performed well in his job.

He said investors had plenty of destinations to choose from and that Selangor needed to offer the best, adding that the state remained a good place but "we need to do better".

## 'Take booster vaccinations and stop the spread of Covid-19'

THE Sultan of Selangor has appealed to the people in the state not to let their guard down and to take booster vaccinations to ensure that everyone plays their role to stop the spread of Covid-19.

"I am worried because there are news reports of people who have doubts about taking the booster jabs.

"There is too much misinformation and fake news on social media. People are influenced easily.

"Then there are those who think that all is good and fine because they have been fully vaccinated."

Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah said in an interview.

He advised the people to stay away from "non-essential" gatherings involving large crowds, adding that everyone had to adjust their way of life.

The Sultan said he received weekly updates on the pandemic from the state health department, adding that there were over 9,800 fatalities recorded in the state alone since the start of the outbreak in March last year, with the majority comprising the Malays.

He noted that initially, more than

880 religious (Kafa) teachers, mosque officials and committee members as well as jurunikah (marriage officials) had refused to get vaccinated.

"So I told them, 'Alright, we will do it at a mosque on a Sunday, and we will provide food and parking.' But only 200 people turned up and out of the total, 100 people refused (to be vaccinated). I was disappointed, to be honest," he said.

He warned that they would not be able to continue carrying out their duties if they remained unvaccinated.

"So I gave them about three months to think about it," he said, adding that most of them were interacting directly with the public, thus putting everyone at risk.

"Now, the situation has improved drastically, only a few are stubborn. Although the vaccine may not offer 100% protection, it helps reduce the severity of the illness," said Sultan Sharafuddin.

The Ruler said while it was important to have a federal body to streamline various issues pertaining to religion, religious matters were still under the purview

of the state.

"For instance, the Muzakarah Committee of the National Council for Islamic Religious Affairs (MKI) cannot simply make a fatwa.

"They can discuss it, but they have to go back to the Conference of Rulers.

"If the Rulers give their approval, they (MKI) need to go back to the state, and the state will finalise it," he said, adding that bodies like the Department of Islamic Development Malaysia (jakim) should not overstep or pre-empt matters pertaining to religion," he added.

# Keeping his subjects close to heart

SELANGOR RULER Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah can be very stern when there is a need for him to address certain issues. Recently, Sultan Sharafuddin voiced his displeasure after some religious school teachers and mosque officials had refused to get inoculated against Covid-19.

Through its Selangor Royal Office Facebook page, Sultan Sharafuddin expressed sadness and disappointment over their stance. The Sultan had stated, without mincing his words, that the individuals' stubbornness would cause problems for others, especially religious school students.

The Ruler had asked for the names of the religious school teachers, mosque committee members and marriage solemnisers who had declined to be vaccinated.

That Selangor was one of the states with the highest number of Covid-19 cases also perturbed the Sultan deeply.

Besides being briefed regularly on the latest developments, Sultan Sharafuddin had also directed that the vaccination for factory workers be expedited as Selangor is an industrialised state with many factories and manufacturing plants.

Sultan Sharafuddin also constantly reminded his subjects to not let their guard down even after they had been vaccinated as it did not mean that they were now immune to Covid-19.

The Ruler also often urged the people to keep complying with the standard operating procedures set by the Health Ministry and to observe all the tenets of the new normal. The concern shown by Sultan Sharafuddin for his people's safety is reflective of the Ruler's caring nature.

This is also always seen when the Sultan addresses matters related to the state's Orang Asli community. The Ruler had recently extended help by sending rice to the Orang Asli community at the Sungai Judah settlement in Pulau Carey, Kuala Langat.

During the opening of the 2009 session of the Selangor Legislative Assembly sitting, Sultan Sharafuddin had asked the state government to hasten the exercise of identifying and gazetting of Orang Asli land.

He said in his royal address that the Orang Asli community's identity was being eroded, hence their land problems must be resolved.

"I want to stress the need to acknowledge and preserve Orang Asli land which had been seized from them in the last few years."

the Ruler had said.

Being a stickler for discipline and good conduct, Sultan Sharafuddin is also outspoken in his criticism of graft and had an audience with Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) chief Datuk Seri Azam Baki a few months ago.

In his address at the Selangor Legislative assembly's opening session this year, the Ruler highlighted that several senior civil servants in the state had been apprehended by the MACC.

The Ruler said it was regrettable that there were still those who were dishonest and misused the trust given to them in their capacity as civil servants or political leaders.

"I am giving another reminder that I do not want to hear of any reports about the involvement of the state's civil servants and political leaders in bribery."

"I have directed the MACC to carry out in-depth investigations to clear Selangor of corrupt practices," the Ruler said at the time.

Sultan Sharafuddin also hoped those involved in graft would be brought to court and, if found guilty, punished severely to indicate the people's rejection of bribery.

The Sultan added that the corrupted had no place in society and

must be dealt with.

On the excessive politicking, Sultan Sharafuddin reminded elected representatives that they should not forget their responsibilities towards the people amid such power plays.

"I cannot hide my disappointment and regret over the country's recent serious political strife, fighting and uncertainty."

"It looks like the Ahli-Ahli Yang Berhormat (elected representatives) do not want to learn from the history of the fall of a nation due to power struggles that led to division in society," Sultan Sharafuddin had noted in his opening address.

The Sultan is also known to speak up when there have been violations of people's rights and privacy.

For example, he had spoken out when the privacy of a state assemblyman was violated through the circulation of some private photos in 2009. While the pictures were being shared on social media along with jeering and snide remarks, much to the discomfort of the assemblyman, Sultan Sharafuddin immediately voiced his concern.

The Ruler's office issued a statement in which Sultan Sharafuddin said he was upset and worried

over the intrusion of privacy and private rights for the purpose of destroying a person's dignity and reputation.

The Ruler expressed sadness that private lives were being made public and subject to public scrutiny via the mass media.

Sultan Sharafuddin was born on Dec 24, 1945, at Istana Jemaah in Klang as Tengku Idris Shah to the late Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah, who was the Raja Muda at the time, and his first wife Raja Saidatul Ihsan Tengku Badar Shah.

The Sultan attended the Malay Primary School in Jalan Raja Muda, Kuala Lumpur, before enrolling in St John's Institution. The Sultan continued his schooling at the Hale School in Perth, Australia, in 1960

and later enrolled in Langhurst College in Surrey, England, in 1964.

He became a civil servant upon his return to Malaysia and served in the Selangor state secretariat, the Kuala Lumpur district office and the police department.

The Ruler became the Raja Muda of Selangor at the age of 15 in 1960 when his father was installed as the Sultan of Selangor. He ascended the throne in 2001 after Sultan Salahuddin's demise.

Sultan Sharafuddin is married to former news presenter Norashikin Abdul Rahman, who is now styled as Tengku Permaisuri Selangor Tengku Norashikin.

On the occasion of his Majesty's 76th birthday, the people of Selangor wish Sultan Sharafuddin good health and many more blessed years ahead. Daulat Tuanku!





# Caring royal with a love for animals

TENGKU Permaisuri Selangor Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin, just like her husband Selangor Ruler Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah, is a working royal. She is always attentive and rises to the occasion when her help or intervention is required.

For instance, when Foodpanda delivery person Nur Athirah Abdul Latif's motorcycle was stolen while she was waiting to pick up a delivery order, Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin stepped in to help.

She bought Nur Athirah a new motorcycle to replace the one that was stolen so that the young woman could continue earning a living.

One of Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin's current projects is reviving the telepuk textile design in order to prevent it from becoming extinct.

Telepuk comprises a stamping design made of gold dust on fabric and is synonymous with Selangor royalty.

Unfortunately, according to Selangor Malay Customs and Heritage Corporation (Padat) curator Intan Salina Idrus, the art of the telepuk design nearly died out with the passing of the artisans who used to make it for the Selangor royal court.

"The Tengku Permaisuri asked us about the telepuk and we explained the situation to her. The Tengku Permaisuri then requested that the tradition be revived," said Intan Salina.

She added that Padat was currently training a male apprentice who had shown interest in becoming a telepuk artisan.

According to a paper published by academics from Universiti Teknologi MARA not long ago, the telepuk textile was in use in the

state from the reign of its first Ruler, Sultan Salahuuddin Shah (1745-1778).

Being an animal lover, Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin has also voiced her disapproval when animals are treated cruelly by local council dog catching units.

On one occasion, she expressed her disappointment and sadness over the way Subang Jaya Municipal Council staff had handled dogs during a dog-catching exercise.

"I urge the authorities to be more sensitive and humane in dealing with cases involving abandoned animals on the streets," the Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin had said in a statement posted on the Selangor Royal Office Facebook page.

Unfortunately, the local councils in Selangor continue mishandling dogs in dog catching exercises in spite of the royal rebuke.

Perhaps the executive councillor in charge of local government, Ng Sze Han, should heed Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin's concern and raise the matter with the municipal and district councils as well as city halls in Selangor.

The always stylish and elegant Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin also has an orchid named after her — the *vanilla norashikiniana* — at the orchid conservatory in Frasers Hill.

Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin and Sultan Sharafuddin were married at Istana Alam Shah in Klang on Aug 31, 2016, and she was proclaimed the Tengku Permaisuri Selangor effective Sept 8 that same year.

Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin was previously an air stewardess before becoming an award-winning newscaster with RTM.

She has two grown-up children, Nur Amanda and Adam Salleh, from a previous marriage.

THERE has been growing interest in community gardening or urban farming in recent years.

The activity is not limited to those living in landed properties, as some residents of high-rise dwellings have access or live close to land available for gardening.

The reasons for such interests are varied, such as gardening as a hobby or therapy, environmental awareness, food security concerns especially after the Covid-19 pandemic, and mutual interest in a project that benefits a community.

During last month's Placemaker Asean Awards (PAA) 2021, the organisers noted that "there was substantial interest in community gardens, with many being established to act as a platform for community building".

The idea behind the Chiang Mai Urban Farm in Thailand was heartfelt and practical; its community concept also benefited multiple groups within the northern Thai city.

It was a solution born of the Covid-19 pandemic – there was great need to feed some of Chiang Mai's most vulnerable, such as low-income groups and individuals who had lost their jobs and were struggling to feed their families.

Jobless people were hired to work on a former dumpsite, which was transformed into an urban farm.

The produce they grew was either sold at affordable prices or distributed for free to homeless people and welfare homes.

Some garden beds were allocated to low-income communities so they could grow their own produce for their own consumption.

Other garden beds were allotted to local schools so students could

gain hands-on experience in urban farming.

The harvest would later be sent to their school canteens for their meals.

Its community-oriented and sharing concept encouraged people to work and learn together, regardless of their social and economic backgrounds.

The Chiang Mai Urban Farm went on to win PAA 2021's Best Placemaker: Placemaking During the Pandemic category.

Closer to home, several community gardens emerged as the top three finalists or won special commendation in other PAA 2021 categories.

These included TTDI Edible

Community Garden in Taman Tun Dr Ismail, Kuala Lumpur; Kebun Kita in Section 3, Old Town, Petaling Jaya; Mid Valley River Three Park in Kuala Lumpur; and Precinct 16 Community Garden in Putrajaya.

However, not all community gardens are welcome by neighbourhoods, especially if the projects are done without the permission of authorities or consent of neighbours, or are sited on land deemed unsuitable for farming.

My colleagues have written about how community gardens in the Klang Valley and Ipoh ran into trouble because the people behind them did not seek permission from the local council or government agency

that owned the land, or they turned green or open spaces such as children's playgrounds and recreational fields into urban farms or there were disagreements with their neighbours over the use of open spaces.

Residents groups in areas under the administration of Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ) and Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) have to seek permission from the respective council's Landscape Department before they can start a community garden in their neighbourhoods.

If the proposed farm is sited on land belonging to a different government agency or utility company (such as Drainage and Irrigation

Department or TNB), then the residents group has to get the respective landowner's permission before submitting an application to the local authority.

"Residents must get the support of their residents associations or Rukun Tetangga as well as endorsement of their local councillor, before initiating the process with MBSJ to start a community garden," said MBSJ in a statement.

"A general consensus is needed, as some residents may be against the idea of having an urban farm in front, behind or near their houses."

"There are also other factors to be considered, such as public safety, not causing obstruction to infrastructure maintenance works or blocking back lane access," it added.

The city council noted that building a community garden required teamwork, perseverance, understanding and good leadership.

"There have been cases where we had to clear out urban farms because the community failed to maintain them," continued MBSJ.

"Poor leadership, lack of team effort, unsuitable locations as well as poor knowledge of growing methods and farm management have been among the factors that led to the failure of such projects," the local council added.

For those seeking some guidance, they can refer to the Urban Community Farming Policy launched by Housing and Local Government Ministry in August 2021.

The policy covers, among other things, must-have elements of an urban farm such as crop rotation practices, watering methods and maintenance as well as types of crops suitable for urban farms.

# Steeped in tradition

DURING important ceremonies held at the Selangor royal palaces, a procession bearing the various royal regalia will formally make its entrance into the venue hall before the event begins.

One cannot but help notice the tall, lithe figure of the Bentara Raja leading the entourage while bearing the royal spear Lembing Sembuana.

The Bentara Raja, Tengku Ezrique Ezzuddean Tengku Ardy Esfandiar, who is a member of the Selangor royal family, had first carried the ceremonial and sacred spear in 2013.

"I was first tasked to carry the Lembing Sembuana during the swearing-in ceremony of former mentri besar Tan Sri Khalid Ibrahim back in 2013," recalled the 33-year-old Tengku Ezrique Ezzuddean.

He explained that the Lembing Sembuana is only used during ceremonial appointments of state officials, the Orang Besar Istana's Menjunjung Dul (pledging allegiance) ceremony as well as other official ceremonies that the palace officials believe requires the ceremonial spear.

The Lembing Sembuana is made of iron mined from Selangor's nine occupied districts during the tenure of the state's second Ruler, Almarhum Sultan Ibrahim Shah Almarhum Sultan Salehuddin.

A replica of the spear is also a central feature in Selangor's coat of arms.

On the criteria required for one to be chosen for the position, Tengku Ezrique Ezzuddean said it was based on familial lineage.

"Selection is amongst members of the royal family by the Royal Council with the approval of His Royal Highness the Sultan," explained Tengku Ezrique Ezzuddean.

He added that the duration of a Bentara Raja's tenure depended on the discretion of the Sultan.

Tengku Ezrique Ezzuddean said

he was presented with a watikah (official scroll) to denote his appointment as the Bentara Raja by current Selangor Ruler Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah during a ceremony held at Istana Bukit Kayangan in 2019.

On what is required of him prior to a ceremonial event, Tengku Ezrique Ezzuddean said he had to attend rehearsals.

"For any event, there will be a rehearsal two to three days prior where I can familiarise myself with the movements required," said Tengku Ezrique Ezzuddean, who is a director of an aviation company that procures and sells helicopters.


He added that he prepared himself mentally and physically for an event by having a good rest a day earlier.

"On the morning of the event, I will bring my Bentara Raja attire and get ready at the palace (Istana Alam Shah). The palace supervisor (Mr Kadir) will assist me in putting on the bengkung, samping and other accessories," he said.

He also shared that if he arrived at the venue early, he would start practising the entrance and exit during the event on his own.

Tengku Ezrique Ezzuddean, who enjoys golfing and boxing, is married to actress, model and host Syamim Mohd Farid.

He is the eldest of three children and his father is the Tengku Sri Paduka Shahbandar Tengku Datuk Ardy Esfandiar Alhaj Tengku Abdul Hamid Shah Alhaj.

"Last but not least, I remember that the young people in Cohort 3 visited a homeless shelter, ensuring comfort and cleanliness among the less fortunate there," Tengku Amir had said.

He added that it was amazing to see the youths being so passionate about giving back to society while also looking to better their own

Tengku Amir is also known to be stern when it is required of him. This was evident when he took over the helm of the FAS in June 2018, when it was at its most troubled point.

Not wasting a single minute, Tengku Amir had used his mettle to sort out the bickering within the football association and put in place a brand new machinery to run the organisation smoothly.

Neither did Tengku Amir mince his words when taking the officials to task during the FAS crisis.

"It's too late now to say sorry because I have given enough chances, enough warnings," the Crown Prince lambasted the feuding officials at the time.

While trying to appease the officials and clearing up the factional disgruntlement, Tengku Amir had explained to them that they could work together to create a good football team.

Selangor FC chief executive officer Dr Johan Kamal Hamidon, who was formerly a SAY chief executive officer, told *The Star* previously that Tengku Amir was always concerned about the

people's best interests.

Tengku Amir has always put the people first since the day he began heading both SAY and YRMS.

"At SAY, Tengku Amir works closely with existing community groups in areas such as community service, entrepreneurship, sports and the arts to maximise the potential and impact of the respective initiatives," he had added.

Tengku Amir was officially declared as the Crown Prince and heir to the Selangor throne on May 3, 2002, when he was just 11.

He was born in San Francisco, the United States, on Dec 12, 1990, and is Sultan Sharafuddin's only son.

He holds a degree in Ecology and Environmental Biology from Leeds University and was commissioned Leutenant Muda in the 17th battalion of the Royal Malay Regiment at Terendak Camp, Melaka.

He was trained at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst in the United Kingdom.

In October 2016, Tengku Amir underwent the age-old rites of the state's royal coronation endorsing his accession as the Selangor throne's heir apparent.

## Turning S'gor into a global business hub

WITH a view of strengthening Selangor's commercial standing by enhancing high-end businesses, the state's investment arm Invest Selangor has embarked on various endeavours. One of its latest accomplishments is the recently concluded Selangor Aviation Show 2021.

Themed "Selangor, the ASEAN Business and General Aviation Hub", the inaugural event was reflective of the state's pursuit of becoming a regional centre for aerospace and aviation activities.

If the state successfully meets the target it has set for itself, Selangor will become a regional aviation hub fuelled only by Singapore.

The pursuit of this sector is also in tandem with results of global data which revealed that the business and general aviation industry were resilient sectors in the face of the Covid-19 pandemic.

The business and general aviation sectors were also the quickest to recover from the adverse effects of the pandemic compared to other aerospace industry sectors.

Selangor executive councillors in charge of industry and trade Datuk Teng Chang Khim said the sectors generally known in the aerospace industry were the defence and commercial or civil aviation sectors. However, little had been done in the past to explore the business and general aviation sectors.

"Business aviation covers private jets and chartered aircrafts while general aviation encompasses small aircrafts, helicopters and drones.

"This is the area we are trying to develop given its potential as well as Selangor's strategic location," explained Teng.

He said more global conglomerates were chartering flights for business travel instead of

commercial flights post-Covid-19. "Studies show that boarding a commercial flight comes with 700 touch points from the time one leaves home and arrives at the intended location compared to only 20 touch points when travelling in private aircrafts," he added.

According to Teng, the number of private jets touching down at Selangor was also expected to increase in the coming months.

He said the increase in business and general aviation activities in the state would help Selangor expand its maintenance, repair and overhaul business.

Teng said Selangor also had the space and expertise to manufacture small aircrafts, which was also one of the state's targeted industries.

Selangor Menteri Besar Dato' Seri Amirudin Shari, meanwhile, said Selangor already had an advantage with Subang Airport.

"We already have a diamond in the rough with Subang Airport and we are determined to help unlock its potential to support and sustain growth in the business and general aviation industry," Amirudin said.

During the Selangor Legislative Assembly sitting in August, Teng revealed that the state had received more than RM22.45bil in investments with some 411 manufacturing projects approved from January 2020.

He added that RM10.43bil and RM12.02bil were from domestic and foreign investments respectively.

Recently, Amirudin said the Selangor government was geared towards becoming a centre for hi-tech manufacturing.

To realise this intent, Selangor was seeking investors with expertise in automation, industrial Internet of Things and advanced robotics, he added.

Invest Selangor has also launched the Selangor Biotechnology Action Plan 2021-2030 with the aim of turning Selangor into a regional biotechnology hub for innovation, technology

dissemination, investment and human capital development.

The Selangor government has big plans to turn the state into a regional economic force to be reckoned with and its aggressive initiatives are already paying off.

## Early intervention


According to Ng, there are many people who are initially unaware that they or their loved ones are experiencing mental health issues.



# Selangor Aviation Show shakes off pandemic blues, to return in 2022

The Selangor Aviation Show will be making a comeback next year. The inaugural event, Selangor Aviation Show 2021 (SAS2021), held on Nov 25 to 27, is believed to be among the first in-person aviation shows to be held in the region since the pandemic struck in 2020.

Selangor state executive councillor for industry and trade Datuk Teng Chang Khim announced that the second Selangor Aviation Show has been scheduled for Sept 8 to 10, 2022, and has called on the aerospace industry to sign up early and make it even better than the just-concluded SAS2021.

"The Selangor Aviation Show from now on will certainly become a staple event within the state's aerospace industry."

"I am happy to announce that during the tabling of the RM2.34 billion state budget for 2022 (on Nov 26), the menteri besar of Selangor granted a bigger allocation of RM5 million for the next edition of our Selangor Aviation Show in 2022."

"This allocation will certainly help us plan a bigger and bolder Selangor Aviation Show for all of you, next year," he said in his speech during SAS2021's closing ceremony held at Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport recently.

Looking ahead, Teng noted that there are still a lot of upsides and positives to explore within the aerospace industry.

"With the support from the business and general aviation community, especially here at Subang Airport and in greater Selangor, we hope to truly realise the ambition of making Selangor the Asean business and general aviation hub in the coming future," he added.

The second edition of the Selangor Aviation Show is open for space booking through Invest Selangor's dedicated aerospace division, Selangor Darul Ehsan Aerospace Industry Coordination Office (SDaico).

Meanwhile, organiser Invest Selangor Bhd hailed SAS2021 as a success beyond its expectations, drawing a crowd of 4,987 visitors, almost achieving the target of 5,000 visitors.

This is especially as SAS2021 is a part of Invest Selangor's initiative to give the aerospace industry a push towards recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic's devastating effects.

Themed "Selangor, the Asean Business and

General Aviation Hub," SAS2021 focused on the business and general aviation industry, especially in Selangor, as worldwide data has shown this sector of the aerospace industry to be more resilient to the pandemic's impact while its recovery is quicker and more sustainable than other sectors.

In a new report published by Global Jet Capital, there were 1.8 million business jet flights worldwide between January and July 2021, a 49% increase over the same period in 2020. Meanwhile, about US\$13.88 billion (RM58.47 billion) worth of business jets were transacted worldwide from January to July 2021, compared with US\$14.10 billion in the same period pre-pandemic in 2019.

Likewise, according to WingX Advance, German business aviation consultancy, there were 77,051 business jet flights out of Asia-Pacific airports between January and September 2021, a 42.7% increase over the same period in 2020. Of these flights, 46% were domestic and 54% international.

Invest Selangor chief executive officer Datuk Hasan Azhari Idris said the aerospace industry has become one of the state's key focus sectors over the last five years, with the establishment of the Selangor Aerospace Council. Through the council, the state also established a dedicated Selangor Aerospace Action Plan 2020-2030.

On why the state is pushing hard to pro-

mote business and general aviation at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport, both Teng and Hasan Azhari echoed Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari's aspiration of unlocking the potential of the established "diamond in the rough" — the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport — to support and sustain growth in the aviation industry.

The inaugural SAS2021 event, which had strong local representation, also managed to assemble a total of 43 exhibitors from seven countries — attracting international players from Brazil, France, Switzerland, Turkey and the US. Exhibitors included major original equipment manufacturers (OEMs) like Airbus, Dassault Aviation, Embraer SA and Turkish Aerospace Industries, as well as local industry leaders Systematic Aviation Services, Galaxy Aerospace, AERODYNE and Pen Aviation.

In addition, 13 memorandums of understanding (MOUs) on various aerospace industry sub-sector collaborations were also signed during SAS2021.

The agreements cover various collaborations such as vocational workforce development joint venture for the aerospace industry, development of the Selangor Drone Centre of Excellence, simulator training hub, one-stop maintenance, repair, and operations (MRO) centre for drones, and proposed development of a seaplane manufacturing facility.

Among others, the strategic collaboration between Malaysia Airports Holdings Bhd (MAHB) and ExecuJet Aviation Group will see Dassault Aviation investing up to RM100 million through ExecuJet MRO Services Malaysia (ExecuJet) to set up a new MRO as a one-stop centre for business jets to carry out line and heavy maintenance and interior refurbishment. ExecuJet MRO Services became a member of the Dassault group of companies in March 2019.

The static aircraft displays at SAS2021 proved to be popular with visitors, with many photos and selfies taken and posted on social media. Among the displays were Embraer's eye-catching E195 E2 Techline regional aircraft, business jets, helicopters, small planes and for many, the irresistible drones.

Apart from indoor displays by exhibitors, the discussion sessions were also well received, with lively debates, especially for topics such as industry development, regulations and financing for the aerospace industry.

(八打灵再也10日讯)雪州大臣拿督斯里阿米鲁丁透露，雪州旅游业将做好准备，一旦我国国门获准开放，即可稳定地恢复旅游业，迎接外国游客。

他今早在雪州旅游全球大会上向媒体表示，雪州在2019年迎接游客

800万人次，如果在开放国门后要恢复到昔日的旅游人数，旅游业者必须提前做好准备。

“目前我国的国门仍然紧闭，大部分入境者都是为了工作而不是为了旅游，因此我们现阶段也只能专注于本地游客。”

# 雪旅遊業準備迎外國客

**探討永續經營**

阿米鲁丁指出，一连两日举办的雪州旅游全球大会是为了商讨如何在现有的情况下，永续经营旅游业。让旅游业从新常态、数码化等方面来提升本地旅游，如何让旅游业永续及有效减少重症患者。”

他表示，去年与2019年相比，雪州的游客消费都降低了173.7%，减少幅度超过100%，州政府为了复苏旅游业，于去年推出“先玩转雪州”旅游计划，惟在今年4月遇上行管令而被迫停止。

在开放跨州后的这3个月以来，雪州的酒店住客率已大大提升，但这只限于本地游客，除了外州游客，也包括雪州人在州内旅游，因此旅游住宿的人数也增加。”

他说，如今随着疫苗的高接种率及经济领域开放重启旅游计划，举办一项全球大会，涉及各领域的旅游业者包括运动旅游、酒店业等，这些都是州政府采取积极的措施来复苏雪州旅游业及经济。

**称确诊数据不再是指标**

他提及，雪州旅游全球大会的主题是“游戏规则改变以重置旅游业”（A Game Changer to Reset Tourism），采取线上线下方式进行，有逾2000人报名参

与。“尽管雪州的冠病确诊数据仍居高不下，但这已不再是一项指标，传染率及症状才更为重要，而我们也看到疫苗有效减少重症患者。”

他认为，旅游活动可在安全的情况下进行，惟更令人担心的是一旦国门开放，如何能确保每个人入境者都已接种疫苗。

他也说，一些旅游计划，如马新疫苗接种者旅游走廊（VTL）及浮罗交怡旅游泡泡计划，都会途经雪州，因此希望雪州能从中受惠。

#### 商讨迎外国医疗游客

此外，阿米鲁丁指出，雪州旅游局已与马来西亚医疗保健旅游理事会（MHTC）商讨及准备，在国门开放后迎接医疗游客，惟这取决于联邦政府的国门控制。

“无论如何，雪州作为马来西亚的‘人口’，设有港口、机场等，比起槟城或柔佛来说更方便，具有更先进的医疗设备来迎接医疗游客群。”

他补充，开放医疗旅游的细节必商讨好，如病患抵达吉隆坡国际机场后，如何安排前往医院等，医院也要做好这些准备工作。

#### 開發Go Selangor程式方便遊客

阿米鲁丁在致词时透露，为了提升游客在雪州的旅游体验，州政府将通过雪州旅游局全力支持开发“Go Selangor”手机应用程序，预计将于明年2月推出。

“我们希望在该应用程序上吸引约1万名雪州的商家，这是州政府积极推动旅游4.0和旅游数字化的举措。”

他表示，雪州是由9个县及12个地方议会组成，提供多样化的旅游目的地，每个地区都有各自独特性，希望大家将雪州的9个县作为必游目的地。因为拥有丰富的历史、遗产和文化，且设有众多旅游景点和娱乐设施。

他也说，旅游业是受疫情严重影响的行业之一，州政府将在2021年至2025年拨出1亿1660万令吉刺激雪州旅游业，将涉及多项旅游领域。

### 不同意收購配套38業主

## 發展商獻議“溫馨配套”

（吉隆坡10日讯）甘榜双溪峇鲁土地收购事宜迎来新进展，发展商今日推出“温馨配套”（Pakej Harmoni）献议，予38名不同意此前收购配套的甘榜双溪峇鲁雪州发展机构（PKNS）组屋的业主。

### 土地赔偿金一半购新单位

甘榜双溪峇鲁重建计划发展商Ritz Gloss私人有限公司董事阿都哈尼今日在新闻发布会上说，在温馨配套下，相关业主能以土地赔偿金的一半，来购买价值30万令吉、900平方尺的新住宅单位。

“举例来说，若有关业主获得25万令吉的土地赔偿金，该业主可以12万5000令吉来购买温馨配套的住宅单位。”

他说，上述新的住宅单位设有3间睡房、2间厕所及一个停车位。

一同出席新闻发布会的吉隆坡甘榜双溪峇鲁业主福利协会主席祖法卡指出，双溪峇鲁共有264个雪州发展机构（PKNS）组屋住宅单位，其中有192个业主已签署同意此前发展商提出的收购土地配套、20个业主牵涉遗产问题、15个业主对此前不同意收购土地配套U转，以及38个业主不同意此前的收购配套。

### 若获38业主同意 明年6月开始重建

他说，他们这5年来对双溪峇鲁的重建计划作出努力，截至目前已取得接近85%的业主同意，并才在今年年初作出土地收回的申请。

祖法卡提及，在当地的重建计划下，甘榜峇鲁和甘榜双溪峇鲁是不一样的，他们今日所提及的相关事项，指的是甘榜双溪峇鲁的范围，而甘榜峇鲁的重建计划则是由马来农村机构（MAS）处理。

此外，阿都哈尼说，如果其余的38名业主都同意温馨配套的献议，他预计相关地区的重建计划最早可以在明年6或7月开始。
