Azmin sudah kehabisan modal - Ginie Lim

MELAKA: Bekas Ahli Dewan Undangan Negeri (ADUN) Machap Jaya, Ginie Lim menegaskan sekalipun tidak dicalon dalam Pilihan Raya Negara (PRN) Melaka namun beliau komited dengan agenda Pakatan Harapan (PH).

Ginie menyifatkan dakwaan Pengarah Pilihan Raya Perikatan Nasional (PN), Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali bahawa beliau digugurkan kerana menyokongnya adalah sebagai kehabisan modal.

Katanya, kesetiaan beliau sebagai seorang ahli PKR dan aktivis Reformis adalah pada prinsip perjuangan parti, bukannya kepada individu.

"Walaupun saya tidak bertanding dalam Pilihan Raya Negeri kali ini, saya tetap komited dengan agenda perjuangan PH serta menyumbangkan tenaga dan idea dalam politik tanah air di bawah pimpinan Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

"Saya menolak dengan tegasnya tindakan Langkah Sheraton kerana bersekongkol dengan kuasa kleptokrat dan perasau yang telah pun ditolak oleh rakyat dalam Pilihan Raya Umum.

"Meskipun Azmin pernah menjadi Timbalan Presiden PKR, namun amat menyediakan bagi seorang yang kononnya memperjuangkan politik pelbagai kaum dan melawan rasuah lebih 20 tahun tetapi akhirnya terpaksa tunduk kepada acuan parti perkauman dan perasau," katanya semalam.

Semalam Mohamed Azmin Ali, melahirkan rasa simpatinya kepada Ginie kerana tidak dicalonkan parti itu dalam PRN Melaka.

Azmin yang juga bekas Timbalan Presiden PKR berkata, Ginie menjadi mangsa politik dalam PKR kerana dilihat berpihak kepada sebahagian selepas mengambil keputusan meninggalkan parti itu.

Ginie kemudian meminta Mohamed Azmin sedar bahawa Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia (Bersatu) sudah tidak lagi relevan untuk masa depan tanah air.

Benarkan hantar permohonan dalam talian

SHAH ALAM: Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS) diharap membenarkan penghantaran permohonan kebenaran berkahwin dibuat secara dalam talian bagi memudahkan pemohon tanpa perlu tiba awal pagi dan beratur panjang di pejabat agama.

Saranan itu disuarakan kerana terdapat pemohon mendakwa terpaksa mengambil cuti untuk hadir ke pejabat agama malah ada yang terpaksa datang kembali dan menghantar borang lagi sekali kerana dokumen disertakan tidak lengkap.

Menurut Zubaidah Mohd. Sufian, 33, situasi menunggu pada waktu awal pagi dan berulang alik ke pejabat agama boleh dielakkan jika permohonan dan penghantaran dokumen boleh dibuat secara dalam talian.

“Untuk pengesahan, mungkin pegawai boleh memanggil pemohon untuk menunjukkan dokumen asal ke pejabat untuk semakan. Tidak perlu panggil semua pemohon, mungkin perlu panggil mereka sekiranya terdapat dokumen yang meragukan,” katanya ketika ditemui *Utusan Malaysia*.

Nuriylia Nordin, 27, memberitahu dia terpaksa hadir ke Pejabat Agama Islam Daerah Klang sebanyak dua kali pada Jumaat lalu kerana dokumennya tidak lengkap dan perlu ditandatangan oleh pegawai disenaraikan sahaja.

“Mujur rumah saya dekat di Kampung Sungai Kandis, cuma saya ada masalah dokumen yang ditandatangan oleh imam masjid, sedangkan ia perlu ditandatangan oleh pengerusi masjid. Terpaksa hantar semula, sudahlah beratur sejak pukul 6.30 pagi.

“Kemudian, ada satu sijil nikah ibu bapa dalam syarat cuma kata salinan, tetapi bila tiba di pejabat tak tahu pula kena bawa sijil asal, itu pun agak menyukarkan. Walau bagaimanapun, mujur saya dibenarkan hantar semula semua dokumen dalam hari sama sebelum pukul 4 petang,” katanya.

Tiba awal pagi, pegawai hanya proses 80 permohonan setiap hari

SHAH ALAM: ‘Terpacak’ di hadapan pintu pejabat agama Islam seawal pukul 6 pagi, itulah antara cabaran awal bagi bakal pasangan pengantin di Selangor yang mahu mendirikan rumah tangga pada hujung tahun ini.

Mereka perlu hadir seawal itu untuk mendapatkan nombor giliran bagi menghantar borang permohonan kebenaran berkahwin ke pejabat agama Islam daerah, Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS) sebelum mereka dibenarkan bernikah.

Tinjauan *Utusan Malaysia* baru-baru ini, di Pejabat Agama Islam Daerah Petaling di sini, seramai 30 orang sudah pun menunggu di hadapan pintu masuk kaunter pendaftaran seawal pukul 7 pagi bagi berurus di sana.

Sementara di Pejabat Agama Islam Daerah Klang pula, hambar 20 orang sudah pun beratur di hadapan pintu pagar pejabat berkenaan dan ada pemohon yang menunggu sejak pukul 6 pagi di sana.

Malah, menurut seorang pemohon, Zubaidah Mohd. Sufian, 33, ruangan menunggu di pejabat agama di Shah Alam itu sudah pun dihadiri lebih 10 pemohon lain ketika dia tiba di sana pada pukul 6.15 pagi selepas keluar dari rumahnya di Puchong pada 5.30 pagi.

“Saya ingat pukul 6.15 pagi itu sudah dikira awal sebab pernah datang pada petang Jumaat lepas untuk hantar borang permohonan kebenaran berkahwin, tetapi dimaklumkan oleh

pegawai mereka tidak lagi menerima borang pada waktu itu.

Justeru, pegawai berkenaan menasihatkan saya datang seawal pukul 6 pagi untuk mendapatkan nombor giliran sahaja kerana sehari mereka memberitahu boleh menerima 80 permohonan sahaja. Tetapi sampai awal pada waktu itu pun sudah lebih 10 orang yang menunggu,” katanya ketika ditemui.

Turut sampai pada waktu sama, Balkis Abbas, 21, juga dari Puchong apabila memberitahu pernah cuba untuk membuat temu janji sebelum kehadiran secara datang terus ke kaunter dibenarkan ketika Selangor dalam Fasa 2 Pelan Pemulihan

Negara, namun sentiasa penuh.

“Saya nikah pada 12 Disember nanti, tetapi sebelum ini pernah cuba untuk selesaikan permohonan kebenaran bermkah awal sebab risau kalau ada dokumen tidak lengkap dan kena datang dua tiga kali ke pejabat agama.

“Tetapi semua tarikh janji temu penuh, mujur sekarang sudah boleh walk-in ke kaunter, cuma kena datang awal pagi. Tetapi saya bimbang juga urusan tak boleh selesai hari ini kerana jurunkah di kawasan rumah sudah tamat tauliah,” luahnya.

Di Klang pula, Mohamad Amirul, 24 dari Kapar memberitahu, dia perlu keluar rumah

seawal pukul 4.30 pagi kerana pejabat agama di Klang terletak kira-kira 30 kilometer dari rumah berbanding pejabat di Kuala Selangor.

“Pernah saya pergi ke pejabat di Kuala Selangor, tetapi diarahkan pergi ke Klang kerana rumah dalam daerah itu. Kemudian pada dua minggu lalu saya datang ke sana pada pukul 8.30 pagi, tetapi ketika itu sudah ada hampir 100 orang menunggu.

Sementara itu, Nasrul Izam, 23, yang turut menunggu di tempat sama memberitahu, situasi orang beratur panjang di sana biasa dilihatnya sejak akhir-akhir ini, malah barisannya panjang hingga ke bahagian belakang bangunan.

SHAH ALAM: Isu 'bottleneck' yang perlu dihadapi oleh pemohon kebenaran bernikah di Selangor dijangka berlarutan sehingga hujung tahun ini berikutan terdapat permohonan tertangguh akibat pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) sebelum ini.

Bagaimanapun, jumlah pemohon dijangkakan masih berada pada sekitar 22,000 seperti tahun-tahun sebelum pandemik Covid-19 melanda, namun disebabkan permohonan ter-

tangguh peningkatan permohonan sehingga Disember ini.

Malah, terdapat empat pejabat agama Islam daerah di negeri ini sedang mengalami peningkatan permohonan iaitu di Gombak, Petaling, Klang dan Hulu Langat.

Perkara itu dimaklumkan Pengarah Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS), Dato' Mohd. Shahzihan Ahmad yang menjelaskan, permohonan kebenaran berkahwin secara terus di kaunter setiap hari meningkat

kepada 80 hingga 100 berbanding hari biasa.

"Peningkatan itu sudah dijangka selepas banyak permohonan tertangguh ketika PKP. Jika sebelum ini, kebiasaan permohonan diterima adalah sekitar 50 sahaja, walau bagaimanapun 80 hingga 100 permohonan itu adalah had dan bebanan kerja boleh ditampung pegawai setiap hari," katanya ketika dihubungi *Utusan Malaysia*.

Mengenai saranan orang ramai supaya JAIS membenarkan

permohonan kebenaran berkahwin diantar secara dalam talian, Mohd. Shahzihan berkata, ia memang dalam pertimbangan JAIS tetapi beliau mahukan satu sistem dalam talian sepenuhnya apabila diperkenalkan kelak.

"Apa yang kita lalui sekarang adalah pengalaman yang sangat besar, bukan JAIS sahaja bahkan semua agensi kerajaan. Sudah sampai masanya kita punyai sistem dalam talian kena buat *end-to-end*," katanya.

Buku CRM dan Tatacara Pengurusan Tatatertib jadi panduan dan rujukan kakitangan

Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam (MBSA) mengingatkan kakitanganinya tidak terpalit dengan isu rasuah dan salah guna kuasa yang boleh memberi kesan kepada pentadbiran pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) itu.

Datuk Bandar Shah Alam, Datuk Zamani Ahmad Mansor berkata, pelbagai usaha dilakukan bagi membanteras perbuatan tidak berintegriti itu.

Menurutnya, antara usaha dilakukan termasuklah menyediakan buku Pengurusan Risiko Rasuah (CRM) dan buku Tatacara Pengurusan Tatatertib yang dilancarkan pada Selasa.

“Buku ini diharap menjadi panduan dan rujukan kepada kakitangan MBSA bagi mengelakkan mereka melakukan menjayah rasuah.

“Kita ada pelan risiko rasuah dan kaedah kita mengambil tindakan terhadap si pelaku,” katanya ketika dihubungi pada Rabu.

Zamani Ahmad berkata, MBSA akan mengambil beberapa tindakan dan ber-

usaha bagi memastikan perbuatan rasuah tidak berlaku dalam kalangan kakitanganannya pada masa depan.

“Kita turut mengenal pasti tempat kerja kita yang ada risiko (berlakunya) rasuah,” ujarnya.

Jelas beliau, kedua-dua buku terbabit diedarkan secara bercetak dan digital yang boleh diakses kakitangannya pada bila-bila masa sahaja.

“Melalui buku panduan ini mereka dapat mengetahui apa tindakan akan dibuat dan apakah kesan sekiranya mereka terbabit dengan rasuah,” katanya.

Ditanya tentang statistik rasuah membabitkan kakitangan MBSA, Zamani Ahmad berkata, setakat ini tiada kes rasuah membabitkan kakitangannya.

“Belum ada sebarang kes rasuah membabitkan kakitangan MBSA melainkan kes-kes lama,” jelasnya.

Damansara Jaya residents upset with Petaling Jaya City Council for cordoning off their community garden >2

Residents hope MBPJ reconsiders clearing out community garden

PETALING Jaya City Council (MBPJ) has cordoned off a community garden in Jalan SS22A, citing violation of its park by-laws

and open space gazette.

A notice to Damansara Jaya Residents and Owners Association (DJROA) was also issued by MBPJ's Landscape Department.

It ordered the cessation of all gardening activities and for all planting materials, tools

and plants to be cleared within 14 days of the date of issue, which was Sept 29.

The residents — who have been taking care of the community garden — hoped the council would reconsider its decision.

Resident Yap Oi Fah, 81, a former secretary of SS22A Rukun Tetangga Area (RT) and DJROA said the idea for a garden was mooted in 2019 as residents wanted more activities to bring the community together.

He said the community garden that started in January last year received a total funding of RM33,000 from Bandar Utama assemblyman Jamaliah Jamaluddin, Selangor executive council member Hee Loy Sian and MBPJ councillor Quratalain Atiqah Norzahirul Anuar as part of the state government's green initiatives.

Another resident, Connie Ng, 66, said the area was once a wild mass of overgrowth with mango and banana trees planted by unknown people.

As the plants were in a part of the park that was seldom used, she said it seemed an ideal location for a garden.

She said the process of starting a community garden and seeing it grow had been rewarding and an educational one.

"Many of us had little to no agricultural background. We learned the process of growing food from others who had the knowledge," she added.

Ng said the community garden also became a social meeting point, with children coming over in the evenings to see what the adults were doing.

"It was the children who decorated the corner where a dead tree stump once stood. They put ornamental flora, fauna and art-

work on pebbles, rocks and recycled wood.

"Other times, the teenagers would hamper a scarecrow together. On Saturday mornings, we would have tea and snacks," she said.

Ng added that although they had no intention to protest against the council's orders to vacate the land, residents were finding it hard to let go.

Dr Siti Hajar Ahmad, 72, a retired university lecturer who has a doctorate in horticulture, said she had asked permission from the city council's Landscape Department to utilise the land.

Although there was no official reply, several successful applications for cash grants led the residents to assume they had received the go-ahead, she said.

The money, managed by the RT, was used to buy soil, seedlings, plants, frames for cultivation beds and a garden shed, she added.

Siti Hajar said it would be good if the residents were allowed to sit with the council to discuss the guidelines.

When contacted, MBPJ Landscape Department director Dr Badrulzaman Jaafar said the community garden was cordoned off in line with the guidelines of the National Community Garden Policy that prohibited the use of parks and open spaces for community gardening.

"This policy was enforced on Aug 3."

He said no allocation was given to the RT of SS22A as it was not registered with the city council.

Residents keen on continuing the community gardening could send in a fresh proposal for a new area or place for the department's review and consideration, he added.

Ab Rauf to stand by party leadership decision

MELAKA: State Barisan Nasional chairman Datuk Seri Ab Rauf Yusoh says he will honour the decision to pick Datuk Seri Sulaiman Md Ali as chief minister-designate if the coalition wins the state polls.

"I will abide as well as respect the decision made by the Barisan and Umno leadership. I am a staunch party man," he said when contacted yesterday.

Ab Rauf, who is also Melaka Umno chief, was asked to comment on a social media post alleging that he would be the chief minister-designate if Barisan wins, by disregarding former Melaka chief minister Datuk Seri Sulaiman Md Ali.

Sulaiman was nominated by Barisan as chief minister-designate on Nov 9 and was the first coalition to do so, followed by Pakatan Harapan which announced that former chief minister Adly Zahari is favoured for the position.

Only the Perikatan Nasional coalition has yet to name its choice of chief minister although the coalition's election director Datuk Seri Azmin Ali said there is an individual reserved for the position.

Rauf said the choice of Barisan's chief minister-designate will remain the final decision as stipulated by the leadership.

"Even my candidacy in the Melaka elec-

tion is decided by the Barisan and Umno leadership.

"If they (leadership) say no, I will abide (by not contesting) in the Melaka election," he said.

Ab Rauf said he is used to criticism levelled at him and deems this as the political game of certain quarters.

"There are always frustrated people and as a leader, I can't escape criticism," he added.

Ab Rauf is involved in a three-cornered fight with Perikatan Nasional's Masjid Tanah MP Datuk Mas Ermieyati Samsudin and Zainal Hassan of Pakatan Harapan.

I remain loyal to PKR, Lim tells Azmin

MELAKA: In a retort to Datuk Seri Azmin Ali, former Machap Jaya assemblyperson Ginie Lim has declared she remains loyal with the party despite being dropped as a PKR candidate in the upcoming Melaka state election.

Lim was responding to Azmin after the former PKR deputy president said on Tuesday he said he “sympathised” with Lim after she was dropped.

“Although I’m not contesting in the coming Melaka state election, I remain committed to the Pakatan Harapan agenda, as well as contributing ideas in national politics under the leadership of Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim,” said Lim in a statement on Facebook yesterday.

Lim had served as a one-term Machap Jaya assemblyperson after she won in the 14th General Election.

Lim said Azmin should realise that Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia is irrelevant to the future of the country.

“He should have returned to the right path, rather than letting himself be used as a tool of corruption,” said Lim, who added that it was sad that he chose to switch allegiances after being in the Opposition’s struggle for over 20 years.

In an event in Machap on Tuesday, Azmin said he was saddened by PKR’s decision to drop Lim and urged her to continue fighting.

Azmin claimed that Lim was a victim in PKR as she was seen aligned with him.

Hodak warns KL not to mess up against injured Giants

PETALING JAYA: Kuala Lumpur, despite having a two-goal cushion, still have a giant task in the Malaysia Cup quarter-finals return leg against Selangor, according to their coach Bojan Hodak.

The City Boys stunned their more illustrious rivals 2-0 at the MBPJ Stadium in Shah Alam on Sunday. And with home advantage at the Kuala Lumpur Football Stadium in Cheras tonight, KL are in the driver's seat to head into the semi-finals.

Romel Morales and Hadin Azman scored for KL in the 14th and 74th minute respectively as they recorded their first away win over the 33-time Malaysia Cup winners in 21 years.

Colombia-born Morales is now

the leading scorer in the competition with nine goals.

But despite having the firepower and momentum going for them, Hodak said it will be dangerous to disregard the Red Giants.

"KL have not played in the last eight of the Malaysia Cup after many years, so we are not considered favourites in the first place," he said.

"Selangor are the Real Madrid of Malaysia and what they've achieved in the competition shows their reputation as one of the big teams in the country.

"We have a two-goal cushion and we play at home but if we go easy, it will be dangerous. We must make the advantage count.

"We still need to go through 90

minutes. It's better if we start thinking like we are 0-0," said the Croatian.

Meanwhile, his Selangor counterpart Karsten Neitzel admitted that his team will be weakened by the absence of striker Ifedayo Olusegun, Brendan Gan, Safuwan Baharudin and Halim Saari, who are injured.

"In the first leg, we were not at our best and could not convert our chances. Now without some of our key players it will be difficult to overturn the result but we will try our best," said Neitzel.

Olusegun, the 2020 Super League Golden Boot winner, is recovering from a medial collateral ligament (MCL) injury and is not certain whether he will be on the starting line-up.
